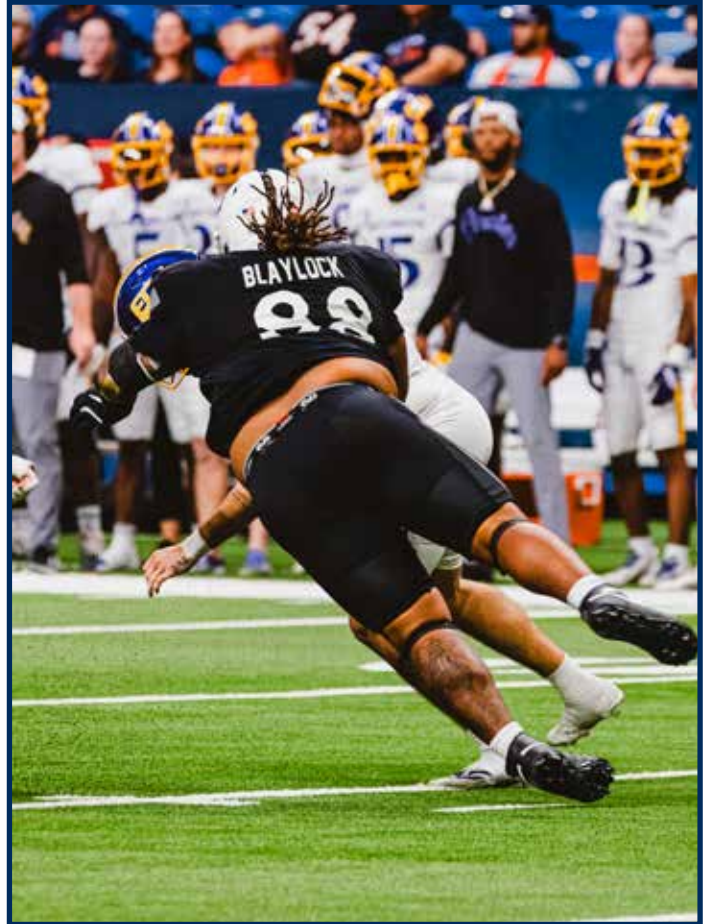

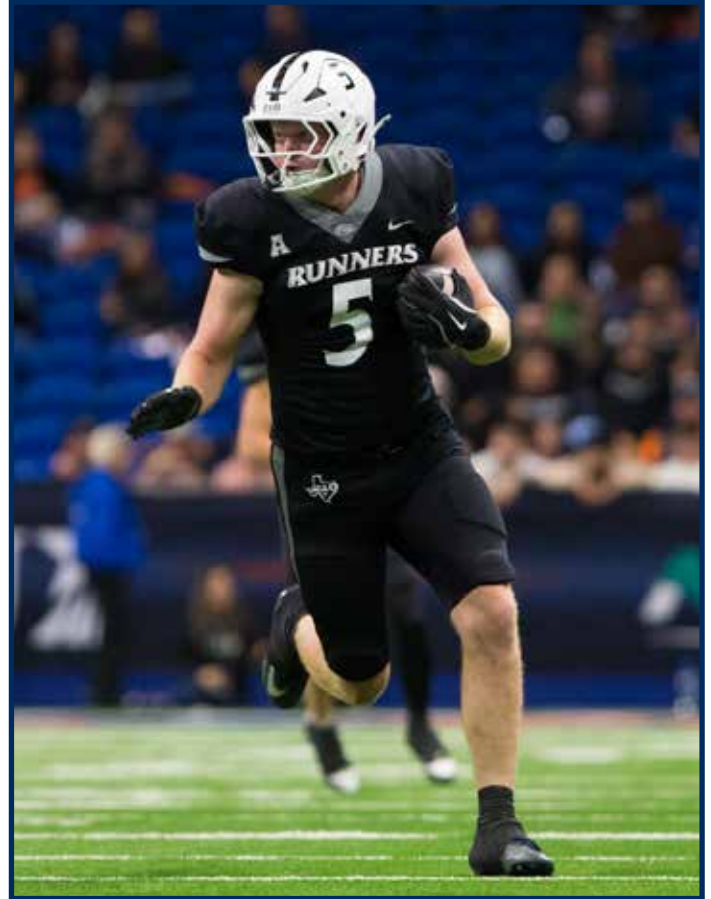

Graduate transfer running back from LSU ... appeared in 38 games with 5 starts for the Tigers ... rushed for 1,123 yards and 14 touchdowns and caught 37 passes for 328 yards and two TDs during his LSU career ... compiled 375 rushing yards and six TDs on 76 carries and caught 13 passes for 129 yards and a pair of scores in 2022 ... set a career-high with three rushing touchdowns at Texas A&M, finishing that contest with nine carries for 55 yards ... rushed for 378 yards and three TDs and recorded 14 receptions for 73 yards as a sophomore in 2020 ... logged his first career 100-yard game with 103 yards and a TD on 12 carries against Vanderbilt ... carried 18 times for 88 yards and a score in a win over South Carolina ... rushed for 188 yards and four TDs on 39 carries and had six receptions for 60 yards as a true freshman on LSU's 2019 national championship team ... considered one of the top-five running backs in the nation coming out of Destrehan High School ... rated a five-star prospect from Scout.com and 247 Sports and the No. 2 running back nationally by 247 Sports ... finalist for the Touchdown Club of Atlanta's National Back of the Year ... competed in the 2019 Under Armour All-America Game ... rushed for 1,693 yards and 26 touchdowns to lead Destrehan to a 13-2 record and the Class 5A state semifinals as a senior ... piled up 1,029 all-purpose yards, scored nine touchdowns and averaged more than seven yards per carry in six games before suffering a season-ending injury as a junior.

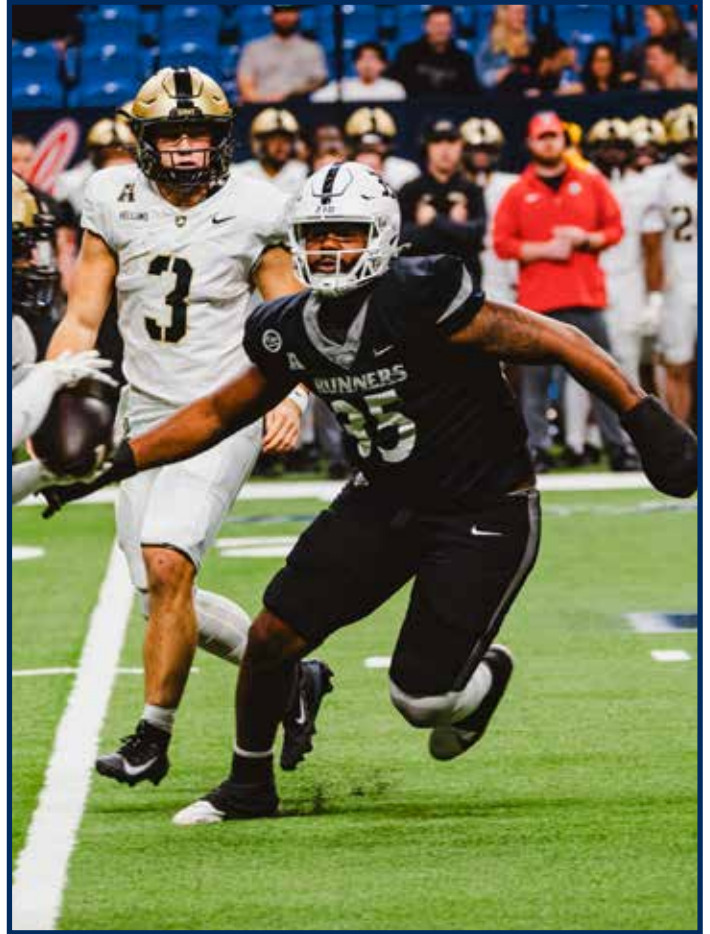
