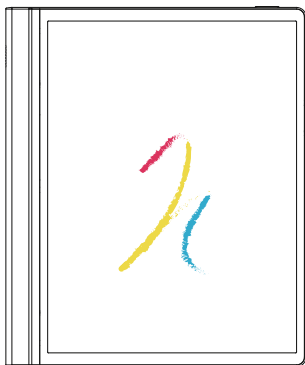

FAQ

Q1: How can I connect my HannsNote2 device to the internet? Does it accept SIM cards?

A1: HannsNote2 can connect to the internet via Wi-Fi, but it does not have LTE functionalities, and SIM cards cannot be inserted.

Q2: Can I adjust the screen's brightness?

A2: HannsNote2 is integrated with HannStar's Argentum Birefringence™ display technology, which leverages ambient light reflection. As such, the HannsNote2 device has no integrated light source, and the screen's brightness cannot be adjusted.

Q3: What are the ideal viewing conditions?

A3: It is recommended to use HannsNote2 in environments with an illuminance above 500 Lux, at least 800 to 1000 Lux for comfortable viewing, and above 1000 Lux for optimum clarity. The device offers clear viewing in daylight, and in any well-lit environment, but viewing may be compromised in low-lighting conditions.

Notes:

1. According to the 'Energy-Saving Technology Manual for Government Offices' compiled by Taiwan's Ministry of Economic Affairs, it is recommended to maintain a minimum illuminance of at least 500 Lux, and the optimum illuminance is 1000 Lux or above.
2. According to the CNS National Illuminance Standard, recommended illuminance values for reading and writing are between 500 Lux and 2000 Lux.

Q4: Where can I download apps from?

A4: HannsNote2 runs the Android 13 operating system, allowing you to download and install any app from Google Play or third-party developers.

Q5: How long is the battery life?

A5: With Wi-Fi turned on and the battery fully charged, HannsNote2 can play videos for approximately 2.5 to 3 hours. In standby mode with Wi-Fi and background programs turned off, the battery can last up to 72 hours.

Q6: What kind of stylus can I use?

A6: HannsNote2 is compatible with any stylus that conforms to communication protocol US1 2.0..

Q7: How do I connect my stylus?

A7: There are two simple steps to pairing HannsNote2 with a stylus (see below).

Step1: Open the HannsNote2 app or your preferred note-taking app.

Step2: Using your stylus, draw a line from the top of the display (near the front-facing camera) down to the center of the display, and back up to the top of the display, 3-5 times.

Note:

If your HannsNote2 device restarts during the pairing process, then repeat the above steps to complete the pairing process.
