Dear Students:

In trying to think of all of you—those who just came to us this year, those who have returned, and those who will be leaving us—Paul's words to the Philip-
pians came to my mind. They seem to reflect the attitude of progressive attain-
ment:

“If by any means I might attain”

“Not as though I had already attained”

“Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained”

Our goal at M.B.C. is that of attainment—not simply of knowledge, or ability, or distinction, however desirable these may be—but the attainment of that goal toward which Paul pressed with every fiber of his being.

You came to school saying, *If by any means I might attain*. Your objec-
tive was perhaps not too well defined or crystallized in your thinking, but at
least you knew that you wanted to attain. Those of you who have been in
college longer have come to understand a little more clearly what it is that
Christ wants you to be, but how well you realize that you have not yet attained.

Finally, those of you who are graduating in the Class of '59 have, I trust,
come to realize very definitely what your Goal is, and although you too with
Paul realize that there is yet much to attain, you are going forth to serve
Christ on that plane *whereto you have already attained*, ever pressing toward
the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. You have
learned your lessons well: I trust you have above all else *learned Christ*,
(Eph. 4:20).
