Power

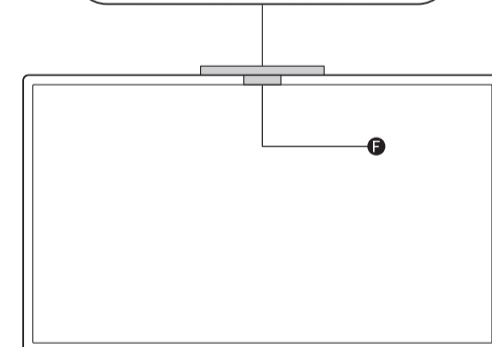
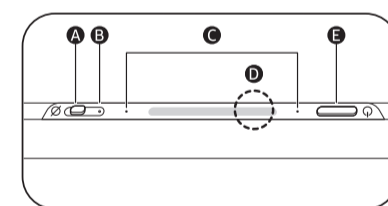
02 Initial Setup

When you turn on your Product for the first time, it immediately starts the Initial Setup. Follow the instructions displayed on the screen and configure the Product's basic settings to suit your viewing environment.

- You will need a Samsung Account to access our network-based smart services. If you choose not to log in, you will only get a connection to external devices, such as HDMI.

Using the Product Controller

- The Product shape may differ depending on the model.

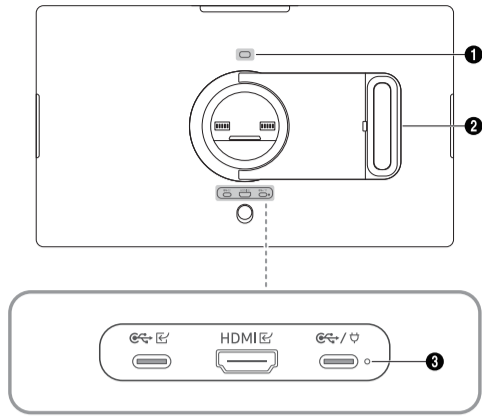


- A** Microphone switch : You can turn on or off the microphone. If microphone is turned off, All voice and sound features using microphone are not available.
 - During analysis using data from the microphone, the data is not saved.
- B** Microphone LED
- C** Microphone
- D** Eco Sensor
- E** Power button

 - You can turn on or off the Product.
 - When the product is turned on, tap the button to display the **Power Off** menu. Select the menu item you want from among **Power Off**, **Battery Rest Mode**, and **Restart**. To use Mobile Remote, scan the QR Code.
 - If you press the button for more than 2 seconds, the product turns off. If you press and hold it for more than 7 seconds, the product restarts.

Ports



1 Camera Port

Connects to a dedicated camera (sold separately) compatible with the product.

2 Kick Stand

The battery is located inside the kick stand.



- Connects to a USB device, such as a keyboard or mouse.
- Connects to a source device using a USB Type-C cable.
 - When connecting a USB Type-C source device, make sure to use the USB Type-C 3.1 Gen2 10G cable so that the screen is displayed properly. Lower version cables do not support the video input function (Displayport ALT).



Connects to a source device using an HDMI cable.

- It is recommended to use the HDMI cable provided as components. If not provided, be sure to use authorised cable for HDMI cable connections.



- Connects to a USB device, such as a keyboard or mouse.
- Used when charging the product. Fast charging at 65 W or higher is possible when charging with a PD adapter. (45 W or higher if using a PD battery).

Shows the battery charging status.

- State-of-charge level by LED colour
 - Full charging : 0 ~ 79 % Red / 80 ~ 94 % Yellow / 95 ~ 100 % Green
 - Charging in battery protection mode (charging limit: 85%) : 0 ~ 64 % Red / 65 ~ 79 % Yellow / 80 ~ 85 % Green

Charging the battery

This product has a built-in battery, allowing users to conveniently use it for a certain period of time without having to connect to a power source.

Battery status indication

Check the status of your device from the status bar at the top right of the screen.

- This option appears when the **Home, Game, Daily Board, or Art** screen opens, and disappears after a while.

Notes

- Fully charge the battery before turning on the product for the first time after purchase.
- Full battery charging time is approximately 3 hours if the power cable is connected and the product is in standby mode, and is approximately 3 hours and 30 minutes if the product is operating.
- During video playback that meets IEC62087 standard, the battery life is up to 3 hours when Eco mode and factory default volume are in use, the input source is set to HDMI, and **Battery Saving** is in the ON state. Battery life may differ, depending on product usage conditions.
- If the product is turned off using **Battery Rest Mode**, it can only be turned on by pressing the power button on the product. Some features, such as **Daily Board** and **Mobile Remote**, are restricted.
- If the battery temperature increases, the product may automatically turn off to protect the battery.
- The battery will not charge if stored below 0 °C (32 °F) or above 50 °C (122 °F). Charge the battery after storing it at room temperature for a sufficient period of time.
 - Store the battery indoors at temperatures between 0 °C and 40 °C (32 °F and 104 °F).

- This panel is made up of sub pixels which require sophisticated technology to produce. There may be, however, a few bright or dark pixels on the screen. These pixels will have no impact on the performance of the product.
- To keep your Product in optimum condition, upgrade to the latest software. (Home > left directional button > Settings > Support > Software Update).

The Product won't turn on.

- Make sure that the power cord is securely plugged into the product and the wall outlet.
- Make sure that the wall outlet is working and the remote control sensor at the top of the Product is lit and glowing a solid red.
- Make sure the power plug is plugged in.
- If the battery has discharged, please charge it by connecting the power cord.
- If the battery temperature is too high or too low, the product will not turn on. Let the battery stabilize at room temperature for a while before turning on the product.
- Try pressing the **Product Controller** button at the top of the Product to make sure that the problem is not with the remote control. If the Product turns on, refer to "The remote control does not work."

The remote control does not work.

- Check if the remote control sensor at the top of the Product blinks when you press the **Home** button on the remote control.
 - When the remote's battery is discharged, charge the battery using the USB charging port (C-type), or turn over the remote to expose the solar cell to light.
- Try pointing the remote directly at the Product from 1.5-1.8 m away.
- If your Product came with a Samsung Smart Remote (Bluetooth Remote), make sure to pair the remote to the Product. To pair a Samsung Smart Remote, press the **Home** and **Power** buttons together for 3 seconds.

Eco Sensor and screen brightness

Eco Sensor adjusts the brightness of the Product automatically. This feature measures the light in your room and optimises the brightness of the Product automatically to reduce power consumption. If you want to turn this off, go to (Home > left directional button > Settings > All Settings > General & Privacy > Power and Energy Saving > Brightness Optimisation).

- The eco sensor is located at the top of the Product. Do not block the sensor with any object. This can decrease picture brightness.

Decreasing power consumption

When you shut the Product off, it enters Standby mode. In Standby mode, it continues to draw a small amount of power. To decrease power consumption, unplug the power cord when you don't intend to use the Product for a long time.
