### THE GOSPEL IS ONLY GOOD NEWS IF IT GETS THERE ON TIME

There is a blessing in winning souls. Proverbs 11:30 says, “The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise” (NKJV). God would not have said this if by the power of the Holy Spirit we were not able to win souls. All around us is a world that needs Christ. When you’re led by the spirit—that little tug on your heart—it is important listen and obey.

#### PRACTICAL PRINCIPLES

1. **Where should we share the gospel?** Simple answer: wherever! Go into all the world and preach the gospel. That’s what Christ said. Go to your family, friends, workplace, neighborhood, and campus.
2. **Go into all of your world and preach the gospel.** We call it “FRAN-gelism” but what does that stand for? Go to your Friends, Relatives, Associates, and Neighbors. Go into all of “your” world and preach the gospel.

#### RELEVANT REMINDERS

- If we really believe in the afterlife, there are only two options: heaven or hell. That fact should motivate us to share the gospel message. People might say no to an invitation to attend or watch the crusade, but they might say yes. So be persistent. Isn’t it worth the risk?
- Jesus said when the Holy Spirit comes, “He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of the judgment to come.” It’s the job of the Holy Spirit to convince. So lovingly, biblically, clearly we are to lay the facts out before a person and then leave it ultimately in the hands of God.

#### APPLICABLE ACTIONS

Don’t miss this opportunity to see a friend or loved one come to know Jesus Christ. Go to your sphere of influence and compel people to come—urge them to come. Why? Because eternity is the biggest issue of all and we want to take as many people with us to heaven as possible.
