LEADING OFF

- Iowa is ranked 44th in the College Sports Madness preseason rankings. The Hawkeyes are also receiving votes in the USBWA preseason rankings.
- Junior outfielder Robert Neustrom has been named the preseason Big Ten Player of the Year by both Perfect Game and Baseball America. Neustrom and junior Brady Schanuel were named to PG's preseason all-conference team.
- The Hawkeyes were picked to finish fourth in the Big Ten by Perfect Game, fifth by D1Baseball.com, and sixth in the Big Ten Preseason Coaches poll.
- lowa has won 140 games over the past four seasons under head coach Rick Heller -- the best four-year stretch in school history. The Hawkeyes have advanced to NCAA Regional play in two of the last three seasons.
- For the first time in the Heller era, lowa will not have at least one of its weekend starting pitchers returning. Redshirt junior Nick Allgeyer is expected to start the season opener.
- lowa's pitching staff has set school strikeout records in each of the past two seasons. The Hawkeyes struck out 470 batters in 61 games, averaging 7.7 strikeouts per game, last season.
- The Hawkeyes return two All-Big Ten selections -- Neustrom and Tyler Cropley -- and Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-Americans Kyle Shimp and Ben Norman.
- · lowa will play 13 games against five 2017 NCAA Regional teams this season (vs. Indiana, vs. Michigan, vs. Oklahoma State, at Nebraska, and vs. Missouri State).
- The Hawkeyes will play 27 games at Duane Banks Field during the 2018 season. Iowa went 19-4 at Banks Field last season, improving the team's record to 52-14 at home since the start of the 2015 season.

ABOUT HEAD COACH RICK HELLER

Rick Heller has turned the University of Iowa baseball program into a perennial Big Ten Conference and NCAA contender in his first four seasons as the Hawkeyes' head coach.

Heller has injected new life into the lowa program, leading the Hawkeyes to the best four-year stretch in program history, winning 140 games, advancing to two NCAA Regionals, and claiming the first Big Ten Tournament title in program history. It was lowa's first conference title since winning the regular season crown in 1990.

Under Heller's watch, lowa has advanced to the postseason in four consecutive years for the first time in program history, he has coached five All-Americans and at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection each season, and lowa has had 15 Major League Baseball Draft picks in four seasons -- the most in a four-year stretch all-time.

Heller has also given the Hawkeyes an international flavor, taking the team to the Dominican Republic in 2016 and Taipei, Taiwan, as the United States representative at the 2017 World University Games. Heller led USA to a silver medal, as the team became the first American squad to medal in Universiade history.

The Eldon, lowa, native became the 20th head coach in program history in 2013 -- his fourth stop as a collegiate head coach. He has enjoyed stints at lowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern lowa (1999-2009), and Upper lowa (1987-99), leading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

Heller guided lowa to an at-large berth into NCAA Regional play in 2015 -- a first for the program since 1990 -- and the team posted the school's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972. It wasn't a fluke; in the two seasons since, lowa was runner-up at the 2016 Big Ten Tournament before claiming the program's first tournament title in 2017 to lock up the school's second NCAA Regional appearance in three seasons.

lowa made just three NCAA Tournament appearances in its history prior to Heller's arrival.

Heller led Indiana State to its first outright Missouri Valley Conference title in 2012, and Northern Iowa to the MVC title and into the NCAA Tournament in 2001, the first and only regional appearance for the Panthers as a Division I program.

On the recruiting trail, Heller has turned the Hawkeyes into a major player on the national recruiting scene by keeping the best in-state players at home. lowa had the top-rated class in the Big Ten -- and 18th-best nationally -- in 2015, and the 2016 class was ranked third in the league.

In 30 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 830-654-4. He is one of two lowa head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament.

The University of Iowa baseball team opens the 2018 regular season at the Diamond 9 Sunshine State Classic in Kissimmee, Florida. The Hawkeyes face Toledo at 5:30 p.m. (CT) on Friday, Oakland at 2 p.m. on Saturday, and Old Dominion at 10 a.m. Sunday.

lowa's first two games will be played at Osceola Heritage Park Stadium, while Sunday's game will be held at Field 2 at Osceola Heritage Park.

QUICK HITTERS

- · lowa will have new starters at third base (Lorenzo Elion), first base (Matt Hoeg/Grant Judkins), and left field (TBA).
- Senior Tyler Cropley and juniors Robert Neustrom and Zach Daniels were named to the Big Ten Preseason Honors List.
- · Sophomore Kyle Crowl will be the first underclassman starting the season at shortstop since Jake Yacinich in 2013.
- Junior Robert Neustrom will be making the 100th start of his career in the season-opener against Toledo. Neustrom has started 63 straight games.

ABOUT TOLEDO

- Toledo was selected to finish eighth in the Mid-American Conference by D1Baseball.com.
- The Rockets finished 17-41 last season and went 9-15 in the MAC. Toledo's offense was its catalyst in 2017, as the team scored the most runs, doubles, triples, home runs, and posted the highest slugging percentage since 2010.
- Toledo will start closer turned starter LHP Michael Jacob on Friday. Jacob went 1-1 with a 4.10 ERA over 26 1/3 innings last season as the Rockets' closer.

ABOUT OAKLAND

- The Golden Grizzlies were picked to finish fifth in the 2018 Horizon League Baseball Preseason Poll in a vote of the league's head coaches. Oakland went 17-40 overall last year and went 11-19 in league play.
- Oakland returns two All-Horizon League honorees

-- second-team selection Emerson Misch and All-Freshman team honoree Tyler Trovinger.

• The Grizzlies will start LHP P.J. Piesko or RHP Nick Parr. Piesko was 1-4 with a 10.61 ERA last season in 18 appearances, while Parr was 4-3 with a 12.60 ERA in 15 appearances, including five starts.

ABOUT OLD DOMINION

- The Monarchs were selected to finish fourth out of 12 teams in the Conference USA Preseason Coaches Poll. ODU was picked behind Southern Miss, Rice, and Florida Atlantic.
- Old Dominion sophomores Vinnie Pasquantion and Kyle Battle were named to the Preseason All-C-USA team. Pasquantion hit .321 with five home runs, 17 doubles, and 38 RBIs to earn Freshman All-America honors. Battle hit .341 with 36 RBIs and was also a Freshman All-American.
- The Monarchs will start 6-foot-7, sophomore RHP Michael Blanchard on Sunday. Blanchard went 1-3 with a 5.81 ERA in 20 appearances (six starts) last season.

SERIES RESULTS

- Iowa is 2-1 all-time against Toledo all-time. The Hawkeyes last faced the Rockets in 2005 -- a 13-9 victory in Jacksonville, Florida.
- It will be the first-ever meeting against Oakland and Old Dominion.

ROTATION NOTES

- · Redshirt junior Nick Allgeyer will be making his second career start (first Friday start) on Friday against Toledo. The southpaw's only other start came against Penn State on May 21 in the regular-season finale of the 2016 season. He went 2 2/3 innings, allowing one run on three hits.
- Junior Cole McDonald will be making his 20th career start. McDonald was part of the weekend rotation for the first nine weekends last season, where he went 2-4 with a 6.96 ERA. McDonald shined at the World Games, going 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in two appearances. He threw a 97 pitch, nine-inning no-hitter against the Czech Republic, fanning seven while walking three. It was lowa's first nine-inning no-hitter since 1965.
- Junior-college transfer RHP Brady Schanuel was a two-time All-American at Parkland College in Champaign. He won 20 games in two seasons and had 261 strikeouts in 164 innings.

30 X 4

lowa posted its fourth straight 30-win season in 2017. The program hasn't enjoyed a better stretch since posting seven consecutive 30 win campaigns from 1979-85.

• lowa won 39 games last season -- the fifthmost in a single season in program history. The Hawkeyes won 41 games in 2015, the secondmost wins in program history.

STATISTICAL BREAKDOWN

It's tough to envision the lowa lineup without All-America first baseman Jake Adams (.335, 29 HR, 55 R, 14 2B, 72 RBIs) and All-Big Ten shortstop Mason McCoy (.328, 83 H, 18 2B, 5 HR, 55 R, 34 RBIs), but offensively, the Hawkeyes have a lot returning in 2018.

- lowa has six starters, including its designated hitter, back from an offense that ranked in the top three in the Big Ten in nine categories.
- The Hawkeyes have 70.9 percent (421 of 594) of their hits, 69.9 percent (79 of 113) of their doubles, 67.6 (234 of 346) of their RBIs, 66.4 percent (250 of 376) of their runs, and 50.1 percent (36 of 71) of their home runs back in 2018. lowa also has 80 percent of its stolen bases back (52 of 65).
- On the mound, lowa has seven pitchers returning, but it will be a new-look staff under first-year pitching coach Desi Druschel. The Hawkeyes bring back 43.6 percent (17 of 39) of their wins, 40 percent (6 of 15) of their saves, 39.8 percent (187 of 470) of their strikeouts, and 36.8 percent (200 of 543 2/3) of their innings pitched.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- Of lowa's 33-man roster, 10 are freshman, eight are sophomores, 11 are juniors, and four are seniors.
- lowa has 20 lowa natives on the roster -- the most of any state. Eight Hawkeyes hail from Illinois, two from Missouri, and one from Indiana, South Dakota, and Canada.
- •The Hawkeyes have two sets of junior college teammates on the 2018 roster. Tyler Cropley and Matt Hoeg were teammates for two seasons at Iowa Western Community College, while Chris Whelan and Brady Schanuel were teammates in 2016 at Parkland Community College.
- lowa has two sets of high school teammates; Zach Daniels and Matt Berst (Cedar Rapids Kennedy High School) and Connor Lindaman and Trenton Wallace (Davenport Assumption High School).

TEAM CAPTAINS

lowa's team captains for the 2018 season are senior Tyler Cropley, redshirt junior Nick Allgeyer, junior Robert Neustrom, and redshirt sophomore Kyle Shimp.

SILVER MEDALISTS IN TAIWAN

lowa made history when it represented the United States at the 2017 World University Games in Taiwan. Competing as the USA Team, lowa claimed the silver medal, becoming the first American team to medal in Universiade history. lowa went 5-2 during the two-week stretch before falling to Japan in the gold medal game.

DEFENDING B1G TOURNEY CHAMPS

- lowa went 4-1 during a four-day stretch to claim the program's first Big Ten Tournament title in school history in 2017. It was the second straight year the team advanced to the title game.
- The Hawkeyes won three games over higher seeded teams -- fourth-seeded Maryland, top-seeded Nebraska, and third-seeded Minnesota -- to reach the title game. Iowa defeated eighth-seeded Northwestern, 13-4, to claim the title.

OFFENSIVE PROWESS

DEFENSE DOES IT

• lowa finished in a tie for second nationally with 67 double plays -- an lowa school record -- in 2017 and the team ranked 24th with a .978 team fielding percentage.

IOWA SET SINGLE-SEASON K RECORD

The lowa pitching staff set the single-season strikeout record for a second straight season in 2017. lowa finished with 470 strikeouts in 61 games, averaging 7.7 punch outs per contest. The squad shattered the previous record of 382 strikeouts set in 2016.

IOWA'S BACKBONE

The Hawkeyes have been built on pitching and defense under UI head coach Rick Heller.

- lowa has ranked in the top 24 nationally in the nation in team fielding percentage in each of the past three seasons. The Hawkeyes have been in the top four in the Big Ten throughout Heller's tenure.
- lowa has posted team ERA records in 2015 and 2016 (2.95 in 2015, 3.56 in 2016), ranking in the top four in the conference in both seasons. The Hawkeyes set school strikeout records in 2016 and 2017.

COACHING STAFF CHANGES

- Marty Sutherland was promoted to associate head coach in the offseason. He also serves as recruiting coordinator.
- Desi Drushchel was promoted to an assistant coach after serving as the director of baseball operations for three seasons.
- Nic Ungs joins the coaching staff as the director of baseball operations. Ungs played for Rick Heller at Northern Iowa and played professional baseball for 11 seasons.

#HELLERBALL

- UI head coach Rick Heller is one of nine coaches all-time to lead three different NCAA Division I teams to regional play.
- Heller recorded his 800th career win against Lehigh on March 12 at the Snowbird Classic in Florida.

- The Hawkeyes have won 30 or more games in each of Heller's four seasons as the helm of the program. It's a first for the team since winning 30 or more in seven straight seasons from 1979-85.
- Heller has led the Hawkeyes to two NCAA Regional appearances in three seasons; the program had three regional appearances in its history prior to his arrival.
- Heller is fourth in school history in career wins with 140 in his four seasons at lowa, including the second (41) and fifth-most (39) in school history.
- Heller led lowa to its first Big Ten Tournament title in 2017

 the first conference title since 1990 -- and he guided the
 Hawkeyes to the Big Ten Tournament title game in consecutive seasons. Iowa has advanced to the league tournament in four straight years for the first time in program history.
- Heller has coached at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection each season, and has 15 Major League Baseball Draft picks in four seasons -- the most in a four-year stretch in school history.
- lowa had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections in 2015 and five in 2017. The Hawkeyes have had 18 All-Big Ten honorees in four seasons under Heller.
- lowa has posted winning streaks of nine games (in 2015) and eight games (in 2017) -- the longest streaks for the program since 2012.
