WILDCATS DROP IOWA, 1-0

Northwestern scored a late goal in the 74th minute to defeat Iowa, 1-0 last Sunday.

Allison Preiss scored off a corner from Elise Weber. Weber sent a ball into the box that found Preiss who took a shot on target. The ball deflected off a Hawkeye defender and into the back of the net.

SCOUTING PENN STATE

The 10th-ranked Penn State Nittany Lions are 6-2-2 overall and 2-0-0 in Big Ten play.

Last season, Penn State finished with a 23-0-2 mark and recorded its eighth-straight Big Ten title. The Nittany Lions advanced to the College Cup where they fell to eventual national champion Portland, 4-3 on penalty kicks

Aubrey Aden-Buie leads the potent Nittany Lion offense with 13 points (six goal, one assit). Katie Schoepfer and Sarah Dwyer each have three goals, while six other players have at least one goal on the season.

Alyssa Naeher has played the majority of time in goal for the Nittany Lions. She has a 1.25 goals-against front for the Hawkeyes. average with 35 saves.

The Nittany Lions are coached by Paula Wilkins. Iowa has never defeated Penn State and have an 0-9-0 record against the Nittany Lions.

SCOUTING DRAKE

The Drake Bulldogs are 4-3-1 overall.

Sarah Foote has 11 points (five goals, one assist) to lead the Bulldog offense. Liz Woerle and Melissa Nelson each have six points this season.

Jenny Schroeder has played in seven games between the posts and has a 2.11 goals-against average with 40 saves. Erin Jarvis has appeared in four matches with a 1.45 goals-against average.

The Bulldogs are coached by Iowa City native and former Iowa assistant coach Corbin Stone. Stone served as an assistant coach at lowa during the 2000 season.

BECKER RETURNS TO LINEUP

Senior goalkeeper Ali Becker returned to the lowa lineup last weekend against Northwestern.

Becker started the first two matches of the season in goal before suffering a hand injury. She missed the next five matches before returning last weekend.

The Bettendorf, IA, native has a 0.90 goals-against average with 23 saves this season.

Sophomore Stephanie Hyink and junior Kelsie Full are proving to be a pretty good combination up

Out of the eight goals lowa has scored, four have been scored by either Hyink or Full. Hyink or Full have also been given an assist on six of those eight goals as well.

In addition, Full and Hyink have linked up for four goals. Hyink scored off a Full assist against Loyola and Eastern Michigan. Full also scored against Eastern Michigan and Iowa State off assists from Hvink.
