

Inspect and Clean Gutter and Downspouts

Test Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors



Summer means more grilling and power use. Make sure your detectors are working and replace batteries as needed.






Trim Trees and Overgrown Shrubs

Check Your Irrigation System



Texas winters can be rough on pipes. Check your sprinkler system for leaks, broken heads, and proper coverage before the summer heat kicks in.

Test chemical levels, clean filters, inspect the pump, and secure safety gates. Make sure your pool is both fun and liability-safe.



Inventory Your Outdoor Furniture and Tools
