IOWA MIDLANDS HISTORY

Iowa has won more team titles (23) than any other school in the 51 years of the Midlands Championships. The Hawkeyes won their first team title in 1974, and proceeded to win nine of the next 11. Iowa also won team titles in 1990, 1992, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2001, 2002, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2011, and 2013. Other team winners include Iowa State (8), Illinois (4), Michigan State (3), Sunkist Kids Wrestling Club (3), Michigan (2), Arizona State (1), Minnesota (1), Missouri (1), North Carolina (1) and Oklahoma State (1). Team scores were not kept at four tournaments (1991, 1993, 1994, 1995).

ON THE HEELS OF HISTORY

Iowa scored 187.5 team points in 2013, breaking its previous tournament record of 185 set in 2007. The Hawkeyes advanced seven wrestlers to the finals last year and crowned three champions, including Mike Evans, who was named the tournaments top individual point scorer, Thomas Gilman and Derek St. John.

Runner-ups included Tony Ramos, Nick Moore, Ethen Lofthouse, and Bobby Telford.

HAWKEYES IN THE MIDLANDS HOF

Seven former Hawkeyes are enshrined in the Midlands Hall of Fame. They include Ed Banach, Chris Campbell, Steve Combs, Tim

Cysewski, Barry Davis, Randy Lewis and Chuck Yagla. Former Hawkeye Head Coach Dan Gable is also a Midlands Hall of Fame member.

INDIVIDUAL MIDLANDS HONORS

Seven former Hawkeyes earned the Art Kraft Champion of Champions Award, while nine were named the Dan Gable Outstanding Wrestler. The Art Kraft Champion of Champions include Lenny Zalesky (1980), Jim Zalesky (1983), Jim Heffernan (1986), Jeff McGinness (1995), Joe Williams (1996), Eric Juergens (1999) and Mark Perry (2007). The Dan Gable Outstanding Wrestlers were Randy Lewis (1979), Lenny Zalesky (1980), Ed Banach (1981), Royce Alger (1994), Jeff McGinness (1995), Lincoln McIlravy (1997), Joe Williams (1999, 2000), Mark Perry (2007) and Brent Metcalf (2009). Gable was named the tournament's outstanding wrestler five times (1966-69, 1971).

20-IN-4 CLUB

Eight former Hawkeyes are members of the prestigious 20-in-4 club, which requires a wrestler to record at least 20 wins in their first four years of competition. They are John Bowsby (22 - 1974, 1976-78), Barry Davis (20 - 1980-83), Joe Williams (20 - 1993-96), Mark Ironside (22 - 1994-97), Wes Hand (20 - 1996-99), Jody Strittmatter (20 - 1997-2000), Doug Schwab (20 - 1997-2000) and Cliff Moore (23 - 2001-03, 2005). Gable was the first club member, recording 20 wins from 1966-69.

IOWA/MIDLANDS SUPERLATIVES

Former Hawkeye Joe Williams holds the most individual titles in Midlands history, winning 10. Other former Hawkeyes to win at least three titles are Tim Cysweski (5), Mark Ironside (4), Royce Alger (3), Ed Banach (3), Chris Campbell (3), Jim Heffernan (3), Randy Lewis (3), Brent Metcalf (3) and Chuck Yagla (3). Ironside has the most wins (27) at 141 pounds, and he and Cysewski hold the most titles (4 each) at that weight. Jim Heffernan holds the most titles (3) at 157, while Williams holds the most wins (35) and titles (7) at 174. Pat Kennedy holds the fastest fall (11 seconds) at 165, while Verlyn Strellner holds the most falls (10) at 197. Gable holds the most titles (3) and falls (13) at 149 pounds.

GRAND SLAM WINNERS

Head coach Tom Brands is one of six Grand Slam Winners in Midlands history. Wrestlers who have won a Midlands title, an NCAA championship, a World title, and an Olympic gold medal are considered Grand Slam Winners. Brands is joined on the list by Dan Gable, Bruce Baumgartner, Dave Schults, Kenny Monday and Jordan Burroughs.

MIDLANDS, 2006-PRESENT

Iowa has won five Midlands team titles since 2006, Tom Brands' first season as head coach. The Hawkeyes won team titles in 2007, 2008, 2009, 2011, and 2013. Iowa placed second in 2006, fourth in 2010, and did not compete in 2012.

Since 2006, 12 Hawkeyes have combined to win 15 individual titles -- Eric Luedke ('06), Joey Slaton ('07), Dan LeClere ('07), Mark Perry ('07), Brent Metcalf ('07, '08, '09), Daniel Dennis ('08), Ryan Morningstar ('08), Jay Borschel ('09), Matt McDonough ('09, '11), Thomas Gilman ('13), Derek St. John ('13) and Mike Evans ('13).

CORNER CHAMPIONS

Iowa's coaching staff has won a combined four Midlands titles. Head coach Tom Brands won the 134-pound title in 1990. Associate head coach Terry Brands won the 126-pound title in 1991, and again in 1997 as a member of the Hawkeye Wrestling Club. Assistant coach Ryan Morningstar won the 165-pound title in 2008.

GILMAN RETURNS TO THE SCENE

Sophomore Thomas Gilman broke into the national picture last season by winning the 125-pound bracket at the 2013 Midlands Championships. Gilman defeated defending NCAA champion Jesse Delgado, 3-1, in the semifinals, and defending Midlands champion Jarrod Garnett, 6-1, in the finals. He also defeated No. 7 Dylan Peters (UNI), 6-3, in the quarterfinals.

Gilman was recognized with Big Ten wrestler of the week honors following the tournament, and broke into the national polls at No. 3.

HAWKEYES IN THE RANKINGS

Iowa has nine wrestlers ranked in the top 10 of the Dec. 16 InterMat rankings, more than any other school. Only two other schools have more than five (Ohio State 8, Penn State 6).

Four of Iowa's wrestlers are ranked in the top 5, including Thomas Gilman (4), Cory Clark (4), Mike Evans (3), and Bobby Telford (3). Four more Hawkeyes are projected in the top 8, including

Josh Dziewa (6), Nick Moore (7), Sammy Brooks (8), and Nathan Burak (6). Brandon Sorensen is ranked No. 10 at 149. Iowa does not have a wrestler ranked at 157.

EVANS DEFENDS 174

Senior Mike Evans won six matches last year, three by fall and two by major decision, en route to the 174-pound title. He scored 29 points for the Hawkeyes and took home the Individual High Point Trophy.

Evans opened the season 9-0 for the fourth straight year. He lost his 10th match of the season as a freshman and sophomore, and opened last year 11-0 before suffering his first loss. His 11 match win streak is the longest win streak of his career.

A LITTLE EXTRA FROM BROOKS

Sophomore Sammy Brooks has nine wins this season, all by bonus points. Brooks is 9-0 overall with three pins, three technical falls, and two major decisions. He also has one win via medical forfeit. He has won 10 in a row dating back to last season.

KELLY RETURNS TO 157

Senior Michael Kelly is 9-0 with four falls this season at 157 pounds. It is his best start to a season since he opened the 2010 season 12-0 at 157, his true freshman season.

Kelly has wrestled every match at 157 pound this season, and has a 32-3 career mark at 157, including an 18-1 record competing unattached in 2010-11. He was 5-1 as a redshirt freshman, and wrestled his entire sophomore campaign at 149. He wrestled at 157 once last year, falling to Indiana's sixth-ranked Taylor Walsh.

The veteran has 36 career dual starts under his belt, the fourth most on the team. He is appearing in his fourth Midlands Championships.

TELFORD EYES MIDLANDS TITLE

Senior Bobby Telford has advanced to the finals in his last two trips to Midlands. In 2011, Telford defeated Mike McMullan, 4-2, in the semifinals, but lost to Central Michigan's Jarod Trice in overtime, 3-2, in the finals.

A year ago Telford ran through a pair of ranked opponents in the quarters and semis, but fell in the finals to fourth-ranked Adam Coon.

This year he is the likely No. 2 seed, behind Northwestern's McMullan, who is the top-ranked heavyweight in the country. Telford is

UNDEFEATED ALL-AMERICANS

Iowa's four returning All-Americans -- Cory Clark (125), Mike Evans (174), Nathan Burak (197), and Bobby Telford (285) -- are a combined 31-0 this season with 17 pins.

Clark, Evans, and Telford are all 9-0. Telford has seven pins, one major decision, and one win via medial forfeit. Clark has pinned six of his nine opponents. Evans has seven wins by bonus points and a decision over a top 10 opponent.

Burak was 4-0 with one pin, one major decision, and one technical fall at the Luther Open, but he has not seen action since due to injury.

The Hawkeyes have crowned at least one All-American every year since 1972, a span of 43 seasons. Iowa has totaled 261 All-America honors during that stretch. The Hawkeyes crowned six All-Americans in 2014, including four-time All-American Derek St. John (157) and first-timers Clark (125) and Burak (197). Tony Ramos earned his third career All-America honor, winning the 133-pound bracket, and Evans (174) and Telford (285) were both named All-Americans for the second time in their careers.

40 YEARS SINCE NO. 1

Iowa will celebrate the 40th anniversary of its first national championship on Friday, Jan. 23, at 7 p.m. against Northwestern.

Gary Kurdelmeier led Iowa to its first NCAA Championship in 1975, and in the 40 years since, the Hawkeyes have accumulated 23 team titles, more than any other school -- Oklahoma State (7), Penn State (4), Minnesota (3), Iowa State (2), and Arizona State (1).

NCAA EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeyes have seven wrestlers with NCAA Championships experience. Seniors Mike Evans (174) and Bobby Telford (285) are three-time NCAA qualifiers. Telford earned All-America honors in 2012 and 2014, while Evans earned All-America hon-

ors in 2013 and 2014. Junior Nathan Burak (197) and sophomore Cory Clark (125) also advanced to the All-America stand in 2014. Burak was making his second NCAA tournament appearance, while Clark was making his first. Senior Nick Moore (165) has competed in two NCAA Championships (2013, 2014), and last year senior Josh Dziewa (141) and junior Brody Grothus (149) made their first career appearances.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 946-224-31 (.799) in 105 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 53 NCAA Champions have won a total of 81 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 110 Big Ten champions have combined for 191 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 29 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 150 All-Americans have earned All-America status 307 times, including 18 four-time, 32 three-time and 39 two-time honorees.

MIDLANDS PRE-SEEDS

Senior Mike Evans and junior Nathan Burak were ranked No. 1 at their respective weights when the 52nd annual Midlands Championships pre-seeds were announced Wednesday, Dec. 24. Iowa is represented in all 10 weight classes, and has two wrestlers pre-seeded at 149 and 157, and three at 174 pounds.

Evans, the defending champion at 174, is the top pre-seed for the second straight year. Burak placed third last season at 197. He is wrestling unattached this year.

Thomas Gilman, the defending Midlands champion at 125, is the No. 2 seed behind Illinois' Jesse Delgado, the two-time defending NCAA champion. Cory Clark is seeded second at 133, and Bobby Telford, a Midlands runner-up in 2011 and 2013, is the No. 2 seed at 285.

Iowa has a top-five seed at every weight class. Brody Grothus (149), Nick Moore (165), and Sammy Brooks (184) are seeded third at their respective weights. Josh Dziewa is seeded fourth at 141, and Michael Kelly is fifth at 157.

Brandon Sorensen placed third last season and is seeded No. 8 at 149. Edwin Cooper is the No. 9 seed at 157, and Alex Meyer, a seventh-place finisher in 2013, is seeded sixth at 174. Freshman Burke Paddock is the No. 9 seed at 174

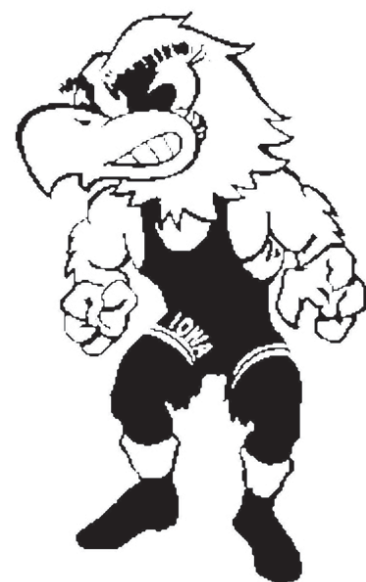

Tom Brands
Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands completed his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 151-15-1 (.907) overall and 59-6 (.908) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 168-35-1 (.826) career mark.

In eight seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning nine NCAA champions, 11 Big Ten champions and 44 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 61 academic all-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 72 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last eight years, sending the entire 10-man line-

up in 2009, 2010, and 2014. Iowa has also won or shared six of the last seven Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, Iowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the then-national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when Iowa defeated Iowa State, 20-15, on Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' eight seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.

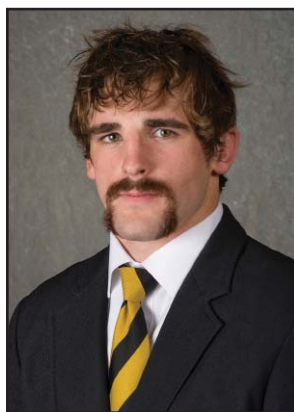
