ON THE MAT

The top-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team travels to Stillwater, Oklahoma, to face No. 8 Oklahoma State on Sunday inside Gallagher-Iba Arena. The Hawkeyes and Cowboys take the mat at 2 p.m. (CT).

The Hawkeyes have 10 wrestlers ranked in the top 20 in at least one national poll, including nine in the top 10, and five in the top 5. The Cowboys have eight wrestlers ranked in the top 20 in at least one national poll. They are led by top-ranked 165-pounder Alex Dieringer, last year's 157-pound NCAA champion.

THE SERIES

Iowa snapped a two-dual losing streak to Oklahoma State with a 24-6 win last year in Iowa City.

Oklahoma State leads the all-time series 27-19-2, including a 13-6-2 advantage in Stillwater. The Cowboys won the first meeting in the series, 24-8, in 1954. Iowa's last win in Stillwater was a 20-13 victory on Jan. 18, 2009.

POTENTIAL REMATCH

The probable lineups include four potential rematches from last year's dual -- all Iowa victories.

Thomas Gilman defeated Eddie Klimara, 2-1; Brody Grothus defeated Josh Kindig, 9-5; Sammy Brooks beat Nolan Boyd, 7-1; and Bobby Telford defeated Austin Marsden, 2-1.

TELFORD EARNS NATIONAL HONOR, TOP SPOT

Senior Bobby Telford was named USA Wrestling's Athlete of the Week after winning four matches against top 10 opponents in a span of six days. The sport's governing body announced the award Monday.

Telford won the Midlands 285-pound title on Dec. 30, knocking off No. 5 Connor Medbery (Wisconsin) in the semifinals and defeating then-top ranked Mike McMullan (Northwestern), 4-2, in the finals.

He earned a 6-2 win over No. 8 Billy Smith on Jan. 2 at Rutgers, and completed Iowa's come-from-behind dual win at Ohio State on Jan. 4 with a 4-0 shutout against No. 10 Nick Tavanello.

Telford climbed to No. 1 in the Jan. 6 Inter-mat rankings. He wrestles his fifth consecutive top 10 opponent on Sunday when he

faces No. 4 Austin Marsden of Oklahoma State. Telford is 1-0 all-time against Marsden, a 2-1 decision last year in Iowa City.

UNDEFEATED ALL-AMERICANS

Three of Iowa's four returning All-Americans -- Mike Evans (174), Nathan Burak (197), and Bobby Telford (285) -- are a combined 42-0 this season with 22 pins.

Evans, and Telford are all 16-0. Telford has nine pins, one major decision, and one win via medial forfeit. Evans has nine wins by bonus points.

Burak is 10-0 with two pins, one major decision, and one technical fall. He has claimed two tournament titles wrestling unattached at the Luther Open and Midlands Championships. He wrestled attached for the first time Jan. 4 at Ohio State and earned a 2-1 win over No. 7 Kyle Snyder.

Clark, Iowa's other returning All-American, was 14-0 before losing for the first time to Ohio State's ninth-ranked Johnny DiJulius, 7-5. Clark is 14-1 overall with seven falls, one technical fall, and one major decision.

All four returning All-Americans won Midlands individual titles on Dec. 30.

The Hawkeyes have crowned at least one All-American every year since 1972, a span of 43 seasons. Iowa has totaled 261 All-America honors during that stretch. The Hawkeyes crowned six All-Americans in 2014, including four-time All-American Derek St. John (157) and first-timers Clark (125) and Burak (197). Tony Ramos earned his third career All-America honor, winning the 133-pound bracket, and Evans (174) and Telford (285) were both named All-Americans for the second time in their careers.

HAWKEYES IN THE RANKINGS

Iowa has 10 wrestlers ranked in the top 10 of the latest Inter-mat rankings (Jan. 6), more than any other school.

Five of Iowa's wrestlers are ranked in the top 5, including Thomas Gilman (5), Cory Clark (5), Brandon Sorensen (5), Mike Evans (2), and Bobby Telford (1).

Three more Hawkeyes are projected in the top eight, including Josh Dziewa (8), Nick Moore Sammy Brooks (7), and Nathan Burak (6). Nick Moore is ranked No. 9 at 165, and Michael Kelly is ranked No. 16 at 157.

EVANS EXTENDS STREAK

Senior Mike Evans blanked Rutgers' Phil Bukuckas, 5-0, and defeated Ohio State's 12th-ranked Mark Martin, 5-2, to improve to 16-0. The 16 consecutive wins is a career-long, and five more than his previous streak of 11 set in 2013-14.

Evans has 93 career wins, more than any other active Hawkeye, and his 60 career dual starts are most on the team. He is 50-10 all-time in duals.

SORENSEN BREAKS INTO TOP 5

Redshirt freshman Brandon Sorensen improved to 21-2 following a 9-7 win over fifth-ranked Hunter Stieber on Jan. 4 at Ohio State.

Sorensen is now ranked No. 5 by Intermat. His 21 wins lead the team. He also has a team-high six major decisions to go along with five falls and two technical falls.

A LITTLE EXTRA FROM BROOKS

Sophomore Sammy Brooks has 16 wins this season, and 12 have come with bonus points. Brooks is 16-1 overall with six pins, three technical falls, and three major decisions. He also has one win via medical forfeit. He has four wins over ranked opponents this season, and placed third at the Midlands Championships. His six falls rank second on the team behind Telford (9) and Clark (7).

KELLY GET NO. 50, ENTERS RANKINGS

Senior Michael Kelly defeated 13th-ranked Anthony Perrotti on Jan. 2 to earn his 50th career win.

The fifth-year senior is 50-30 in his career, including a 15-2 mark with four falls this season at 157 pounds. His 50 career wins are the fifth most among active Hawkeyes, and his 38 career dual starts is fourth most among active Hawkeyes.

Kelly split a pair of matches last week against ranked opponents. He defeated Perrotti, but fell to No. 5 Josh Demas of Ohio State, 5-2. Despite the loss, Kelly entered the rankings for the first time this season. He is ranked No. 16 by Intermat.

BRANDS GETS WIN NO. 150

The Hawkeyes' 11th straight win over Iowa State on Nov. 29 was Tom Brands' 150th career win at Iowa. He is 153-15-1 (.908) in eight-plus seasons as Iowa's head coach. Only Dave McCuskey (160) and Dan Gable (355) have more dual wins at Iowa.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 948-224-31 (.799) in 105 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 53 NCAA Champions have won a total of 81 NCAA

individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 110 Big Ten champions have combined for 191 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 29 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 150 All-Americans have earned All-America status 307 times, including 18 four-time, 32 three-time and 39 two-time honorees.

40 YEARS SINCE NO. 1

Iowa will celebrate the 40th anniversary of its first national championship on Friday, Jan. 23, at 7 p.m. against Northwestern.

Gary Kurdelmeier led Iowa to its first NCAA Championship in 1975, and in the 40 years since, the Hawkeyes have accumulated 23 team titles, more than any other school -- Oklahoma State (7), Penn State (4), Minnesota (3), Iowa State (2), and Arizona State (1).

NCAA EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeyes have seven wrestlers with NCAA Championships experience. Seniors Mike Evans (174) and Bobby Telford (285) are three-time NCAA qualifiers. Telford earned All-America honors in 2012 and 2014, while Evans earned All-America honors in 2013 and 2014. Junior Nathan Burak (197) and sophomore Cory Clark (125) also advanced to the All-America stand in 2014. Burak was making his second NCAA tournament appearance, while Clark was making his first. Senior Nick Moore (165) has competed in two NCAA Championships (2013, 2014), and last year senior Josh Dziewa (141) and junior Brody Grothus (149) made their first career appearances.

HAWKEYES ON TV

Iowa's regular season duals Minnesota, and Penn State will air live on BTN. The Hawkeyes wrestle at Minnesota on Jan. 30 at 6 p.m., and at Penn State on Feb. 8 at 12 p.m.

BTN will televise the semifinal and final rounds of the Cliff Keen National Duals, hosted by the University of Iowa on Feb. 21-22. The semifinals will air Saturday on BTN at 3 p.m. The finals will be televised Sunday at 11:30 a.m.

BTN is televised the final round of the Midlands Championships, and will televise the final round of the Big Ten Championships on March 8, 2015, at 2 p.m. The 2015 conference tournament is hosted by Ohio State.

Tickets are \$10 for Saturday, Feb. 21 (quarterfinals and semifinals), and \$20 for Sunday, Feb. 22 (finals and consolation finals). Prices are for all ages, and everyone needs a ticket for entry.

LAST MEETING -- JAN. 10, 2014 in Iowa City, Iowa

Iowa won 8-of-10 bouts to top fifth-ranked Oklahoma State, 24-6, on Jan. 10, 2014 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The 18-point margin of victory was Iowa's largest over the Cow-boys since a 29-10 win in 1995.

Third-ranked Iowa won all eight bouts by decision, and won four matches they were not favored, including a win at 133, where fourth-ranked Tony Ramos used two takedowns and three nearfall points to defeat top-ranked Jon Morrison, 8-2. Ramos' win was on the heels of Thomas Gilman's 4-2 at 125 and stretched Iowa's team lead to 6-3.

Oklahoma State's 14th-ranked Anthony Collica cut the lead in half with a 5-3 win over No. 9 Josh Dziewa at 141, but Brody Grothus swung momentum back toward the Hawkeyes with a 9-5 win over No. 3 Josh Kindig at 149.

Grothus scored a takedown in the first, scored a reversal and three nearfall points in the second, and added 3:11 of riding time.

St. John extended Iowa's lead to 12-3 before intermission with a 2-1 win over No. 2 Alex Dieringer. The match was scoreless after one period, and Dieringer had a tight ride on St. John until the defending NCAA champion scored a reversal with 24 seconds left in the second.

Fifth-ranked Nick Moore extended Iowa's lead to 15-3 with a 3-1 overtime win over No. 2 Tyler Caldwell at 165. Moore and Caldwell exchanged escapes in the second and third periods before Moore finished a shot with 15 seconds left in the first sudden-victory period.

Top-ranked Chris Perry held on for a 5-4 win over No. 6 Mike Evans at 174 to cut Iowa's lead to 15-6, but Sammy Brooks, Nathan Burak, and Bobby Telford closed the dual with three straight wins. Brooks used two takedowns and two back-points to defeat No. 16 Nolan Boyd, 7-1, at 184, and Burak used three takedowns to defeat Jordan Rogers, 8-3, at 197. Telford earned a 2-1 win over No. 15 Austin Marsden at 285.

Tom Brands
Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands completed his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 153-15-1 (.907) overall and 61-6 (.908) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 170-35-1 (.826) career mark.

In eight seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning nine NCAA champions, 11 Big Ten champions and 44 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 61 academic all-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 72 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last eight years, sending the entire 10-man line-

up in 2009, 2010, and 2014. Iowa has also won or shared six of the last seven Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, Iowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the then-national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when Iowa defeated Iowa State, 20-15, on Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' eight seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.

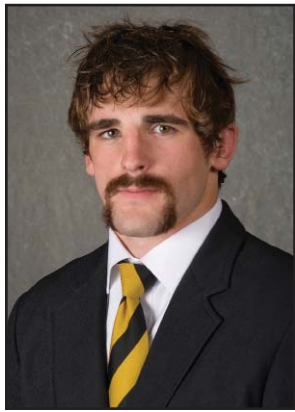
