EVANSTON, IL – The Iowa women's tennis team lost a close match to Ohio State, 4-3, Saturday afternoon. The Buckeyes advanced to the Big Ten championship match.

The Hawkeyes were unable to take the doubles point, losing two matches at the No. 1 and No. 3 positions. At No. 5 singles, **Deni Alexandrova** topped Lindsey Adams, 7-5, 7-5.
