No, we are all made in God's image and should treat each person with value and respect.

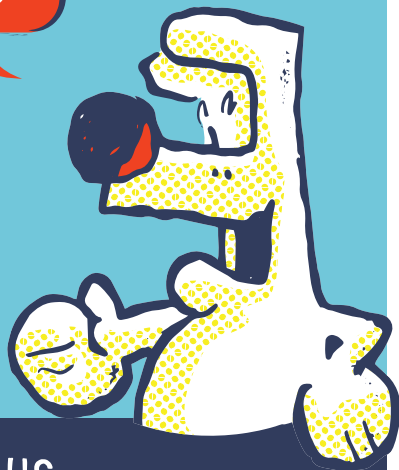
NEXT STEP OF THE MONTH!
