IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,059 games since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 646-413 (.610). That includes a 323-164 (.663) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 306-89 (.775) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

WIN NO. 300 AT HOME

The UI women's basketball program picked up victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 306-89 (.775) record inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

SCOUTING MINNESOTA

The Minnesota Golden Gophers are 11-12 overall and are 3-7 in Big Ten play. Minnesota lost its first seven conference games in a row, but has won its last three-straight. Minnesota has defeated Northwestern, Michigan and Indiana.

Minnesota's last game was a 65-59 win at Indiana Feb. 3. The Golden Gophers had a bye last weekend. Kiara Buford scored 16 points to lead Minnesota over the Hoosiers. Katie Loberg added 14 points.

Buford leads the team with 15.2 points per game. Leah Cotton is next at 13 points per contest. Jackie Voigt is the team's leading rebounder at 6.2 boards per game.

As a team, Minnesota is shooting .419 (526-1,256) from the field, including .321 (94-293) from three-point distance.

IOWA VS. MINNESOTA NOTES

- Iowa leads the all-time series, 43-22. The Hawkeyes have won six of the previous eight matchups against the Golden Gophers. Iowa won 20-straight games over Minnesota between 1983-94. The Hawkeyes are 23-7 in games played in Iowa City, and have won the last three meetings at home.
- Iowa's Theairra Taylor and Minnesota's Kiara Buford are from the same hometown (St. Paul, MN) and attended the same high school (St. Paul Central).
- Iowa's Trisha Nesbitt and Minnesota's Kionna Kellog are both from Ames, IA and were high school teammates at Ames High School.
- Iowa has four players from Minnesota on its roster, including Kachine Alexander (Minneapolis), Kamille Wahlin (Crookston), Hannah Draxten (Fergus Falls) and Theairra Taylor (St. Paul). The Golden Gophers have seven players from Minnesota on their roster.
- Iowa and Minnesota both played Virginia Tech and Southern this season. Minnesota defeated Virginia Tech, 63-58 at home in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge and also defeated Southern at home, 63-48. The Hawkeyes opened the season with a 76-52 win over Southern at the Islander Tip-Off Tournament in Corpus Christi, TX. Iowa knocked off Virginia Tech, 72-43, at the Caribbean Challenge in Cancun.

LAST MEETING

Iowa picked up its first conference win of the 2010-11 season with a 63-57 win at Minnesota (Jan. 5).

Iowa trailed by nine points at half, and by as many as 13 in the second half, but a tough comeback sealed the win. Iowa shot .462 (12-26), including .444 (4-9) from three-point distance in the second half to earn the win. The Hawkeyes also shot .850 (17-20) from the free throw line in the game.

Iowa was led by Kachine Alexander, who netted 20 points, grabbed eight rebounds and dished out five assists. Kamille Wahlin added 14 points and Morgan Johnson recorded a double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds. Jaime Printy had 10 points.

IOWA IN THE RANKINGS

The Hawkeyes are receiving votes in the AP and the ESPN/USA Today polls.

Four Iowa opponents are also ranked in the AP and the ESPN/USA Today polls: Michigan State (11th/13th), North Carolina (13th/10th), Iowa State (22nd/20th) and Penn State (23rd/23rd).

Ohio State, Kansas State and Northern Iowa are receiving votes.

The Hawkeyes also rank 11th in the nation in attendance, bringing in an average of 6,188 fans.

IOWA AND RPI NOTES

- Iowa is currently ranked 17th in the latest NCAA RPI, which is the second-highest among Big Ten schools.
- Iowa's schedule is rated the 13th-toughest in the nation, according to RealTimeRPI.com.
- Iowa has three wins over top 30 RPI teams (Michigan State - 14, Ohio State - 20, Iowa State - 29).
- All seven of Iowa's losses are to teams with an RPI of 50 or better, with three of those losses to teams with an RPI of 25 or better. Three of those losses are also against teams ranked in the top-25 when the game was played.

HAWKEYES DROP HOME GAME VS. PENN STATE

Two furious comebacks in the second half weren't enough, as Penn State knocked off Iowa, 82-75 Feb. 6 in Iowa City.

The Lady Lions led by 12 at halftime, but an 8-2 run cut the deficit to just three at 54-51 with 13:26 remaining. Penn State stretched its lead to 13 points with 8:25 left, but an 11-2 surge pulled Iowa within four at 66-62. That would be as close as Iowa could get, as the Lady Lions held on for the win.

Kamille Wahlin led Iowa with 24 points. Jaime Printy added 20 points, four rebounds and four assists. Kachine Alexander chipped in a double-double with 12 points, 17 rebounds and four assists. Kelly Krei had 10 points.

ALEXANDER JOINS ELITE GROUP

Kachine Alexander became the first player in Iowa history, and just the fifth player in Big Ten history, to collect 1,000 career points, 800 career rebounds and 300 career assists vs. Penn State (Feb. 6). The other Big Ten players to accomplish the milestone include Janel McCarville (Minnesota), Jolene Anderson (Wisconsin) and Lacey Simpson and Tajua Catchings (Illinois).

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 562-272 (.674), including a 206-130 (.613) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

MORE MILESTONES FOR ALEXANDER

- With 11 rebounds at Ohio State (Jan. 24), Alexander became just the sixth player in school history, and the first-ever guard, to collect 800 career rebounds.
- Alexander is the sixth player in school history to have 1,000 career points and 800 career rebounds.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT (REBOUNDER)

Kachine Alexander's 9.5 rebounds per game are the most for any guard in the country. Alexander ranks 39th in the country in rebounding, but the 38 players ranked above her are all listed as forwards or centers. East Tennessee State's Destiny Mitchel and Wyoming's Aubrey Vandiver are the only other guards listed among the NCAA's top 50 rebounders. They are tied for 50th at 9.2 boards per game.

SEEING DOUBLE

Kachine Alexander recorded her seventh double-double of the season against Penn State (Feb. 6), finishing with 12 points and 17 rebounds. Alexander now has 31 career double-doubles, which is four shy of Lisa Long's school record for double-doubles (35, set from 1983-87). Last season, Alexander finished with 15 double-doubles, which was one shy of tying Amy Herrig's record for single-season double-doubles. Alexander tallied nine double-doubles as a sophomore.

ALEXANDER AND WAHLIN EACH GET A GRAND

Kachine Alexander and Kamille Wahlin both reached the 1,000 career point milestone this season. Alexander hit the mark with a layup at the 11:54 mark in the first half against Minnesota (Jan. 5). She became the 27th player in school history to record 1,000 career points. Wahlin also scored her 1,000th career point with a layup. Wahlin's came at the 17:23 mark against Penn State (Feb. 6). She is the 28th player in school history to score 1,000 points in a career.

WAHLIN TIES ARENA RECORD

Kamille Wahlin's six made three-pointers against Penn State (Feb. 6) tied a Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for three-pointers made in a single game. Wendy Ausdemore made six treys against Wisconsin (Feb. 25, 2007).

PRINTY AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Iowa has played in six games against opponents ranked in the top 25 this year, and Jaime Printy's numbers in those games have been impressive. Printy is averaging 15.5 points, 4.7 rebounds and 4.2 assists in Iowa's games against ranked opponents (North Carolina, Iowa State, Ohio State twice and Michigan State twice). Printy is shooting .448 (30-67) from the field, including .458 (11-24) from three-point distance and .917 (22-24) from the free throw line against ranked teams.

NINE IN A ROW FROM DOWNTOWN

Jaime Printy buried nine-straight three-pointers, starting with Iowa's game at Minnesota (Jan. 5). Printy made her last three-point attempt at Minnesota, was a perfect 2-2 against Ohio State (Jan. 8), a perfect 4-4 at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and made her first two attempts vs. Indiana (Jan. 16) before missing a long-distance shot.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Morgan Johnson recorded her sixth double-double of the season and the ninth double-double of her career against Illinois (Jan. 30). Johnson finished the game with 17 points and 13 rebounds.

JOHNSON AT .500 OR BETTER

When Morgan Johnson takes eight or more shots in a game, chances are she will make at least half of them.

Johnson has attempted eight or more shots in 18 of Iowa's 24 games this year. In those 18 games, Johnson has shot .500 or better 11 times, including a 7-9 (.778) shooting performance at Illinois (Jan. 30).

Johnson has attempted 10 or more shots eight times, shooting .500 or better in all but two games. Johnson was 8-13 (.615) against Northeastern, 10-16 (.625) against Central Michigan, 8-11 (.727) vs. Iowa State, 9-12 (.750) vs. South Dakota State, 5-10 (.500) vs. Michigan and vs. Ohio State and 7-12 (.583) at Ohio State.

She was 2-12 (.167) vs. James Madison and 4-12 (.333) at Minnesota.

JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET

Morgan Johnson scored double figures over a tough four game-stretch, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 Iowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Iowa is one of only three teams in the Big Ten to have four players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the conference.

Iowa, Ohio State, and Northwestern have four players ranked. Penn State, Wisconsin and Purdue have three ranked, while the remaining five schools have either one or two players ranked.

The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in 20 of the 24 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley and at Illinois. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan, Kansas State, Minnesota, in both games vs. Ohio State and vs. Penn State.

HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS

Iowa's rebounding numbers are impressive. The Hawkeyes rank second in the Big Ten in overall rebounding (41.6 per game), second in defensive rebounding (27.7 per game), and third in offensive rebounding (14.0 per game) and rebounding margin (+4.8).

Kachine Alexander ranks second in offensive rebounding (3.5 per game), third in overall rebounding (9.5) and fourth in defensive rebounding (6.0 per game). Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are the third most for any Big Ten player this season.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

- Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.
- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (31), sixth in career rebounding (843), 10th in career assists (305) and 23rd in career scoring (1,126). She needs five more rebounds to move past Lisa Long for fourth place on the rebounding list and 18 assists to move past Lisa Anderson for ninth on the assists list. She needs five more double-doubles to take over first place (Lisa Long, 35).
 - Morgan Johnson ranks fourth in career blocks (139) and needs seven more to move past Toni Foster into third place.
 - Kamille Wahlin ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (155) and 28th in career scoring (1,009). She needs two more three-pointers to move past Leah Magner into fourth place.
 - Jaime Printy ranks seventh in career three-pointers made (134) and needs five more to move past Kristi Faulkner for sixth place.

PRINTY HAS A BIG WEEK

Jaime Printy averaged 20.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in Iowa's two games at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and at home vs. Indiana (Jan. 16).

Printy shot a combined .571 (12-21) from the field, including .700 (7-10) from three-point distance, while only missing one free throw (10-11, .909).

Printy started the week with 23 points, seven rebounds, two assists and three steals in Iowa's buzzer-beater loss at Michigan State, scoring 18 of Iowa's 28 first half points.

She followed with a game-high 18 points on 5-10 shooting, including 3-6 from beyond the arc, and eight rebounds in Iowa's 20-point victory over Indiana.

STEALING AWAY AGAINST BRADLEY

Iowa collected 17 steals against Bradley Nov. 16, which was the highest steal total for a Hawkeye team since the 2005-06 season. Iowa recorded 17 steals against UW-Milwaukee in the season opener on Nov. 20, 2005.

RACKING UP THE POINTS

Iowa's 91 points against Bradley Nov. 16 were the most for a regular season, non-overtime game since Feb. 25, 2007, when the Hawkeyes defeated Wisconsin, 103-93. Iowa scored 97 points in a triple-overtime win against Penn State Feb. 1, 2009.

BLUDER REACHES MILESTONE

With a 75-71 win at Drake Dec. 20, Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder became only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 204 wins in her 11 years at Iowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at Iowa, finishing her time in Iowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

ALEXANDER NAMED CO-BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week, Nov. 22, for her efforts against Bradley, Northeastern and Central Michigan. Alexander shared the weekly honor with Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of Iowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander has now been named Big Ten Player of the Week five times in her career. She was a two-time award winner as both a sophomore and junior.

ALEXANDER MAKES FIRST CUT FOR WOODEN AWARD - ON WATCH LISTS FOR OTHERS

Senior Kachine Alexander was one of 20 players to be named to the Wooden Award Top 20 Midseason List Jan 11. She is also on watch lists for the Wade Trophy and the Naismith Trophy. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players and the Naismith Trophy watch list is made up of 50 players.

The Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy are considered the three most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last year marked the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

Iowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.
