### THE MATCH-UP

The University of Iowa soccer team returns to action Saturday, facing Indiana at Bill Armstrong Stadium in Bloomington, Ind. Game time is set for 5 p.m. (CT).

### SCOUTING INDIANA

The Hoosiers, winners of two straight contests, enter Saturday's game with a 10-2-1 overall and 3-2-0 Big Ten record. Indiana's lone two defeats came in consecutive matches at Ohio State (3-1) and at No. 8 Penn State (4-1) on Sept. 26 and Sept. 29, respectively. The Hoosiers rebounded with consecutive wins over Northwestern (2-1, OT) and Illinois (3-2).

Indiana, which is out-scoring its opposition, 28-12, on the season, is led by Lisa Nouanesengsy. The midfielder has seven goals and three assists. Nine different IU players have found the back of the net in 2013, which includes four goals apiece from Kayleigh Steigerwalt and Abby Smith. Rebecca Candler has a team-best six assists.

Shannon Flower has played every minute in goal for the Hoosiers, posting a 0.89 goals against average and making 40 saves. Flower is tied with Iowa's Hannah Clark for the conference lead in shutouts with seven.

### INDIANA VS. IOWA -- THE SERIES

Saturday's match-up will be the rubber game in the all-time series between Indiana and Iowa, as the two schools have split 16 meetings. The Hawkeyes have won the last two games in the series, winning 1-0 in Bloomington in 2011 and 1-0 in Iowa City a season ago behind a Katherie Lewis penalty kick goal in the 30th minute.

### LAST GAME

The Hawkeyes won their second Big Ten contest, downing Michigan State, 1-0, in double overtime, on Oct. 6 at the Iowa Soccer Complex. Iowa scored the game-winning goal in the 106th minute when junior Anne Marie Thomas got a head on junior Melanie Pickert's free kick. The goal came on Iowa's 23rd shot of the game, 14 of which were on goal. The Spartans had six shots (three on goal) in the contest. Sophomore Hannah Clark made three saves for Iowa en route to her seventh shutout of the season.

### CATRELL THRIVING

Senior Ashley Catrell is making the most of her final season as a Hawkeye, leading Iowa in multiple categories.

The Overland Park, Kan., native leads Iowa with 39 shots, four goals, and 11 points. Her two game-winning goals are tied for the team lead, and she holds the second-highest assist total (3).





**HEAD COACH RON RAINEY**

Ron Rainey has turned the University of Iowa soccer program into consistent contenders, guiding Iowa to its two best seasons in program history the past two years. With Rainey at the helm, the Hawkeyes have averaged over 10 wins a season the past four years, marking its most successful stretch in program history.

With 75 career victories at Iowa, Rainey is the school's all-time winningest coach. His career record is 165-128-38, while he sports a 75-63-17 record at Iowa. He has guided Iowa to at least 12 wins in the past two seasons, going undefeated in nonconference play and qualifying for the Big Ten Tournament in consecutive seasons. Iowa has also re-written the record books the past two years, breaking or tying 10 school records.

Iowa wrapped up a 12-6-3 season in 2012 with a trip to Bloomington, Ind., for the Big Ten Tournament. The Hawkeyes went 9-0 in nonconference play and outscored its opponents 31-3 in that stretch. Iowa picked up Big Ten victories against Indiana and Purdue, and defeated Wisconsin, 2-0, to reach the postseason in a dramatic conclusion of the regular season. Iowa outscored its opponents, 40-19, in 2012.

The Hawkeyes finished 13-4-3 in 2011 and set or tied nine school records. Iowa went 9-0 in nonconference play and outscored its opponents 35-5 in that stretch. Iowa's 5-4-2 Big Ten record was its best since 2000. Iowa went on to qualify for the Big Ten Tournament for the sixth time in program history. The Hawkeyes ranked near the top in many major Big Ten statistical categories and finished fifth in Big Ten standings.

Rainey joined the Hawkeyes from Ball State University before the start of the 2006 season, where he served as the school's head coach since the program's inaugural season in 1999. Under his tutelage, the Cardinals posted a 70-52-17 record in seven seasons.

Before starting the program at Ball State, Rainey served as an assistant coach at the University of Iowa for the first two seasons of the Hawkeye program (1997-98). In Iowa's first year of varsity soccer, Rainey and the Hawkeyes were named the No. 1 first-year program by Soccer Buzz Magazine.

Rainey's wife Margaret earned her master's degree in education at Iowa and played collegiate soccer at the University of Wisconsin. They have three children: Wade (11), Sally (9) and Mary (7).

**IOWA 9TH IN GREAT LAKES REGION**

The Hawkeyes are ranked ninth in the NSCAA/Continental Tire Great Lakes Region rankings that were released Oct. 8. Big Ten teams take up eight of the 10 spots in the poll; Penn State (1), Michigan (3), Wisconsin (4), Nebraska (5), Minnesota (6), Indiana (7), and Ohio State (8)

**SCORELESS STREAK**

Iowa's defense posted a scoreless streak of 435:36 from Aug. 25 to Sept. 13. During the stretch, the Hawkeyes tallied four straight shutouts.

**NONCONFERENCE DOMINANCE**

The Hawkeyes have been dominant in non-league competition dating back to the 2011 season. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 25-0 nonconference record during the stretch.

Iowa's last nonconference loss came during the 2010 season against Nebraska, a year before it joined the Big Ten.

Since the 2011 season, the Hawkeyes have out scored their nonconference opponents, 81-12.

**CLARK IN B1G**

Sophomore Hannah Clark ranks among the top-five in the Big Ten in three different statistical categories. The Colorado native's seven shutouts and 0.54 shutouts per game are tops among the league's 12 goalkeepers, and her 0.76 goals against average ranks third.

**BALANCED SCORING**

Eight different Iowa players have scored at least one goal thus far in 2013. Senior Ashley Catrell leads the team with four strikes, while senior Alex Melin and junior Melanie Pickert are tied for second with three strikes apiece. Junior Cloe Lacasse has a team-best six assists, which ties her for sixth-best in the Big Ten.

**OUTSHOOTING, OUT SCORING**

In 13 games, Iowa has out shot its opponents, 214-122. The Hawkeyes have limited the opposition to 53 shots on goal and a .082 shot percentage.

Offensively, Iowa has a 21-10 advantage in goals.

**IRON WOMEN**

Juniors Caitlin Brown and Emily Scott are the only two position players to play every minute for the Hawkeyes in 2013, logging 1,185 minutes apiece. Goalkeeper Hannah Clark, who has also played every minute of the season, has thrived with Brown and Scott leading a defense that allows only 9.4 shots per game.

**BREAKING RECORDS, BEATING RIVALS**

The Hawkeyes continued their dominance over Iowa State on Sept. 6, beating the Cyclones 3-0 in front of a record crowd of 1,594 at the Iowa Soccer Complex. The crowd bested the previous high mark of 975 fans set in the 2011 season.

The win was the sixth-straight for Iowa in the series. In those six games, Iowa has out scored the Cyclones 19-4.

**CLARK EARNS B1G HONOR**

Sophomore goalkeeper Hannah Clark was selected as the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 3 after posting consecutive shutouts and leading the Hawkeyes to the team title at the Pacific Soccer Classic. The Fort Collins, Colo., native made six saves on the weekend and had a 0.00 goals against average and a 1.000 saves percentage. The honor is the second of Clark's career.

**LACASSE HISTORICALLY SPEAKING**

In two-plus years, junior Cloe Lacasse has made her mark on the Iowa soccer program.

The Sudbury, Ontario, native is currently second in career goals (27) and game-winning goals (8), and third in points (73) and shots (195).

Lacasse has led Iowa in goals scored, points, and shots taken in both the 2011 and 2012 seasons.

Lacasse was named Iowa's MVP in 2012, scoring goals in each of the team's first nine matches. She was named to the Madness' 2012 All-Big Ten first-team by CollegeSportsMadness.com, and was an All-Great Lakes Region second team honoree by the NSCAA.

**HAWKEYES TAKE TOURNAMENT TITLE**

After defeating UC Davis on Aug. 30 and Pacific on Sept. 1, the Hawkeyes captured the Pacific Soccer Classic team title.



Senior Alex Melin, juniors Melanie Pickert, Caitlin Brown, Cloe Lacasse, and sophomore Hannah Clark were named to the all-tournament team.

### HAWKEYES ON TV

Iowa will appear on BTN at least once this season, and the Big Ten Digital Network at least three times.

The Hawkeyes' Sept. 22 contest with Michigan was broadcast live on BTN. The Hawkeyes fell to the Wolverines, 2-1.

The Big Ten Digital Network broadcast Iowa's games against Northern Iowa (Sept. 17), Michigan State (Oct. 6), and will broadcast the Hawkeyes' home contest versus Ohio State (Oct. 27).

The BTN will also be televising the Big Ten Tournament on Nov. 6-10.

### ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACH

In his eighth season as Iowa head coach, Ron Rainey is the winningest coach in school history. He has compiled a 75-62-16 record, which includes 35 victories the past two plus seasons. The stretch is the best in program history, including a 13-win season in 2011.

### TEAM CAPTAINS

Senior Alex Melin and junior Caitlin Brown have been voted team captains for the 2013 Iowa soccer team.

### B1G IN THE POLLS

In the most recent NSCAA Coaches Poll, four Big Ten teams are ranked in the Top 25.

Penn State (10-2-1) fell from their previous spot at No. 7 to No. 11, while Michigan (9-2-1) advanced two spots to No. 19. Wisconsin (8-2-2) dropped two spots to No. 20, and Nebraska (9-3-1) moved back one spot to No. 24.

Minnesota received votes.
