GROW YOUR OWN PINEAPPLE

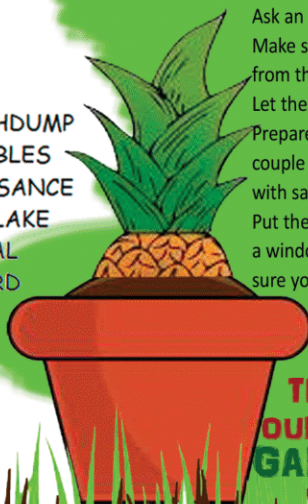
WHAT YOU NEED:

a whole pineapple
an ice-cream container
some sand

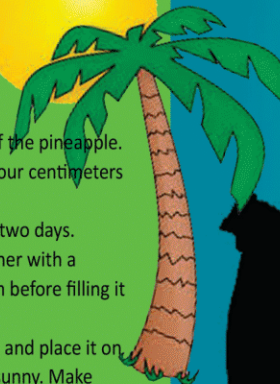
HOW TO:

Ask an adult to cut the top off the pineapple. Make sure they leave about four centimeters from the base of the leaves. Let the pineapple dry out for two days. Prepare the ice-cream container with a couple of holes in the bottom before filling it with sand. Put the pineapple in the sand and place it on a window sill or somewhere sunny. Make sure you water regularly....then you have to be patient for two months!

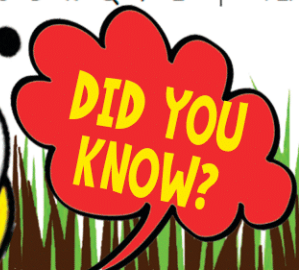
