# TWO YEAR COURSE

The new two year Christian Workers Course is designed especially for those who have no plans for going into full-time Christian service, but who want a well-rounded basic training in the Bible. Students completing this course will receive a total of 20 semester hours of Old and New Testament Exposition (this is equivalent to 320 class sessions), 8 hours of Preliminary and Advanced Dispensational Studies, 2 hours of Hermeneutics (Bible Interpretation), 2 hours of Bible Geography, 2 hours of Evangelism, 4 hours of Church History, 12 hours of Christian Education, 4 hours of Missions, 2 hours of speech, and 6 hours of English. This course gives the student a total of 1,024 actual periods of class instruction.
