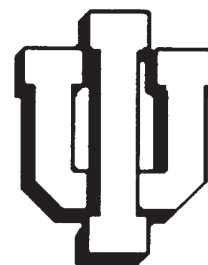

The University of Iowa soccer team heads to Evanston, Ill. to compete against the Northwestern Wildcats. The match, set for Thursday night, will kick off at 7 p.m.

Sunday afternoon, the Hawkeyes will be in action in Iowa City. Head Coach Ron Rainey and the Hawkeyes welcome the Indiana Hoosiers to the Iowa Soccer Complex for a Big Ten face off that will be featured live on the Big Ten Network. Game time is slated for 2 p.m.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

Northwestern goes into Thursday night's game with a 5-7-3 overall record. The Wildcats are 1-4-1 in league play with their sole win coming Sept. 24 over Indiana, 2-1.

Freshman Kate Allen leads Head Coach Stephanie Foster's attacking force. Allen has recorded five of the team's 16 goals as well as earning an assist.

In goal for the Wildcats is senior Carolyn Edwards. Experience has been key for Edwards, as she has made 56 saves and recorded three shutouts in 15 games.

Indiana arrives in Iowa City with a 4-10-1 record on the season, 0-6-0 in conference competition. Upperclassmen leadership has boosted the Hoosiers, offensively. Junior Carly Samp and sophomore Oriánica Velasquez have scored seven and six goals, respectively. Samp has also been

UNDERCLASSMEN EFFORTS LEAD IOWA

Hawkeye rookies are playing nothing like rookies. The underclassmen efforts this season have boosted the women's soccer team offensively on a consistent basis.

Seven of Iowa's top-nine stat leaders are either freshmen or sophomores. The leading points scorer is Hawkeye newcomer Leah DeMoss, a St. Charles, Ill. native.

DeMoss tops the scoring list with five goals and three assists for 13 points. Sophomores Jade Grimm, three goals and four assists, and Dana Dalrymple, three goals and two assists, fall into the second and third places on the stat sheet with 10 and eight, respectively.

Junior Morgan Showalter also has eight points on the season with three goals and two assists, while fellow junior Alyssa Cosnek falls in line with seven points.

Freshman Alex Melin and sophomore Gabrielle Ainsworth have five points, each has two goals and an assist. Rounding out the top-nine are freshman Ashley Catrell, two goals, and sophomore Stefani Campbell, one goal and two assists, with four points.
