



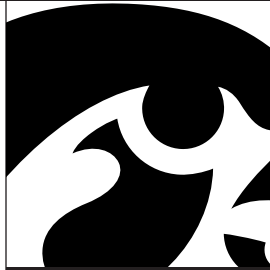

LEADING OFF

- The Hawkeyes are in the midst of a season-long 10-game home stand. Iowa is 6-1 at Banks Field this season and 39-11 at home since the start of the 2015 season.
- Sophomore Zach Daniels is the reigning Big Ten Pitcher of the Week. He earned the distinction after going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA in two victories last week, striking out nine in 5 2/3 innings of relief.
- Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in runs (Mason McCoy, 26), RBIs (Jake Adams, 31), home runs (Jake Adams, 9), doubles (Mason McCoy, 9), slugging percentage (Jake Adams, .678), and total bases (Jake Adams, 61). Sophomore Robert Neustrom is also second in the B1G in RBIs (28) and hits (36), and third in batting average (.379).
- Iowa is 7-3 over its last 10 games, moving the team's record to a season-high five games over .500. The Hawkeyes are hitting .307 during the stretch with five regulars hitting over .300.
- UI head coach Rick Heller joined the 800 career win club March 12 when the Hawkeyes won a doubleheader against Lehigh at the Snowbird Classic.
- Iowa ranks in the top five in the Big Ten in nine different offensive categories. The Hawkeyes are second in batting average, third in slugging and on-base percentage, RBIs, and walks, fourth in runs and hits, and fifth in doubles and home runs.
- Iowa ranks second in the Big Ten and 17th nationally with a .981 team fielding percentage.

Iowa native Rick Heller is entering his fourth season as head coach of the University of Iowa baseball program. Heller was tabbed as the 20th head coach in program history on July 12, 2013.

Heller, an Eldon, Iowa, native, has been head coach at four institutions -- Iowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99) -- leading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

In 2015, Heller guided the Hawkeyes to an at-large berth into NCAA Regional play and posted the school's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972. He led Indiana State to its first outright Missouri Valley Conference title in 2012, and Northern Iowa to the MVC title and into the NCAA Tournament in 2001, the first and only regional appearance for the Panthers as a Division I program.

Heller has rejuvenated the Iowa program in just three seasons, going 101-67, making him the winningest coach in his first three seasons in school history. He is the first Iowa coach to lead the program to the postseason in three consecutive years, he has coached at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection each season, and has 11 Major League Baseball Draft picks in three seasons -- the most in a three-year stretch since 1991-93.

The success has translated on the recruiting trail, where Heller has turned the Hawkeyes into a major player on the national recruiting scene. Iowa had the top-rated class in the Big Ten -- and 18th-best nationally -- in 2015, and the 2016 class was ranked third in the league.

In 30 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 805-641-4. He is one of two Iowa head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament.

THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa baseball team continues its season-long 10-game homestand with a three-game nonconference series against UNLV from March 31-April 2 at Duane Banks Field. Friday's series opener will begin at 4:05 p.m. (CT), Saturday's game is set for 2:05 p.m., and the series finale will start at 11:05 a.m.

GAME COVERAGE

- All three games will be carried on select stations around the state via the Hawkeye Radio Network and be streamed online via Hawkeye All-Access with Zach Mackey and Steve Duncan on the call.
- The duration of the series will be available on AM-800 KXIC in Iowa City and WDBQ in Dubuque; Sunday's games will also be on KKFD in Fairfield.
- All three games of the series will be carried on BTN Plus on BTN2Go.
- Live statistics will be available at www.hawkeyesports.com and fans can follow the action via Twitter/UIBaseball.

IOWA TIDBITS

- Iowa will use the same rotation for a second straight weekend with Nick Gallagher taking the ball Friday, Ryan Erickson on Saturday, and Cole McDonald on Sunday.
- Iowa is averaging 6.9 runs and hitting .307 as a team over its last 10 games. Five players are hitting over .300 with senior Mason McCoy leading the way with a .417 average during the stretch. Jake Adams and Robert Neustrom have 17 RBIs apiece in the 10 games.
- The Hawkeyes have overcome deficits in seven of their 14 victories this season.
- Iowa hit two grand slams -- one from Tyler Cropley and one from Robert Neustrom -- in a 12-1 midweek victory over Bradley on March 22. It was the team's third grand slam of the season. The Hawkeyes have 21 home runs as a team to rank fifth in the Big Ten.
- The Hawkeyes have had 10 or more hits in 11 games this season and have scored 10 or more runs in five contests. Iowa has scored seven or more runs in 11 games.

UNLV NOTABLES

- UNLV brings a 10-17 overall record into its three-game series at Iowa. The Rebels are 2-8 away from the Sin City in 2017.
- The Rebels have lost eight straight games since winning the series opener at San Diego State on March 17. The streak includes two losses at No. 3 Texas Tech, three against New Mexico, and a Tuesday defeat at Arizona State.
- Offensively, UNLV boasts a .301 team batting average and the Rebels average 5.8 runs per game. The team has 71 extra base hits, including 50 doubles. Six regulars are hitting over .300 with Ernie De La Trinidad hitting a team-best .374.

Justin Jones has 26 RBIs and a .347 average, while Nick Ames has five home runs and 25 RBIs.

- On the mound, the Rebels have a 5.68 team ERA, allowing 185 runs on 273 hits over 240 2/3 innings. Opponents are hitting .285 against the Rebels' staff.
- The Rebels will start junior RHP Alan Strong (3-1, 4.91 ERA) on Friday, sophomore LHP Tevita Gerber (2-4, 6.46 ERA) on Saturday, and junior LHP Garrett Poole (2-3, 5.55 ERA) on Sunday.
- UNLV's defense hasn't helped its pitchers, committing 40 errors in 27 games for a .963 team fielding percentage.
- The Rebels are led by Lowden, Iowa, native Stan Stolte, who is in his second season as UNLV's head coach. Stolte played collegiately at St. Ambrose College before beginning his coaching career at Clarence-Lowden (Iowa) High School. Stolte also coached in-state at Muscatine Community College.
- UNLV's volunteer assistant/pitching coach is MLB Hall of Famer Greg Maddux. Maddux's son, Chase, is a sophomore reliever for the Rebels.

SERIES RECORD

- This is the first meeting all-time between UNLV and Iowa.
- The Hawkeyes are 12-33 all-time against current Mountain West Conference schools -- Air Force (3-1), Colorado State (0-1), Fresno State (1-3), New Mexico (3-11), San Diego State (1-1), Wyoming (4-6).
- Iowa swept a two-game midweek series (9-7, 22-2) against Air Force last season in Iowa City.

DANIELS EARNS WEEKLY HONOR

Sophomore Zach Daniels was named the Big Ten Pitcher of the Week on March 27 following a week where he went 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA with nine strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings. It was Daniels' second career weekly honor as he was Big Ten Freshman of the Week last season.

STAFF SHINES

Iowa's pitching staff had its best weekend of the season, posting a 1.67 team ERA in its three-game series against Purdue. The Hawkeyes gave up just five runs in three games and limited the Boilermakers to a 2.50 average. The team had 30 strikeouts during the weekend.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS

- Iowa is out-scoring its opponents, 28-11, in the first inning this season. The Hawkeyes are 7-2 when scoring first.
- Over the first three innings, Iowa is out-scoring its opposition, 64-33.
- The Hawkeyes are 12-0 when scoring six or more runs this season. Iowa is 2-9 when scoring five runs or less.
- Iowa is 8-3 when hitting a home run this



season. The team is 7-0 when hitting two or more long balls.
 • The Hawkeyes are 12-2 when leading after six innings, 11-1 after seven innings, and 12-1 after eight innings this season.

HELLER WINS NO. 800

UI head coach Rick Heller won the 800th game of his collegiate coaching career when the Hawkeyes swept a March 12 doubleheader over Lehigh at the Snowbird Baseball Classic.

#SWINGFASTER

The Hawkeyes are fifth in the Big Ten with 21 home runs this season. Nine different players have hit at least one home run.
 • Iowa had 26 home runs in 56 games during the 2016 season.

GOING, GOING...

Junior Jake Adams hit his Big Ten-leading ninth home run of the season in Iowa's 6-5 victory over Grand View on March 28.
 • The South Dakota native is sixth nationally with nine home runs. The leader is Eastern Kentucky's Ben Fisher with 13.
 • Adams hit three home runs (and had seven RBIs) in Iowa's 12-11, 10-inning victory at Kansas State on March 19. Adams is the first Hawkeye since Jason White in 2007 to hit three home runs in the same game.
 • Adams is one of five Big Ten players to hit three home runs in a game this season.
 • Iowa's single-season home run record is 22, set by John Knapp in 1986. Jason White is the last Hawkeye to hit at least 10 home runs (2007). The high of the Rick Heller era is nine by Taylor Zeutenhorst in 2014.
 • Adams hit a school-record 25 home runs last year during his All-America season at DMACC. In two junior-college seasons, Adams hit 42 career home runs -- a school record.

FLIP-FLOP

Jake Adams and Robert Neustrom flip-flopped spots in Iowa's batting order after Purdue pitched around Adams in the March 24 series opener. In the three games since, Adams is hitting .500 with three RBIs in the three-hole, while Neustrom has a .400 average with five RBIs as the cleanup hitter.

A WHOLE LOTTA RBIS

Senior Jake Adams drove in seven runs (on three home runs) in Iowa's 12-11 victory over Kansas State on March 19. It was Adams' second game with six or more RBIs this season. The South Dakota native has a Big Ten-best 31 RBIs on the year. He ranks 17th nationally in RBIs.
 • Adams has at least one RBI in 14 games; Iowa is 12-2 when Adams has at least one RBI.

• Sophomore Robert Neustrom had a career-best four hits and five RBIs to complete Iowa's doubleheader sweep of Lehigh on March 12. Neustrom has two games with four or more RBIs and his 28 RBIs are second-most in the Big Ten.

NEUSTROM PRODUCES

Sophomore Robert Neustrom has hit safely in all but three games this season (20-of-23 games). The outfielder opened the year with a career-best 11-game hitting streak.
 • Neustrom's 36 hits are second-most in the Big Ten and he has team-high 12 multi-hit games. His .379 average is third in the conference and he has 16 runs and 28 RBIs. He has six games this season with two or more RBIs and has driven in at least one run in 14 games. Iowa is 10-4 when Neustrom has at least one RBI.
 • He tallied his first career four-hit game against Lehigh, finishing 4-for-5 with a career-best five RBIs.
 • The Sioux City, Iowa native, has a career-best three home runs, including a three-run shot in Iowa's road loss at Minnesota and a grand slam against Bradley.
 • Neustrom had 12 multi-hit games the entire 2016 season -- a season where he hit .307 as a true freshman.

MCCOY: THE SHORTSTOP

Senior Mason McCoy is back at his natural position at shortstop; he's comfortable and producing. The Illinois native has 11 multi-hit games, hit safely in 18-of-23 games, and has scored at least one run in 16 contests.
 • McCoy is leading the Big Ten with 26 runs scored and ranks fifth in batting average.
 • McCoy was an Northwest League All-Star selection in both 2015 and 2016, playing for the La Crosse Loggers.
 • Iowa has had an all-conference selection at shortstop in each of Rick Heller's first three seasons. (Jake Yacinich, first-team, 2014; Nick Roscetti, third-team, 2015, first-team, 2016).

NORMAN TAKES HOLD

Freshman Ben Norman has started Iowa's last 16 games in the outfield, primarily in center field. The Des Moines, Iowa, native is hitting .347 with seven multi-hit games. Norman's seven doubles are tied for seventh in the Big Ten.
 • Since becoming Iowa's everyday center fielder, Norman is hitting .387 (24-of-62) with 24 hits, six doubles, 10 runs, and eight RBIs. He has seven multi-hit games.
 • Norman went 4-for-6 with two runs and two RBIs at Kansas State, which included a game-winning RBI double in the 10th inning of Iowa's 12-11 extra inning win at Kansas State.
 • Norman is also Iowa's top base-stealing threat, going 7-for-8 on the base paths this season.

OFFENSIVE TIDBITS

- Junior Jake Adams has hit safely in 17-of-23 games this season, including posting 11 multi-hit games. The South Dakota native has four multi-hit games in Iowa's last six contests.
- Junior Austin Guzzo went 2-for-2 with two runs and a solo home run in Iowa's 6-5 win over Grand View. It was his first multi-hit game of the season.
- Freshman Justin Jenkins had his first career two-RBI game in Iowa's game two win over Purdue. He had a game-tying sacrifice fly and added an RBI single in the victory.
- Junior Chris Whelan is hitting .338 with 17 runs and seven RBIs. The outfielder has eight multi-hit games, including multi-hit games in three of the last five games where he is hitting .412 with seven hits. As Iowa's leadoff hitter, Whelan is hitting .412 with 21 hits and 10 runs scored.

- Heller has coached at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection each season, and has 11 Major League Baseball Draft picks in three seasons -- the most in a three-year stretch since 1991-93.

- Iowa has posted winning streaks of nine games (in 2015) and seven games (in 2014) -- the longest streaks for the program since 2012.
