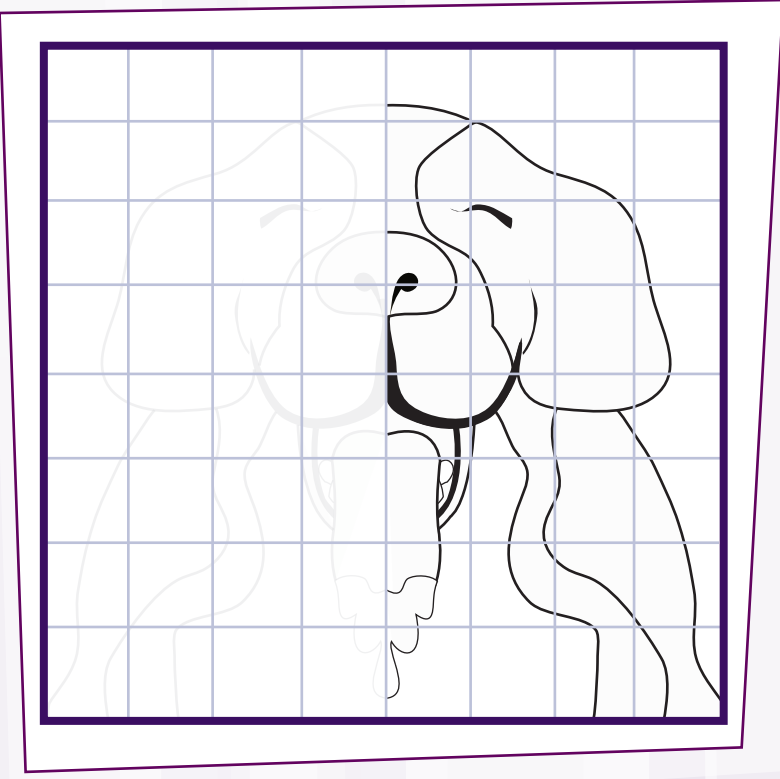


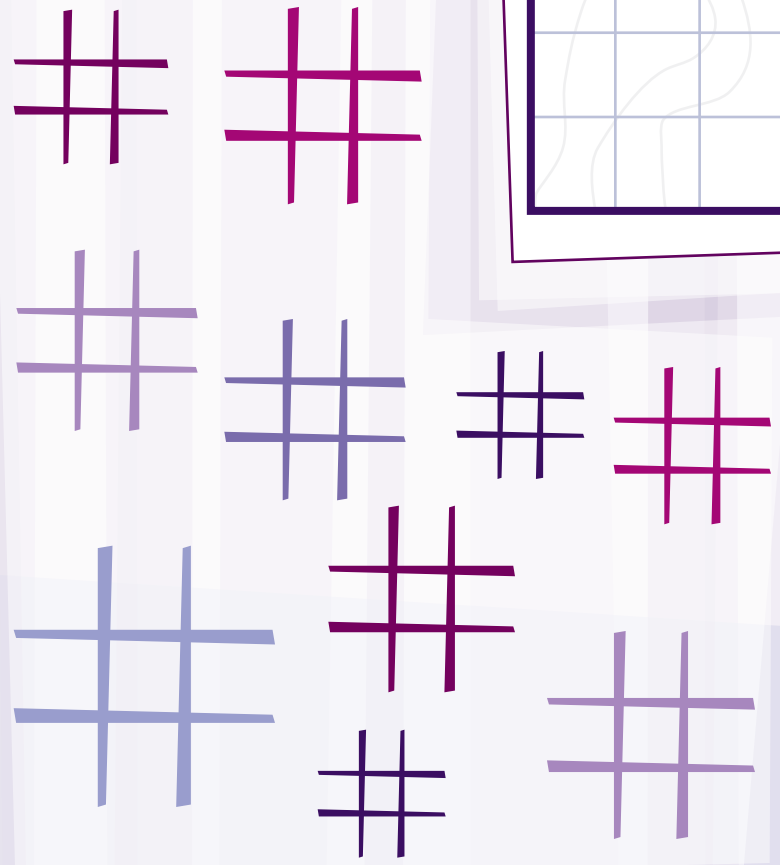


Help finish drawing Sampson

Use the boxes for guides.

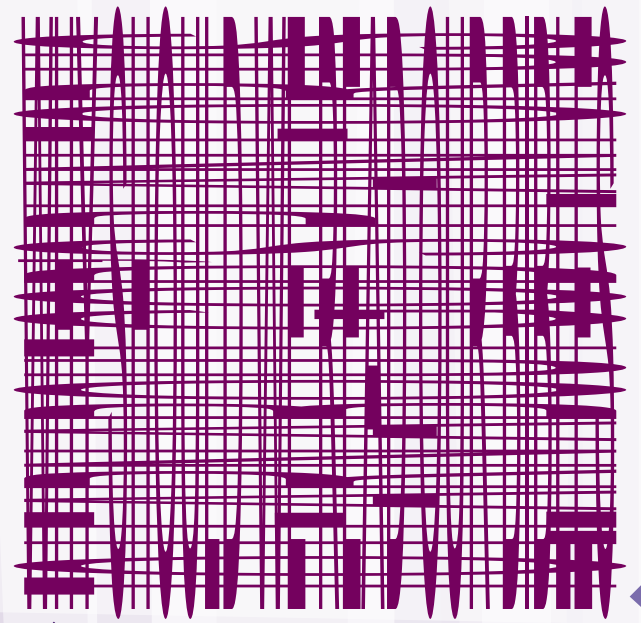


Tic-Tac-Toe

Hint: Tilt the page to eye-level.

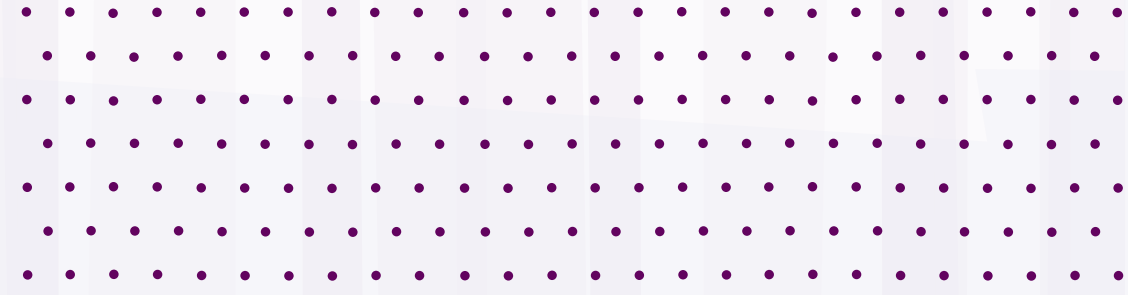


Now turn at look at this angle for the answer.
