## WIN NO. 300 AT HOME

The UI women's basketball program picked up victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 304-88 (.776) record inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

## SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE

The Michigan State Spartans are 15-1 overall and 3-0 in Big Ten play. Michigan State's only loss was at Baylor (52-78), who is currently ranked No. 1 in the nation. Michigan State has won 13-straight games.

In their last game, the Spartans knocked off Michigan, 63-56 in Ann Arbor. Lykendra Johnson scored 17 points, grabbed 17 rebounds and recorded four steals to pace Michigan State. Brittney Thomas added 13 points, seven rebounds and four assists, while Kalisha Keane had 12 points.

Keane leads the team with 16.2 points per game. She is followed by Johnson at 10.3 points per contest. Johnson is also the team's best rebounder, averaging 7.9 boards per contest.

Michigan State leads the Big Ten in scoring defense (52.4 per game), scoring margin (+18.1), field goal percentage defense (.362), three-pointers made (7.4 per game), rebounding allowed (32.8 per game), rebounding margin (+8.5), offensive rebounds (15.1 per game) and steals (11.1 per game).

As a team, the Spartans are shooting .435 (418-960) from the field, including .349 (118-338) from three-point distance.

## IOWA VS. MICHIGAN STATE NOTES

- Thursday will be the 56th meeting between Iowa and Michigan State, with the Hawkeyes leading the all-time series, 32-23. Iowa has won three of the last four meetings, but Michigan State has won nine of the previous 13 contests. Iowa is 13-12 in games played in East Lansing. Iowa's last win at the Breslin Center was Feb. 1, 2004 (78-67).
- Iowa won both meetings last year, including a 77-66 win in Iowa City and a 59-54 victory in the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament.
- Two of the top rebounding teams in the Big Ten will meet Thursday. Iowa leads the league in overall rebounding (42.9 per game), while Michigan State ranks third (41.3 per game). The Spartans and Hawkeyes are first and second, respectively, in rebounding margin (+8.5, +6.3) and offensive rebounds (15.1, 14.5).

## 2010-11 Team Captains

Iowa captains are senior Kelsey Cermak and junior Kamille Wahlin.

### **LAST MEETING**

Iowa defeated Michigan State, 59-54, in the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament.

Iowa trailed by one point at halftime, but put together a solid second half for the win. Iowa converted all 12 free throw attempts in the second half, and turned 15 offensive rebounds in 19 second chance points.

Four Hawkeyes scored double figures, including Kachine Alexander (14), Kamille Wahlin (13), Trisha Nesbitt (10) and Jaime Printy (10).

### **JOHNSON'S BLOCK PARTY AGAINST MICHIGAN STATE**

With three blocks against Michigan State in the Big Ten Tournament last season, Morgan Johnson set both the school and freshman record for single-season blocks. Three previous record of 73 was held by Tangela Smith (1994-95). Johnson finished last season with 79 blocks.

### **IOWA IN THE RANKINGS**

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 16 in the AP poll and No. 20 in the ESPN/USA Today poll.

Four Iowa opponents are also ranked in the AP and the ESPN/USA Today polls: Michigan State (9/10), North Carolina (11/11), Iowa State (17/16) and Ohio State (24/24).

Michigan is receiving votes.

### **HAWKEYES TOP OHIO STATE**

Iowa used a solid shooting performance and a balanced scoring attack to knock off No. 20 Ohio State, 89-76 Saturday inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

The Hawkeyes recorded season-highs in field goal (.492) and three-point (.421) percentages. Iowa shot a blistering .500 (6-12) from beyond the arc in the first half and .517 (15-29) from the field in the second half.

Four Iowa players scored double figures, led by Jaime Printy's 25 points (8-10 FGs). Kamille Wahlin added 18 points and four assists, while Kachine Alexander scored 16 points and grabbed 13 rebounds. Morgan Johnson added 10 points, six rebounds, three assists and three blocks.

### **BIG GAME AGAINST THE BUCKEYES**

Jaime Printy's 25 points against Ohio State (Jan. 8) were the most for a Hawkeye player against the Buckeyes in nearly five years.

The last player to score 25 or more points against Ohio State was Crystal Smith, who recorded 26 points against the Buckeyes Jan. 12, 2006, in a 72-62 loss.

### **SEFING DOUBLE**

Kachine Alexander recorded her fourth double-double of the season against Ohio State (Jan. 8), finishing with 16 points and 13 rebounds.

Alexander now has 28 career double-doubles, which is seven shy of Lisa Long's school record for double-doubles (35, set from 1983-87).

Last season, Alexander finished with 15 double-doubles, which was one shy of tying Amy Herring's record for single-season double-doubles.

Alexander tallied nine double-doubles as a sophomore.

## Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 559-268 (.676), including a 203-126 (.617) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

### KASH GETS A GRAND

With a layup at the 11:54 mark in the first half against Minnesota (Jan. 5), senior Kachine Alexander became the 27th player in school history to record 1,000 career points.

Alexander is also the eighth player in school history to collect 1,000 career points and 700 career rebounds, and just the third in school history to record 1,000 career points, 700 career rebounds and 200 career assists.

If Alexander records 22 more assists, she would join Franthea Price as the only player in Iowa history to have 1,000 career points, 700 career rebounds and 300 career assists.

### HANSEN STEPS UP IN THE CLUTCH

Junior college transfer Kalli Hansen had her best game in a Hawkeye uniform against Minnesota (Jan. 5).

Hansen scored seven points and grabbed eight rebounds in 19 minutes of action. Her three-pointer with 3:10 remaining tied the game at 53, and her two free throws at the 2:54 mark gave Iowa the lead for good. Hansen missed two free throws with 13 seconds remaining that would have put Iowa up five, but she recorded a steal and sank her next two free throws to ice the game.

### DOUBLE TROUBLE

Morgan Johnson recorded her fifth double-double of the season and the eighth double-double of her career against Minnesota (Jan. 5). Johnson finished the game with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

### JOHNSON AT .500 OR BETTER

If Morgan Johnson takes eight or more shots in a game, chances are she will make at least half of them.

Johnson has attempted eight or more shots in 13 of Iowa's 17 games this year. In those 13 games, Johnson has shot .500 or better nine times.

Johnson has attempted 10 or more shots six times, shooting .500 or better in all but one game. Johnson was 8-13 (.615) against Northeastern, 10-16 (.625) against Central Michigan, 8-11 (.727) vs. Iowa State, 9-12 (.750) vs. South Dakota State and 5-10 (.500) vs. Michigan and Ohio State.

She was 4-12 (.333) at Minnesota.

### JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET

Morgan Johnson scored double figures over a tough four game-stretch, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 Iowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

### BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Iowa is one of only three teams in the Big Ten to have four players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the conference.

Iowa, Ohio State and Northwestern and each have four players ranked. Penn State, Wisconsin and Indiana have three, while the remaining five schools have either one or two players ranked.

The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in 16 of the 17 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan, Kansas State, Minnesota and Ohio State.

### HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS

Iowa's rebounding numbers through its first 16 games are impressive. The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in total rebounding (42.9 per game) and rank second in rebounding margin (+6.3), offensive rebounds (14.5 per game) and defensive rebounds (28.4 per game).

Morgan Johnson and Kachine Alexander are tied for second in the league in offensive rebounding (3.5 per game). Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are the second most for any Big Ten player this season.

### REBOUNDING NUMBERS IMPROVED FROM A YEAR AGO

Iowa's rebounding has improved greatly from a year ago.

Through 17 games last year, Iowa had a -0.1 rebound margin. The Hawkeyes were being outrebounded, 657-658, including a 206-213 deficit on the offensive glass.

This year through 17 games, Iowa holds a +6.3 rebounding margin and is outrebounding opponents 729-622. That includes a 247-204 advantage on the offensive glass.

### TOP FIVE IN THE BIG TEN

Three of Iowa's starters rank in the top five in the Big Ten in different statistical categories.

- Morgan Johnson is tied for second in offensive rebounds (3.5 per game) and ranks third in blocks (2.5 per game).
- Kachine Alexander is tied for second in offensive rebounds (3.5 per game) and ranks third in total rebounding (9.4 per game).
- Jaime Printy ranks second in three-pointers made (2.3 per game) and fourth in free throw percentage (.875).

### MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (28), eighth in career rebounding (774), 13th in career assists (278) and 26th in career scoring (1,029). She needs 16 more rebounds to move past Amy Herrig for seventh place on the rebounding list and one assist to tie Laurie Aaron and Necole Tunsil for 12th on the assists list. She needs eight more double-doubles to take over first place (Lisa Long, 35).
- Morgan Johnson ranks fourth in career blocks (121) and needs 25 more to move past Toni Foster into third place.
- Kamille Wahlin ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (140) and needs 17 more to move past Leah Magner into fourth place.
- Jaime Printy ranks eighth in career three-pointers made (121) and needs five more to move past Johanna Solverson for seventh place.

#### BLUDER REACHES MILESTONE

With a 75-71 win at Drake Dec. 20, Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder became only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 201 wins in her 11 years at Iowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at Iowa, finishing her time in Iowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

#### ALEXANDER NAMED CO-BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week, Nov. 22, for her efforts against Bradley, Northeastern and Central Michigan. Alexander shared the weekly honor with Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of Iowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander has now been named Big Ten Player of the Week five times in her career. She was a two-time award winner as both a sophomore and junior.

#### ALEXANDER ON WATCH LISTS

Senior Kachine Alexander has been named to the watch lists for the Wade Trophy, the Wooden Award and the Naismith Trophy. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players, the Wooden Award includes 30 student-athletes and the Naismith Trophy watch list is made up of 50 players.

The Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy are considered the three most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

Alexander is also one of 30 Division I women's basketball players nationally to be selected as a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible, the candidates must show excellence in four categories: community, classroom, character and competition.

#### SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last year marked the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

Iowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.

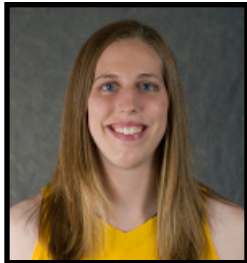
