ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning! Who loves [child's name]? God loves [child's name]!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, no one will ever love us more than You do. That's why we can always trust Your plans for us."



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your child what their favorite animal is. Talk about how God put two of every kind of animal in the ark with Noah and his family.



Bath Time

Add a toy boat and/or toy animals to bath time. Talk about how Noah trusted God's plans and built the ark, just like God told him to. Then, God sent two of every animal to get on the ark with Noah and his family.
