The University of Iowa men's tennis team (5-2) travels to Eugene, Oregon for a match-up against the Oregon Ducks (6-1), Saturday at 2 p.m. (PT). Saturday will be the first meeting of the Hawkeyes and the Ducks in program history.

SILVERSTEIN

Junior Josh Silverstein is ranked No. 103 nationally in the latest ITA singles rankings. Silverstein began the season ranked No. 18 regionally and worked his way onto the national list after defeating Jolan Cailleau of Texas Tech who was ranked No. 25 at the time.

"Being ranked shows opponents that you can compete with the best college tennis players in the nation," said Silverstein.

"It took me two and a half years of fighting and grinding to get nationally ranked, but I finally accomplished that goal. The next step is to keep beating though players and move forward as a team."

HAWKS ON THE COURT

- Junior Lefteris Theodorou is 6-1 in singles competition this season.
- He is undefeated in the top spot.
- Senior Robin Haden and junior Jake Jacoby are undefeated as a doubles team on court three.

SCOUTING OREGON

- The Ducks have two athletes ranked nationally in singles.

- Three doubles teams are on the ITA's national list at No 33, 47, and 51, respectively.
