GAME #3 STORYLINES

- Iowa has won 39 of its last 40 nonconference home games, dating back to 2012.
- Seton Hall is the last team to have beaten 2016 NCAA champion Villanova. The Pirates downed the Wildcats (69-67) in the championship game of the BIG EAST Tournament.
- Senior Peter Jok scored 27 points in Iowa's season opening win over Kennesaw State. The 27 points are the most by a Hawkeye in a season opener since Adam Haluska poured in 29 against The Citadel in 2006.
- Freshman Tyler Cook (10) joined Aaron White as the only two players to grab 10 or more rebounds in their first game as a Hawkeye in the past 20 years.
- Freshman Cordell Pemsil scored in double digits each of his first two contests. In two games, Pemsil is averaging 14 points and 7.5 rebounds. In Sunday's win, Pemsil netted 18 points making every shot (7-of-7 FG, 4-of-4 FT) and snagging a team-best nine rebounds.
- Iowa scored 116 points Sunday against Savannah State -- the most in the Fran McCaffery era. The 116 points equal the seventh most points scored in a single game in program history.
- Iowa's 3-pointers made (18) and attempted (43) versus Savannah State on Sunday are new school records.
- Peter Jok was named to the preseason 10-player All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists.
- Iowa has competed in postseason play the last five years (NCAA 2014-16; NIT 2012-13).
- The Hawkeyes won 22 games, tied for third place in the Big Ten, and won an NCAA Tournament game each of the last two seasons.
- Iowa sold out 23 home games the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes ranked 19th in national attendance in 2015-16.
- Iowa has won 20 or more games in four consecutive seasons -- its longest streak in 15 years.
- Fran McCaffery has guided Iowa to upper division finishes in the Big Ten in each of the last four seasons. McCaffery, who is one of just 12 Division I head coaches to take four different programs to the NCAA Tournament, has accumulated 16 first division finishes in 20 years as a head coach. McCaffery has posted 10 seasons of 20 or more wins as a head coach.
- Iowa is 52-7 when scoring 80 points or more, the last six seasons. The Hawkeyes are 61-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last six years.

THE SETTING

Iowa (2-0) remains home on Thursday, hosting Seton Hall (2-0). Tipoff is set for 8:06 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Thursday's game is part of the second annual Gavitt Games.

Tickets are \$28 for adults and \$15 for youths and UI students. UI Faculty & Staff will be admitted FREE Thursday night, while their guests can purchase a ticket for only \$5.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin will handle the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Thursday's game will be televised nationally on BTN (BTN2GO). Brian Anderson and Jon Crispin will call the action.

ALL-TIME SERIES RESULTS

This will be the second meeting between the two schools. Iowa beat Seton Hall in the previous meeting, 85-63, on Dec. 29, 1982, in the Rochester Classic contested in Rochester, New York. Iowa is 39-33 all-time against current members in the BIG EAST.



GAVITT GAMES

The Gavitt Tipoff Games is an annual series between the Big Ten and BIG EAST conferences and named in honor of Dave Gavitt, founder of the BIG EAST and basketball visionary. The series is in its second year and will span eight years with games being played on home sites. Eight teams in the event advanced to the NCAA Tournament and won at least 20 games last season.

Iowa won last year's inaugural Gavitt Games contest, winning 89-61 at Marquette.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA ENHANCEMENTS

The Iowa Athletic Department upgraded Carver-Hawkeye Arena's video boards, sound system, lighting, digital scoretable displays, and playing surface this past summer.

A new four-sided centerhung video system is the centerpiece of the installation. The two main centerhung displays measure approximately 14.5 feet high by 26 feet wide and the other two centerhung displays measure 9.5 feet high by 16.5 feet wide. The project also upgraded the auxiliary displays located near the ceiling at each side of the arena.

HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his seventh season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 20th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four years.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 34th season as a collegiate coach in 2016, which includes 20 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant. McCaffery is one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 57, holds a career mark of 371-263 (.585) and guided his teams to 10 postseason appearances (seven NCAA and three NIT). He is 120-86 (.582) at Iowa. McCaffery has led Iowa to NCAA Tournament victories in each of the past two seasons, the first time Hawkeye teams have won tournament games in consecutive seasons since 1996-97.

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have earned five postseason tournament berths (3 NCAA, 2 NIT). McCaffery coached Iowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided five different Hawkeyes to all-conference honors, including three straight first team honorees. The last time Iowa had three consecutive first-team all-league honorees was 1946-48.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past four seasons at Iowa and 16 of 20 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by more than 50 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes boast a 58-12 home record the last four seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (.682, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

IOWA CRUISES TO WIN OVER SAVANNAH STATE

Iowa made a school-record 18 3-pointers en route to a 116-84 triumph over Savannah State Sunday afternoon on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

- Iowa surpassed the century mark for the 97th time in program history.
- All 13 players who saw action scored with four players reaching double figures: Brady Ellingson (23), Cordell PemsI (18), Tyler Cook (14), and Peter Jok (13).
- Sophomore Brady Ellingson scored a career-high 23 points (7-9 FG, 5-5 FT), scoring 21 of his 23 points in the first half.
- Iowa's bench scored 76 of its 116 points.
- Savannah State was outrebounding the Hawkeyes by eight (26-18) at half, but Iowa was +20 on the glass in the second half finishing the game with a +12 advantage (52-40).
- Nicholas Baer was credited with a career-high six assists. He also had nine points.

SCOUTING SETON HALL

- Like Iowa, Seton Hall opened with a pair of home wins to start the 2016-17 season. The Pirates beat Fairleigh Dickenson (91-70) and Central Connecticut (82-58).
- Khade Carrington is averaging a team-best 22.5 points, bolstered by a blistering 9-of-10 shooting (.900) from 3-point range. He shot 15-of-22 (.682) overall from the field the first two games combined.
- Junior Angel Delgado averages a double-double (18 points and 15 rebounds). He is shooting 73.9 percent (17-of-23) from the field.
- Seton Hall, who's starting lineup consists of four juniors and a senior, shoots at 56.1 percent clip from the field, but is 57.7 percent from the free throw line.
- The Pirates posted a 25-9 overall record and captured the 2016 BIG EAST Tournament title. Seton Hall competed in its 10th NCAA Tournament, ultimately losing to Gonzaga in the first round.
- Head coach Kevin Willard is in his seventh season on the Seton Hall sidelines (109-100) and his 10th season overall (154-139) as a head coach. Prior to being named the 19th head coach in Seton Hall history, he was head coach at Iona for three seasons. Willard was an assistant coach on Louisville's staff when Iowa beat the Cardinals in 2003 (Indianapolis) and 2004 (Maui).
- Seton Hall will log several miles traveling to three different states for nonconference competition: Iowa, Florida (3), and Hawaii (2).

PETER JOK ENTERS FINAL SEASON AS A HAWKEYE

After averaging seven points per game as a sophomore, Peter Jok surged 9.1 points last year as a junior averaging 16.1 points per contest. The +9.1 improvement was tops among Big Ten players. Jok's 16.1 scoring average ranks second among Big Ten players returning this season behind Illinois' Malcolm Hill (18.1 ppg).

Jok was named to the preseason 10-player All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists.

IOWA SIGNS 2 PREP STANDOUTS

Luka Garza and Jack Nunge have signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa in 2017.

Garza is a 6-foot-11, 240-pound forward from Maret School in Washington, D.C. Garza is a two-time first team All-DC, all-conference and second team Washington Post All-Met honoree. He scored more than 1,000 points and grabbed over 600 rebounds his first three years. Garza averaged 25.5 points, 12.6 rebounds, and 2.6 blocks as a junior, and 19.8 points and 9.8 rebounds his sophomore campaign. He helped Maret earn back-to-back conference championships (22-8 in 2014 and 22-5 in 2015). He was recognized as the 2014-15 Washington Post All-Met Most Improved Player. Garza averaged 11.3 points (54% FG, 36% 3-pt FG) and 6.5 rebounds last year in the EYBL.

Nunge is also 6-foot-11 and weighs 220 pounds. He hails from Newburgh, Indiana and attends Castle High School. Nunge earned first-team All-SIAC, IBCA Supreme 15 Underclassmen, and Indiana All Star-Core 6 honors following his junior campaign. He posted a team-best 18 double-doubles, and averaged 19.3 points (FG%: 57%, 3-pt FG%: 43%, FT%: 81%), 11.4 rebounds, and 3.7 blocks per game his junior season. He was named team Most Valuable Player in 2016. A two-time team captain, he tallied 35 points and 25 rebounds against Bosse High School, and 35 points and 22 rebounds versus Harrison High School his junior season. Nunge also excels in the classroom, boasting a 3.97 grade point average, ranks 20th in his class, and earned the Scholastic "C" Award. He is a member of the National Honor Society and Student Council. He played with the Pocket City AAU basketball team.

Jok ranked second on the team in scoring (16.1 ppg) and first in free throw accuracy (.852, 92-of-108). Jok made 28 straight free throws before missing in the win over Temple (3-of-5). He scored 20 or more points 10 times in 2015-16, including a career-best 29 points at Rutgers (Jan. 21) and versus Illinois (March 10). The 29-point outbursts tie for seventh-most by a Hawkeye during the Fran McCaffery era.

Jok became the first Hawkeye non-senior to average 16 points or more since Chris Kingsbury averaged 16.8 points as a sophomore in 1995.

NICHOLAS BAER PLAYED OVERSEAS IN AUGUST

Nicholas Baer averaged 8.5 points, 8.3 rebounds, and two steals in four games (3-1) overseas on the USA East Coast All-Star Team.

This marked the sixth consecutive year that a Hawkeye traveled overseas with the USA East Coast basketball team. In 2011, Matt Gatens and Bryce Cartwright traveled overseas; Zach McCabe went in 2012; Jarrod Uthoff was on the roster in 2013; Mike Gesell and Adam Woodbury competed in 2014; while Dom Uhl traveled with the team in 2015.
