October 2020

Thu 1: "Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever Amen".

Fri 2: UK: Last month we asked for prayer for the safe arrival of some of our Mega voice MP3 players sent for widows in Uganda. Last week we heard of their safe arrival and an order for 20 more to be sent Thank you for praying.

Sat 3: Praise God for the recordist training course in the **USA** which went ahead despite Covid. Pray for the trainees as they begin to record and use the new skills they have been taught.

Sun 4: GRN South Africa gives thanks for GRN recordings and picture book materials delivered to trained evangelists amongst the remote Luvale people in Zambia. Pray that these will be fruitful. Another 25 evangelist sets are to be sent.

Mon 5 Europe: Pray for strength and wisdom for Christians helping refugees in Lesbos in Greece following the terrible fire that destroyed the makeshift homes of many thousands. They are using our materials to tell them of their Saviour.

Tue 6: UK: Desperate asylum seekers and migrants continue to flood into the UK. Pray that more individuals and Churches will reach out to them and provide for their spiritual needs as well as their physical ones.

Wed 7: Papua New Guinea has 8 million people speaking hundreds of different languages. Pray that the Lord will send workers to be trained as recordists and distributors in "this land of the unexpected". Please pray for Merolin Gawa who oversees the office and distribution there

Thur 8: We give thanks to all our prayer partners and supporters who faithfully uphold the work of GRNUK daily. Please pray for new prayer partners for our continuing endeavours. **Thank You.**

Fri 9: Terrorism is a constant threat to GRN teams in many parts of Africa and Asia. Pray that the Lord will protect each team and the Christian communities in which they live and serve.

Sat 10: Today the European Directors will be meeting via Zoom, for an important meeting. Pray they will be able to recognise the leading of the Holy Spirit in all their discussions and that the Lord will bless their time together.

Sun 11: The Nyenkha language is spoken by about 10,000 people in the Black Mountains of Bhutan. They are mainly Buddhists. We do not know of any missionaries or Christians working among these people. Pray that they may come to know the Lord as their own personal saviour.

Mon 12: Pray for the staff of GRN in Bangladesh. Director James and his family have had Covid. Pray the team there will be encouraged to press on knowing the Lord is a shield about them, and that no weapon forged against them will prosper.

Tue 13: Please pray for wisdom for all our political leaders and governments around the world at this time of the pandemic. Pray for unity among them.

Wed 14 Covid is a growing problem in Africa and is exacerbated by hunger, violence and inflation in many countries. Pray for protection for our GRN staff and African Christians.

Thu 15: GRN staff in Nigeria are distributing recordings of a new 'covid script' prepared by our International Director. Pray that many will hear it and turn to the Lord. Pray also for staff and other Christians coping with a 100% rise in food prices due to the pandemic.

Fri 16: Pray for Christians in the mountains of Asia, in an area where churches have been growing and have been using our materials to reach out in all the local tribal tongues They are contending with a regime hostile to the Gospel who are trying to eliminate Christian organisations.

Sat 17: UK: Pray for Kenny and Joan as they continue to send out our GRN materials although some of their recording work is having to go on hold due to the pandemic.

Sun 18: GRN Mexico. Please pray for Chucho, Chuy and their families as they deal with high inflation and heavy restrictions in their country. Pray for good opportunities to record and distribute recordings.

Mon 19: Please pray for all our recording teams around the world who are restricted in travelling to make recordings. Give each one wisdom to know when it is safe for themselves and the language helpers to meet and record.

Tue 20 It is with great sadness we announce the recent deaths of some of our former staff members. Jan Lange (USA), Nancy Cornthwaite (USA), Sybil Shaw (Australia), Vida McLellan (Australia) and Ray Avenell (UK). Our thoughts and prayers are with their families.

Wed 21: "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Therefore as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers" (Gals 6 v 9-10).

Thu 22. Plans to train recordists in Togo and in Mexico have had to be postponed because of Covid. Pray that the training will be able to go ahead in due course.

Fri 23: Praise the Lord for all the GRN recordings that are listened to and downloaded each day from our 5fish.mobi app. Over 6,700 languages & dialects are available free.

Sat 24: GRN Worldwide: Please pray for all our team leaders, IT teams, administration and office staff in the GRN offices around the world. Give each one the joy and blessing in serving The One True God, the King of Kings and The Lord of All".

Sun 25: Pray for GRN volunteers in Belgium and other European countries reaching out to migrants in their countries using GRN recordings etc.

Mon 26: In the mountains of Asia where churches are growing despite opposition from a hostile regime, GRN materials are being used to reach out to people in local tribal languages.

Tue 27: GRN are able to use social media to target speakers of minority languages with links to our recordings. The focus is on languages which have no Christian evangelistic or Christian teaching.

Wed 28: Pray for all GRN teams on every continent reaching out with the Gospel in many languages to make Jesus known. Encourage and protect each team and especially those living in hostile regions.

Thu 29: Ps 121. "I lift up my eyes to the hills-where does my strength come from? My help comes from the Lord the maker of heaven and earth".

Fri 30: Pray for all our GRN leaders at this time of political uncertainty, terrorism, and pandemic. Fill each one with your Peace, Love and Joy as they have the privilege of serving our amazing God.

Sat 31: With over 4,000 languages and dialects still unrecorded, please that GRN can accelerate recording the remaining unrecorded languages without sacrificing quality. **Thank you for praying.**
