## December 2020

**Tue 1: UK:** We are so thankful for your prayers each month. Thank you for praying for our safety as we are able to come into the office each week. We are blessed to be able to send out GRN recordings and Flip charts.

**Wed 2: Global 24 Hour Prayer Day:** Last week we were able to meet online with our teams from Australia, Canada, Serra Leone, Kenya, USA & France. Many other GRN groups met during this 24 hour period praying for each other and enjoying fellowship.

**Thur 3: UK:** Today one of our friends from the UK is flying to Niger, Africa with some 30 of our Megavoice players & SD micro cards loaded with the Tuareg New Testament & a radio program recording on Righteousness. Please pray for his 3 week visit there.

**Fri 4: UK:** One of our Seamen Mission friends gives our 5fish cards to crew members on the ships he visits. He also gives and sends out lots of Christian books including 'Good News For Everyone.' He glues the 5fish cards in all the New Testaments, Bibles and Devotionals which he gifts to seafarers. This enables the listener to hear the Gospel in their language on their phone.

**Sat 5 Kosova:** Thanks to the generosity of one of our amazing support partners, we have been able to provide food parcels to poor families living in Gjakove. Our friends at Victory church deliver the food parcels each week. They know the needs of the families there; many of whom have no income at all. (Matt 25v31-40)

**Sun 6: Thailand:** The Nyaw and Isaan people recently received mp3 players loaded with GRN content. Pray that they will continue to listen to the messages and stories and as a result many will come to know their Creator—the One who wants a personal forever relationship with them.

**Mon 7:** Pray for the Work of GRN Nigeria and especially for Kish Bai, the Director, who is seriously ill with Covid. Pray for his safety for his family and team.

**Tue 8:** Asia: All the staff working with GRN in a mountainous country where the Gospel is not welcome have been ill with Covid. Pray for their recovery and that their work will not be hindered by opposition.

**Wed 9: UK:** Although the pandemic has hindered recordings, Kenny and Joan are still working and sending out materials. They have sent shipments to several

African countries; pray for them that the materials they send out will be well used to teach Christians & evangelise those who have not yet heard of their Saviour.

**Thur 10:** Many GRN Centres in Africa have 'tent-making' businesses to support their families; the Pandemic has closed many of these down just as inflation and food prices are rising. Pray for God's provision and protection.

**Fri 11:** Joseph Ndiba, Director of GRN Cameroon has recently join the international Leadership Team of GRN. Pray for him as settles into this new role in addition to his work in Cameroon.

**Sat 12:** GRN Mexico leads an outreach to migrant workers from remote rural areas who come to pick crops in Culican each year. They ask for prayer for 100 volunteers for the outreach in 2021.

**Sun13:** Give thanks for the Covid 19 script, recorded in several languages in Nigeria, which is proving helpful-with listeners. Pray that it can be used in other areas.

**Mon 14** The Dameli people in Pakistan are 100% Muslim; pray for opportunities to record in their language so they can hear and be saved.

**Tue 15:** Pray for Graydon Colville, International Director, as he supports and guides Centres across the world vi technology; unable to travel to visit Centres as he normally does

**Wed 16:** The 8,000 Lakha people of Bhutan have no Christians or Christian resources; pray that the Lord will send workers to these people, who will provide an opportunity to record the Good News in their language.

**Thur 17:** In several Asian countries GRN has teams who are able to continue their recording and distribution ministry at this time. Pray for their health and safety and the Lord's guidance and enabling.

**Fri 18:** John Taylor worked with GRN UK for many years as a staff member and, after his retirement, as a volunteer. Pray the Lord will bless and encourage him everyday and give him good health and strength.

**Sat 19:** GRN South Africa gives thanks for recordings and picture book materials delivered to trained evangelists who are proclaiming Christ to the remote Lu-vale people in Zambia. Pray that these audio materials will be fruitful. Another 25 sets are to be sent.

**Sun 20** GRN Cameroon director, Joseph Ndiba asks for prayer as he records the Gospel of John in the Éwondo language. Pray these recordings will have impact as the Word of God is faithfully proclaimed. Pray God's Word won't return void.

**Mon 21: Thailand:** Pray for the Lords blessing on a partnership between GRN Thailand and "Bibles for Asia" (BFA). The strategy is for GRN to help train BFA national workers to make recordings for BFA listening groups. Please pray for good success in this project.

**Tue 22.** Papua New Guinea has eight million people speaking hundreds of different languages. Pray that the Lord will send workers to be trained as recordists and distributors in this land of great diversity. Pray that GRN leader Merolin Gawa will be encouraged and full of vision as she oversees the office and distribution of audio evangelism materials.

**Wed 23:** GRN uses social media to target speakers of minority languages with links to our recordings. The focus is on languages which have no evangelistic or Christian teaching. Ask God to prosper this new pathway for getting our recorded gospel messages to minority language speakers all over the world.

**Thur 24:** "The Birth of Jesus" in Luke Ch 2" But when Joseph and Mary arrived in Bethlehem, the couple could not find anywhere to stay. They were forced to stay in a stable that night of their arrival, and in this stable their son Jesus was born.

**Fri 25: CHRISTMAS DAY.** Thank you to the Lord for His great gift to us, on this day when we remember the coming of our Saviour Jesus Christ.

**Sat 26:** Asia: Please pray for salvation from a recent visit and for recordings made in the Bagri language by our team. The community are 100 % Hindu and plans are being made for translating more stories in their language and recordings in the future.

**Sun 27:** We thank the Lord for his continued provision for the work of GRNUK and for Kenny & Joan personally through the year with many small gifts, donations & bequests from Christian Trusts & God's people towards our many projects around the world.

**Mon 28:** The movement of people in this century provides opportunities for GRN staff to record languages from distant regions without leaving their home city or country. Pray that Kenny and recordists in Europe, Australia and the USA will find opportunities to record strategic languages in 2021.

**Tue 29:** Pray that GRN will be a house of prayer for all nations (Isaiah 56:7). Pray with us for the people with whom we have shared our recordings, that they will turn away from their idols and false gods and turn to the true and living God.

**Wed 30:** Many GRN projects remain at a standstill until it is once again safe to travel and meet with people. Pray that recording teams will use this down time to be strengthened in prayer and in the Word. It will be helpful also to have language contacts identified and committed to assist us with the field projects when the virus is eventually brought under control.

**Thur 31:** As the New Year arrives please pray that the will of the Lord's be done in GRN and across the world in this new year.
