Top-ranked lowa (4-0) will head to Troy, NY, for the Journeymen/Brute Northeast Duals Saturday. The Hawkeyes, who will look to extend their 18-match winning streak, will wrestle Binghamton (2-2) at 8:15 a.m., Maryland (1-2-1) at 10 a.m., Central Michigan (0-0) at 12:15 p.m. and Bloomsburg (0-1) at 4 p.m. All matches will be held at the McDonough Sports Complex Field House at Hudson Valley Community College. Tickets are \$25 for adults and \$20 for students.

BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

The Binghamton Bearcats are 2-2 with wins over AIC (38-3) and Wagner (54-0), and losses to Penn State (8-36) and North Carolina (10-27).

Head Coach Pat Popolizio is 25-24 in three seasons at Binghamton. He is assisted by Dennis Papadatos and Scott Green. The Bearcats are led by sophomore Anwar Goeres (141), senior Nate Patterson (157) and junior Josh Patterson (174). This will be the first meeting between the two programs.

MARYLAND TERRAPINS

The Maryland Terrapins are 1-2-1 with a win over Findlay (37-12), losses to Edinboro (14-23) and Lehigh (15-21) and a tie with Army (19-19).

Head Coach Kerry McCoy is in his first season with the Terrapins, and has a 30-21-1 career record as a collegiate head coach. He is assisted by Todd Beckerman and Jason Powell. McCoy inherited a squad that won the 2008 ACC title, went undefeated in the conference (5-0) and posted a 16-4 dual mark.

Returning all-American Hudson Taylor leads the team at 197 and is currently ranked second in the nation. Maryland also returns five other 2008 NCAA qualifiers in juniors Steven Bell (133), Jon Kohler (141) and Mike Letts (174), and sophomores Eric Medina (149) and Brian Letters (157).

lowa leads the series, 1-0, winning the only meeting (25-6) in 1973 at College Park, MD.

HEAD COACH TOM BRANDS



The 2008 NWCA, W.I.N. Magazine and Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his third season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time all-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 39-6 overall and 13-3

Big Ten record at Iowa, and a 56-26 career mark.

In his second season at Iowa, Brands guided the squad to NCAA and Big Ten titles, as well the Big Ten regular season title with an undefeated 8-0 league mark. It was Iowa's 21st NCAA team title - the first since 2000 - and the Hawkeyes' 32nd Big Ten championship - the first since 2004. Iowa also won the 2007 Midlands title and the Division I trophy at the NWCA/Cliff Keen National Duals in January. The Hawkeyes posted a 21-1 dual mark, ending the season on a 14-match winning streak. Senior Mark Perry and junior Brent Metcalf each won NCAA titles, and Iowa crowned a total of seven all-Americans, which was the most for Iowa since 2001.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at lowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 all-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001. Brands was a four-time all-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

CENTRAL MICHIGAN CHIPPEWAS

The Central Michigan Chippewas will open their 2008-09 dual season Saturday at the Journeymen/Brute Northeast Duals. The Chippewas are ranked 11th in the most recent national dual team rankings by *W.I.N. Magazine* and 17th in the *USA Today/* NWCA/Intermat Top 25 coaches poll.

Head Coach Tom Borrelli is 204-87-6 in 18 seasons at Central Michigan and 250-116-7 in 23 years as a college head coach. He is assisted by Mark DiSalvo and Brandon Sinnott.

The Chippewas are led by senior Trevor Stewart (165), juniors Conor Beebe (133) and Steve Brown (149), sophomore Mike Miller (174) and freshman Scott Sentes (125). Stewart, Beebe and Brown qualified for the 2008 NCAA Championships and were part of last season's squad that tied for seventh place at the NCAA Championships, won its seventh-straight Mid-American Conference title, went undefeated in the conference (5-0) and posted a 16-2 overall dual record.

lowa leads the series, 2-0, winning the last meeting (28-8) in the first round of the 2003 Cliff Keen/NWCA National Duals. The Hawkeyes also won the first meeting (36-6) in the first round of the 2002 National Duals.

BLOOMSBURG HUSKIES

The Bloomsburg Huskies are 0-1 (0-1 EWL) with a loss to Pittsburgh (7-27). Head Coach John Stutzman is 31-26-1 in four years at Bloomsburg. He is assisted by Scott Owen.

Returning all-American Matt Moley (157) leads the squad, along with juniors Jason Guffey (133), Rick Donald (141), and Rick Schmelyun (165).

lowa leads the series, 2-0, winning the last meeting (37-3) in the first round of the 1990 National Duals. The Hawkeyes also won the first meeting (30-14) in 1986 at Bloomsburg.

IOWA WINS THREE AT NWCA ALL-STAR DUAL

Three Hawkeye wrestlers picked up wins at the 2008 NWCA All-Star Dual in Columbus, OH. Junior **Brent Metcalf** (149) turned in one of the more dominant performances of the night, while senior **Charlie Falck** (125) and junior **Phillip Keddy** (184) each picked up decisions. Iowa sent four wrestlers to the event - Falck, Metcalf, junior **Jay Borschel** (174) and Keddy - which was the most of any team represented. A crowd of 2,070 was on hand at Ohio State's St. John Arena for the 43rd annual event.

Falck, who was ranked third in the nation at 125 in the Intermat/NWCA/NWMA poll, opened the event with a 6-2 win over fifth-ranked James Nicholson of Old Dominion. It was the second time that Falck defeated the Des Moines, IA, native. Top-ranked Metcalf posted a match-ending 19-3 technical fall in 6:20 over fourth-ranked Darrion Caldwell of North Carolina State at 149. Caldwell, who handed the Hawkeye junior his only loss during the 2007-08 season, scored his only points off escapes. Borschel, who is ranked second at 174, lost a 3-2 decision to top-ranked Steve Luke of Michigan. Luke, who is the defending Big Ten champion and the 2008 NCAA runner-up, now holds a 2-1 advantage in the series between the two. Keddy, who is ranked third at 184, won a 3-2 decision over fourth-ranked Louis Caputo of Harvard, evening their series at 1-1.

HAWKEYES GO 4-0 AT IOWA CITY DUALS

The Hawkeye wrestling team opened the 2008-09 season going 4-0 at the lowa City Duals (Nov. 21) in lowa City. Approximately 900 fans packed the University of Iowa Field House North Gym to watch Iowa defeat Iowa Central (52-0), Coe (51-0) and Minnesota State Mankato (45-3) earlier in the day, and a crowd of 4,846 saw the Hawkeyes beat Arizona State (41-0) at Carver-Hawkeye Arena later that afternoon. Iowa posted a 39-1 record - including 20 pins, two technical falls and three major decisions

- and extended its dual match winning streak to 18.

Hawkeye senior Charlie Falck (125), juniors Daniel Dennis (133), Brent Metcalf (149), Ryan Morningstar (165), Jay Borschel (174), Phillip Keddy (184) and Dan Erekson (Hwt.), and redshirt freshman Matt Ballweg (157) each posted 4-0 records on the day. Metcalf pinned all four opponents in a combined total of 9:14, extending his own winning streak to 36 matches. Other individual highlights included three pins each from Borschel and Erekson, Falck's 2-1 win over eighth-ranked Anthony Robles of Arizona State and Morningstar snapping the 44-match winning streak of Coe's Tyler Burkle with a 12-3 major decision. Ballweg also made his varsity lineup debut, scoring one pin and both of the team's technical falls. Senior Alex Tsirtsis (141) and junior Chad Beatty (197) each posted 3-0 records.

FOUR HAWKEYES WIN TITLES AT KAUFMAN-BRAND OPEN

Four University of Iowa wrestlers won individual titles at the 26th annual Kaufman-Brand Open in Omaha, NE. Junior **Joe Slaton** won the 133-pound title in the elite division, while true freshmen **Matt McDonough** (133) and **Mark Ballweg** (141) and redshirt freshman **Brodie Ambrose** (197) won titles in the amateur division.

Slaton, who defeated lowa redshirt freshman **Montell Marion** 5-1 in the finals, won his second straight Kaufman-Brand Open title. McDonough also faced a Hawkeye teammate in the finals, beating true freshman **Nate Moore** in the 133-pound amateur final. Ballweg recorded two pins, a technical fall and a major decision en route to his title. Hawkeye sophomore **Aaron Janssen** was lowa's other placewinner, finishing third in the 165-pound elite division.

Due to the possibility of sellout crowds for those duals, the first 1,000 University of Iowa students will be admitted free of charge after they log-in to their student account at **www.hawkeyesports.com** to reserve a seat and download a free paper ticket. Student seats for the Iowa-Iowa State dual must be reserved by Dec. 5 at 5 p.m.

lowa's overall dual meet record is 832-215-30 (.786) in 97 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 21 national titles and 32 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 49 NCAA champions have won a total of 76 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 14 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 101 Big Ten champions have won a total of 182 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time and 24 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 135 all-Americans have earned all-America status 273 times, including 17 four-time, 27 three-time and 33 two-time honorees.

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeye wrestling staff of **Tom Brands**, **Terry Brands**, **Doug Schwab**, **Mike Zadick** and **Jared Frayer** earned a total of one Olympic gold medal, one Olympic bronze medal, six NCAA titles, 11 conference titles and 15 all-America honors. Their combined college career wrestling record is 487-83-2 (.858).

OH BROTHER

The two sets of brothers on the 2008-09 Hawkeye wrestling roster are junior **Dan LeClere** and redshirt freshman **Nick LeClere** from Coggon, IA, and sophomore **Matt Ballweg** and freshman **Mark Ballweg** from Waverly, IA.

There have been 10 sets of brothers to wrestle together in the Hawkeye lineup since the 1950s. They are **Don** and **Tom Huff** (1961), **Mark** and **Scott Trizzino** (1981), **Lenny**, **Larry** and **Jim Zalesky** (1981-82), **Ed** and **Lou Banach** (1981-83), **Marty** and **Lindley Kistler** (1984-85), **Jim** and **John Heffernan** (1987), **Tom** and **Terry Brands** (1989-92), **Troy** and **Terry Steiner** (1991-93), **Ryan** and **Randy Fulsaas** (2001) and **Luke** and **Ty Eustice** (2003-04).

There have also been five sets of twins to wrestle at Iowa. They are Ed and Lou Banach, Tom and Terry Brands, Ben and Brett Stedman, Troy and Terry Steiner and Randy and Ryan Fulsaas.

H. A. W. K. CLUB PARTIES

After 15 years at the First Avenue Club, the post-meet H.A.W.K. club parties will have a new location for the 2008-09 season. All parties will be held on the second floor of Kinnick Stadium's Brechler Pressbox. Using the Gate D entrance, take one of the elevators to the second floor, take a left out of the elevator and another left at the hallway. The party dates are as follows: Dec. 6 (lowa State), Jan. 23 (Wisconsin), Jan. 30 (Bucknell) and Feb. 15 (Minnesota).

NEXT UP

The Hawkeyes will try to pack the house and recapture the current national dual meet attendance record when it hosts intra-state rival lowa State Dec. 6 at 7 p.m. in Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The current record of 15,646 was set by Minnesota on Feb. 1, 2002, when the Golden Gophers hosted lowa at the Target Center in Minneapolis.

The meet has also been designated as a "Black Out" meet, where all fans are encouraged to wear black and will receive black rally towels. It will also be the sixth event in this season's Hy-Vee Cy-Hawk Series. Iowa leads the series, 7-4. The dual will be aired live on Iowa Public Television, while the Big Ten Network will have a same day delayed broadcast at 9:30 p.m.

While Carver-Hawkeye holds 15,500 fans for a dual wrestling meet, University of Iowa officials have secured special permission from local authorities to sell standing room only seats around the top perimeter of the facility for a new capacity of 15,713. Iowa City was home to the national dual meet attendance record for almost 19 years before Minnesota's record-breaking crowd in 2002. The Hawkeyes had 15,283 fans when they hosted Iowa State on Feb. 19, 1983. Iowa broke that record on Feb. 22, 1992, when 15,291 fans filled Carver-Hawkeye to watch the Hawkeyes and Cyclones compete.
