

Inspect the Roof for Damage



Emphasize fall-specific checks for any damage that may have occurred in summer storms.





Check Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors



With the weather turning colder, heating systems may run more, so it's crucial to ensure these detectors are in working order.



Clean and Inspect the Fireplace or Chimney




Make sure fireplaces or wood-burning stoves are safe for use, and clean out any buildup from previous seasons.
