New Rules For '08 • The NCAA has implemented some new rules that will go into effect for the 2008 season that reflect international volleyball rules.

The term "game" has been changed to "set." Matches will still be the best of five "sets."

The first four "sets" will also be played to 25 points instead of 30 points. The fifth set will still be played to 15 points.

Teams will also be limited to 12 substitutions per "set."

New Era at Iowa • Head Coach Sharon Dingman will coach her first match in Black and Gold this weekend. Dingman was hired as the eighth coach in volleyball history March 21, 2008.

Dingman comes to Iowa from Illinois State, where she served as head coach from 2000-07. Dingman led the Redbirds to the NCAA Tournament last season and she helped Illinois State produce winning seasons in seven of its last eight seasons.

Dingman's assistant coaches are **Chris Gaskill** and **Jason Allen**. Gaskill served as an assistant under Dingman last season at Illinois State while Allen recently spent one year as the 16U Head Coach for the Texas Tornadoes club team, which is considered one of the best volleyball clubs in the country.

Angie Mlinar is in her first season as the Director of Volleyball Operations. She came to Iowa City after serving as the Director of Volleyball Operations at Alabama for two seasons.

Scouting Nicholls State • The Nicholls State Colonels return seven players from last year's squad that went 8-24 overall and 2-14 in South-land Conference play.

The Colonels return their libero (Enjoli Ford), setter (Amy Whitehead) and seniors on both the outside (Mallory McInnis) and in the middle (Chelsey Adams).

This will be the first meeting between the two teams.

Scouting Western Kentucky • The Western Kentuck Lady Toppers are receiving votes in the CBS College Sports Network/AVCA Disivion I Coaches Top 25 Preseason poll.

Western Kentucky became the first ever Sun Belt team to receive an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament last season after going 27-9 and reaching the Sun Belt Tournament championship game. The Lady Toppers return three-time all-American middle blocker Megan Argabright along with four other starters.

lowa leads the all-time series, 1-0.

Scouting Alabama • The Alabama Crimson Tide are coming off their third-straight NCAA Tournament appearance after receiving an at-large bid last season.

Alabama, who finished 15-15 overall and 12-8 in the Southeastern Conference, return nine letterwinners and have an incoming class that was rated in the top 30 by PrepVolleyball.com.

Iowa trails in the all-time series, 0-1.

Tough Schedule in '08 • The Hawkeyes will face five teams ranked in the CBS College Sports Network/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 preseason poll. Four additional teams are also listed as receiving votes. Iowa will also square off against 10 teams that qualified for the NCAA Tournament in 2007.

Opponents ranked include Penn State (No. 1), Wisconsin (No. 13), Minnesota (No. 16), Iowa State (No. 18) and Purdue (No. 25). Opponents receiving votes are Michigan, Michigan State, Illinois and Western Kentucky.

The 10 teams who played in the NCAA Tournament last year are Western Kentucky, Alabama, Iowa State, Xavier, Minnesota, Purdue, Wisconsin, Michigan, Michigan State and Penn State, who also won the 2007 Big Ten and NCAA championship.



Head Coach Sharon Dingman



Sharon Dingman was hired as the eighth coach in Iowa volleyball history March 21, 2008.

Dingman comes to Iowa after serving as head coach at Illinois State from 2000-07, where she compiled a 147-98 record. In 2007, Dingman led the Redbirds to their first at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament since 1997 after reaching the championship match

of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and finished with a 21-12 overall record.

Illinois State produced winning seasons in seven of the eight seasons under Dingman and never finished lower than fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Redbirds also reached at least the semifinals of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament in six of her eight seasons. Dingman produced 21 all-Missouri Valley Conference selections, including Player of the Year, Libero of the Year and two Freshman of the Year honorees. Two players also garnered all-district and all-region honors.

Redbird teams under Dingman were also strong in the classroom. Eleven players were named to the league's scholarathlete squad in her eight seasons and in 2004, four volleyball student-athletes earned perfect 4.00 grade-point-averages and the team recorded a 3.32 GPA. In 2005, her volleyball team won the academic award for the highest GPA in the athletic department.

Dingman started her head coaching career in 1991 at Auburn, where she led the Tigers to a 22-13 record in her only season at the helm. Her 1991 squad become the first Auburn volleyball tem to receive votes in the national poll and Auburn's fourth place finish in the SEC that season marked the highest finish ever for Auburn at the time. Two studentathletes earned all-SEC honors, including Jenifer Kleyn, who was named the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was an NCAA post-graduate scholarship recipient who carried a 4.0 GPA.

She then moved to Butler in 1992, where she served as head coach for eight seasons. Dingman led the Bulldogs to four 20 win seasons and three postseason tournaments, including an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 1997 after capturing the Midwestern Collegiate Conference title. She was named MCC Coach of the Year in 1997 after compiling a 28-7 record. Dingman guided three student-athletes to MCC Player of the Year honors, seven to all-region accolades and five to "Top 100 Student" honors at Butler.

Prior to becoming a head coach, Dingman spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at three Division I programs. After one season at Northern Michigan (1984), she assisted at Texas Tech for three seasons (1985-87). Dingman then spent three seasons at Kentucky (1988-90) and helped the Wildcats to an SEC Championship in 1988 along with three-straight regional finals appearances in the NCAA Tournament. **Loads of Returning Talent** • The 2008 Hawkeyes return all six starters and 13 letterwinners from last year's squad, including all statistical leaders from the previous season.

Junior **Megan Schipper** led the team in kills (309) while redshirt sophomore **Becky Walters** had a teamhigh .265 attack percentage. Senior **Kiley Fister** amassed a team-best 918 assists and 27 service aces. Senior **Emily Hiza** returns after leading the team with 493 digs while senior **Laura Kremer** was the team's leading blocker, with 140 total blocks.
