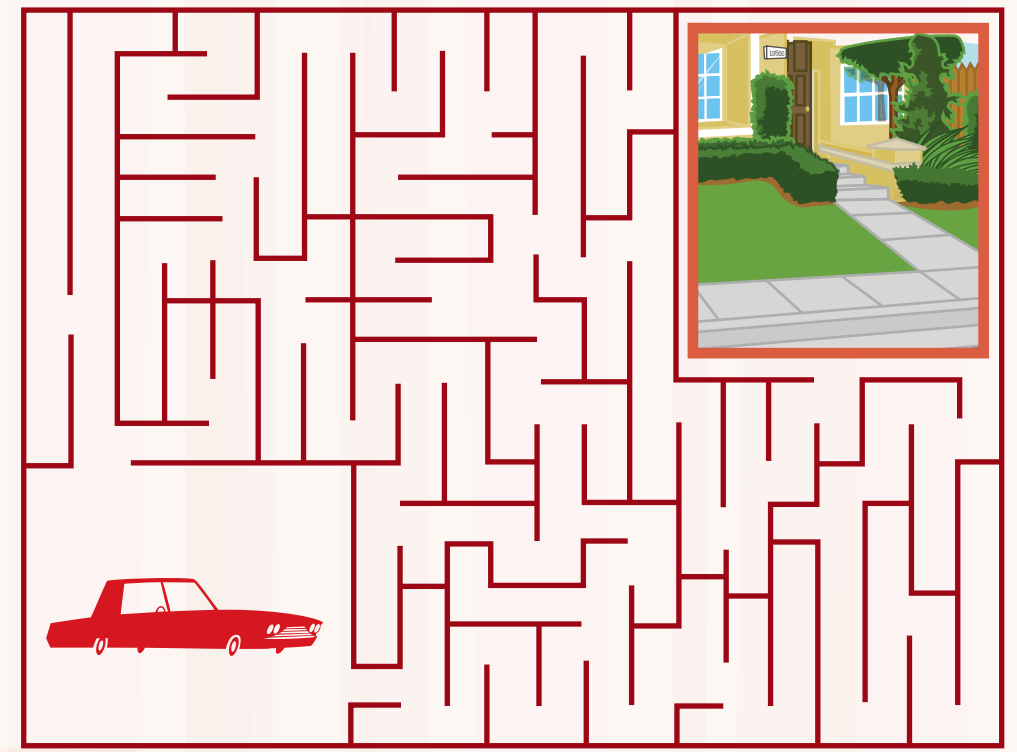




## Tic-Tac-Toe
