This Week: The lowa women's volleyball team (3-4) will travel to Madison, WI, to compete at the InnTowner Invitational. Iowa will face Duke (4-3) Friday at 5 p.m. and North Carolina State (5-3) Saturday at 5 p.m. Both matches will take place at the Wisconsin Field House.

The Blue Devils: Duke is 4-3 after a three-match sweep over Charlotte, Buffalo and Southern Illinois at the Duke Classic and a 3-0 sweep over East Carolina on Tuesday. The Blue Devils have only lost one game in their last four contests. Senior Tassy Rufai leads the team with 3.91 kills per game. Senior Katie Gilman is averaging 3.95 digs. Junior setter Stephanie Istvan is averaging 12.14 assists. Senior Krista Dill is averaging 1.8 blocks per game and has a total of 38 solo blocks this season.

Iowa-Duke Series: The Iowa-Duke series is tied at I-I. In matches at neutral sites, the Blue Devils lead I-0. In their last meeting, the Blue Devils defeated the Hawkeyes (3-1) in Gainesville, FL (8/13/96).

The Wolfpack: North Carolina State is 5-3 after a 3-0 win at North Carolina A&T. Last weekend the Wolfpack won two of three matches at the Outback Wolfpack Classic. North Carolina State defeated High Point and Virginia Tech and lost to Texas Christian. Freshman Julia Reis leads the team with 3.57 kills per game. Senior Caroline Frede is averaging three digs. Senior setter Crystal Shannon is averaging 10.93 assists. Junior Sarah Ensminger leads the team with a 1.11 blocks per game average.

lowa-NC State Series: Saturday will mark the first meeting between the two schools.

lowa Swept by Drake, 3-0: The Hawkeyes dropped their fourth match of the season Tuesday night in a 3-0 loss to intrastate rival Drake. Game one proved to be a fierce competition with the Bulldogs edging lowa,

33-31. The second game was also a backand-forth battle with Drake edging the Hawkeyes 30-28. After intermission lowa lost momentum, registering only nine kills in a 30-19 loss to give Drake the match.

Hawkeyes Go I-2 at Cyclone Challenge: lowa lost to Iowa State and Kentucky and recorded a win over Western Illinois at the Cyclone Challenge. Kentucky took the tournament title and Iowa State finished runner-up. The Hawkeyes began the tournament with a 3-I loss to the Cyclones. Iowa lost the first two games against Iowa State (30-19, 30-26), then rallied after intermission to take game three (30-24). The Hawkeyes' comeback wasn't enough as they lost game four (30-20) and the match. Iowa fought a close battle with Kentucky throughout the entire match. The Hawkeyes were edged in the first game (30-26) and then rebounded in games two and three (30-28, 30-27) to take a 2-1 lead. Kentucky fought back and went on to take game four (30-22) and five (15-8) to claim the match. lowa finished the tournament in style with a 3-0 (30-17, 30-16, 30-21) sweep of Western Illinois. The Hawkeyes posted their best hitting percentage of the season at .378 (58-13-119).

Simpson Named to All-Tourney Team: Junior Laura Simpson received all-tournament honors at the Cyclone Challenge. Against Iowa State Simpson posted 14 kills, nine digs and four total blocks. She recorded eight kills, two service aces and four digs against Kentucky. Simpson's best match occurred against Western Illinois where she registered 20 kills while committing only three errors in 35 attempts for a .486 hitting percentage. She also recorded four digs.

Bates Emerges For Career Weekend: Senior Louise Bates earned her first two career Hawkeyes starts, playing at right side against Kentucky and Western Illinois. Bates posted career numbers with seven kills and five total blocks against Kentucky and 16 digs against Western Illinois.

Giese Solid Against State Rivals: Junior Carolyn Giese continued her solid play against intrastate rivals, with a career-high 18 kills against Drake. The mark broke her previous career-high of 15 kills set at Iowa State last Friday. Against the Cyclones, Giese also tied a career-best eight digs.

Freshmen See First Action: Freshmen Aabria Lipscomb, Chelsey Garrett and Meredith Stach each saw their first collegiate action last weekend at the Cyclone Challenge.

Double the Fun: Senior Jitka Stehnova has recorded a double-double in five of seven matches this season. She currently leads the team with 10.48 assists and seven service aces.

Costanzo Provides Impact: Freshman Tiana Costanzo has provided a big spark in only five matches of collegiate competition. Costanzo has recorded double figures in digs in six of seven contests. She currently leads the team with a 3.17 digs per game average.

Marathon Matches: The Hawkeyes have played three five-game matches this season. Iowa only played one five-game match last season (at Purdue 11/1/02). Iowa is I-2 in five-game matches this season. The Hawkeyes have competed in two four-game matches and have a I-I record. Iowa has played two three-game matches this season and is I-I.

In Big Ten Rankings: The Hawkeyes are tied with Penn State with a league-leading 16.83 digs per game. Tiana Costanzo is 10th with 3.17 digs per game. Junior Pam Kavadas is 11th with 3.03 digs and Jitka Stehnova ranks 13th with a 2.93 digs per game average. Laura Simpson is 14th in kills with a 3.93 average.

In Iowa Rankings: Jitka Stehnova is currently fifth in Iowa's all-time assists with 1,430. Pam Kavadas is 20th in career digs (665). Carolyn Giese is 18th in all-time attack percentage at .206 (349-156-936).

International Experience: Assistant Coach Chris Gonzalez served as an assistant coach for the USA women's national team that won the bronze medal match of the Pan American Games. Tiana Costanzo competed for the USA youth squad that spent the summer competing in Montreal. Laura Simpson competed for the Australian national team against Japan

and participated in the Thang Long championship against Vietnam, Malaysia, Singapore, Kazakhstan and Thailand.

Home Grown Hawkeyes: The lowa roster features five Hawkeyes from the state of lowa. Abby Tjaden is from Eldora, Carolyn Giese Dubuque, Lastascia Granger Waterloo and April Mech and Betsy Cordt Davenport.

The Long Beach State Connection: Head Coach Rita Buck-Crockett and assistant coaches Chris Gonzalez and Melissa Ohta all have ties to the Long Beach State program. Buck-Crockett served as an assistant coach from 1986-88. Gonzalez served as the 49ers' assistant coach from 1997-2002 and was part of three final four teams, including the 1998 national champion squad that went undefeated (36-0). Ohta was a competitor on each of the final four teams as one of the nation's top defensive specialists from 1997-2000.

Quoting Buck-Crockett: "We improved on offense over the weekend. We are disappointed we didn't come away with three wins, but we are showing improvement. We will also face a high level of competition this weekend at the InnTowner Invitational. We are trying to gain some consistency and work to where our girls are playing at a high level with consistent averages."



Head Coach Rita Buck-Crockett

Buck-Crockett is in her sixth season as head coach. She has compiled an overall record of 47-103 (.315) and a Big Ten record of 24-76

(.240). Buck-Crockett has spent the past four summers as a member of the USA Volleyball High Performance staff. She was a member of the 1980 and 1984 USA Olympic teams. Buck-Crockett has played and coached at the international level in Japan, Italy and Switzerland. In the spring of 1999, she was inducted into the San Antonio Sports Hall of Fame.
