The pastor of a **Wanga speaking church** said, "I gave a player and a Good News flipchart to a family that never came to church and were involved in witchcraft." The pastor asked them to listen to the messages and to return them to the church on Sunday, through their child. The pastor was surprised on Saturday evening when the man came with his wife and 17 year old daughter to the church, where a meeting was taking place. They came in and went right to the pulpit area and knelt down, the fellowship burst into worship songs. Suddenly, the man shouted **"... Pastor it's time for my family to stop our behavior and accept Jesus, we want Him to give us His Love and peace too. We are also children of Israel, let Him save us now, we have no peace in our home and we are here, come and pray for us"** The man fell on his stomach prostrate while his wife kept crying. The entire family asked Jesus into their lives. Today they are the most supportive of the work of God. The pastor thanks God for the GRN materials.



Revealed Sinful Habits

Ateso County is well known for drunkenness and alcoholism. Many parents initiate their new born babies with a locally brewed alcohol. A pastor said, "he had a church member who used to drink but could not miss coming to church." He gave him a player with the *Look, Listen & Live* book number three (Victory through God) and also number six (Jesus Teacher and Healer). He told him to listen to them as they enjoy their "sweet food" (meaning alcoholic drink) with friends and bring it back on Sunday.

The following Sunday he came early to the church office, in the company of three men. One of the men said, **"Preacher you sent our friend messages in this player that taught us how bad and sinful we are. We have come so that together you can pray for us to receive Jesus, so we can have a new life in Him. We heard the preacher on the player tell us that we should say we are sorry for annoying Jesus by drinking for long hours. Also that Jesus died so we may rejoice in Him and be free."** The pastor prayed for them and led them to Christ. The three men form a strong pillar of Christians who actively give much of their time in the church activities and fellowship. Their salvation encouraged three others to accept salvation through Jesus as well.

Director's Desk – David Elliott

Reports from Kenya indicate that churches which have received GRN audio and visual materials have grown greatly, in some cases almost doubling the size of their Sunday Schools. Pastors requested more materials. The reports provided by the Kenya director, Walter Okelo, have indicated an eagerness to hear the gospel in their own language. In some cases this has been their first time hearing the Bible stories in their own language.

GRN Banquet was a blessing as **Godsave** shared his personal testimony. He had a powerful story on how God saved him both physically and spiritually. Godsave has been instrumental in getting GRN Tanzania off the ground and registering the mission with the government. He shared that Tanzania has 210 different languages with 125 ethnic groups. Many of these groups do not have the Bible in their own language. In the pictures below, James Shikuku, from Kenya is working with language helpers to record Tanzanian languages. There is a great need to continue this vital ministry of providing the gospel in all 120 languages.



Godsaves' wife Beatrice is the only worker with GRN Tanzania. She is pictured in the left photo. There is a need for funding to do more recordings and to see the gospel distributed. We also learned that rural pastors who most need the material for their ministries, only receive less than \$10 U.S. per month.
