Cannot add RDMs to virtual machines using NetApp SnapDrive (1029963)

Symptoms

When attempting to add a SAN storage as an RDM to a virtual machine by using SnapDrive, you experience these symptoms:

- You are unable to add the RDM using NetApp SnapDrive.
- NetApp SnapDrive does not list any available LUNs to add as an RDM.
- You are able to add the RDM via vCenter Server.

Resolution

To resolve this issue, use this workaround provided by NetApp:

Note: Ensure you back up your registry before performing these steps.

1. Using device manager or from vCenter Server, disable the IDE channel.
2. Add a new CD-ROM drive on the free IDE channel for that virtual machine.
3. Check if SnapDrive is able to see the FCP initiators. If not, continue with Step 4.
4. Navigate to the registry location `HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\HARDWARE\DEVICEMAP\Scsi`.

You see keys similar to `SCSI Port <x>`, where `<x>` is a number

When you expand these keys, you see subkeys similar to `SCSI bus <x>`, which, in turn, have keys `Initiator ID` and `Target ID`.

If the `SCSI Port <x>` key does not have the subkeys `SCSI bus <x>`, `Initiator ID`, and `Target ID`, delete the `SCSI bus <x>` registry key.

5. Restart the SnapDrive service and check if SnapDrive is able to see the FCP initiators.

Note: This workaround may not be persistent across virtual machine reboots.
