• The Hawkeyes are making their first trip to Minneapolis to face the Gophers since the 2012 season. All three games were decided by one run with the Gophers taking 2-of-3 games. (lowa played at Target Field in the 2015 Big Ten Tournament.)

• lowa is 4-1 in its last five games -- its best five-game stretch of the season.

• The Hawkeyes hit four home runs in their 12-3 victory over Northern Illinois on March 29. It was the team's most home runs in a game since 2010 in a win over Coe College.

 Iowa has won three straight Big Ten-opening series after taking 2-of-3 games against Maryland last weekend in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes have won nine of their last 10 Big Ten series dating back to the end of the 2014 season.

 Freshman Robert Neustrom earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors March 28 after hitting .500 in Iowa's 3-1 week. Iowa has had two players (Zach Daniels) earn the distinction this season.

• The Hawkeyes have posted six come-from-behind victories during the 2016 season. Iowa tallied its seventh walk-off victory since the start of 2015 when it defeated Bradley, 7-6, on March 22.

• Iowa is leading the Big Ten in team fielding percentage -- a staple of Rick Heller-coached teams -- at .977. Iowa ranks 30th nationally in the category.

• Sophomore Nick Gallagher is 2-1 with a 0.68 ERA in his last three appearances, allowing one run on seven hits over 13 1/3 innings. He has 14 strikeouts to five walks during the stretch.

UI head coach Rick Heller is in his third season leading the Hawkeye baseball program.

Heller, an Eldon, Iowa, native, has been head coach at four institutions -- Iowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99) -- leading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

Heller is the winningest coach in his first two seasons in Iowa history, posting a 71-41 record, and he is one of two UI head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament. In 28 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 761-606-4.

The Hawkeyes had a breakthrough season in Heller's second season in Iowa City, going 41-18 with the 41 victories being the second-most alltime and just the fourth 40-win season in program history. Iowa earned the school's first NCAA Regional berth since 1990, where it went 2-2 at the Springfield Regional for the program's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972.

The Hawkeyes rolled to a 15-5 start and won its first 11 series of the season, including a school-record eight consecutive Big Ten series wins dating back to the 2014 season. Iowa swept No. 19 Indiana to open Big Ten play to catapult the Hawkeyes into the national rankings for the first time in 25 years. Iowa climbed to as high as No. 13 before finishing the year 20th by Collegiate Baseball, 25th by Baseball America, and 28th by the NCBWA -- the program's first appearance in the final rankings in school history.

Heller guided lowa to a Big Ten runner-up (three games ahead of the third place finisher) finish in a year where the league was at its alltime best with a record five NCAA Regional participants. Iowa went 19-5 in conference play for a .792 winning percentage -- the best winning percentage by a second place team since the Big Ten returned to single division play in 1988.

In NCAA Regional play, Heller led the Hawkeyes to a pair of wins over Oregon in Springfield, Missouri, and lost two games to No. 8 national seed Missouri State by a combined three runs. Senior reliever Nick Hibbing was tabbed as the Springfield Regional's Most Outstanding Player and was named to the all-tournament team.

Under Heller's watch, Iowa had a pair of players earn three All-America distinctions, had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections, and a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award.

IOWA TIDBITS

 Iowa opened Big Ten play by taking 2-of-3 from Maryland last weekend at Duane Banks Field. It was the team's third straight Big Ten-opening series victory.

• The Hawkeyes have won nine of their last 10 league series dating back to the final weekend of the 2014 season. Iowa's only series loss was at Rutgers last season.

 lowa has 13 home runs in 22 games this season with eight different players hitting at least one home run. Nick Roscetti, Joel Booker, Tyler Peyton, Austin Guzzo, and Daniel Aaron Moriel have two home runs apiece. The Hawkeyes had 14 home runs in 59 games in 2015.

MINNESOTA NOTABLES

• The Gophers are 13-9 overall after beating Saint Mary's (Minn.), 9-1, on Wednesday at Siebert Field. Last weekend, Minnesota took 2-of-3 games at Missouri State, sweeping a Saturday doubleheader, 12-5 and 7-5.

• Minnesota leads the Big Ten with a .333 team batting average with seven regulars hitting .300 or better. Three players are in the top eight in the Big Ten in hitting and the Gophers average 6.7 runs per game. Austin Athmann has a .412 average with five home runs, 19 RBIs and 14 runs scored, Terrin Vavra is hitting .403 with 14 RBIs, and Matt Fielder has scored 20 runs, while hitting .389 and is 7-of-7 on the base paths.

• The Gophers have a 4.50 team ERA, allowing 107 runs (96 earned) and have 159 strikeouts to 85 walks. RHP Matt Fiedler (3-2, 4.15 ERA) will start Friday, LHP Dalton Sawyer (3-2, 3.90 ERA) Saturday, and RHP Toby Anderson (3-0, 5.06 ERA) Sunday.

• lowa beat Sawyer, 7-1, in the series finale last year, scoring five runs on three hits in 3 1/3 innings.

SERIES RECORD

• The Gophers lead the all-time series over lowa,

178-115, in a series that dates back to 1892.
The Hawkeyes have won the last two series over Minnesota, taking 2-of-3 games in 2014 and sweeping the three-game series last season. It was lowa's first season sweep of the Gophers since 1990 when it went 4-0 and the first time the Hawkeyes have won back-to-back series since 1962 and 1963.

• lowa hasn't won three straight series over the Gophers since 1948, 1949, and 1950.

SEE YA LATER

The Hawkeyes hit four home runs in their 12-3 victory over Northern Illinois on March 29 at Duane Banks Field. It was the team's first four home run game since 2010 -- a 16-6 victory over Coe College. Senior Tyler Peyton hit a grand slam in Iowa's eight-run sixth inning. It was Iowa's first grand slam since Blake Hickman hit one at Austin Peay in Rick Heller's second game as Iowa's head coach.

NEUSTROM HONORED

Freshman Robert Neustrom was honored as the Big Ten Freshman of the Week on March 28 after hitting .500 in helping lowa to a 3-1 record last week. Neustrom had hits in three of four games, including two multi-hit contests, and posted a .667 slugging and .462 on-base percentage.

Neustrom is Iowa's second freshman of the Week honoree this season, joining Zach Daniels, who was honored March 14. It is the first time Iowa has had two different players earn the freshman honoree in the same season.

HE'S A FRESHMAN?

After getting off to a slow start to his freshman season, Robert Neustrom has adjusted well to Division I baseball. The Sioux City, Iowa native is hitting .370 -- tops among Iowa's regulars -- with eight RBIs and eight runs scored. All eight RBIs have come in the team's last 10 games.

• Neustrom has three multi-hit games in lowa's last four contests. He went 2-for-3 with two runs and a triple in the series opening win over Maryland and tallied his third three-hit game in game two, series-clinching victory.

• Against Northern Illinois, Neustrom connected on his first career home run -- a two-run shot into the wind to right field and finished 2-for-3 with two runs and a career-high four RBIs.

• The outfielder is hitting .469 (15-of-32) with eight RBIs, four extra base hits, and six runs scored over his last 10 games.

PITCHING EMERGES

lowa's pitching staff emerged in the Big Ten series-opening victory over Maryland. The Hawkeyes limited the Terrapins to six runs over 27 innings, posting a 2.00 ERA and striking out 23







to seven walks. Maryland hit .221 in the threegame series.

COMPLETE GAME C.J.

Redshirt sophomore C.J. Eldred notched his first career complete game in lowa's 8-1 seriesopening victory over Maryland on March 25. The Mount Vernon, lowa native allowed one run on six hits, induced three double plays, and struck out a career-high nine batters.

A WALK-OFF WINNER

• lowa rallied for a 7-6 victory over Bradley with two runs in the bottom of the ninth inning on March 22 at Banks Field. It was the Hawkeyes' first win when trailing after six innings this season.

• Seniors Eric Schenck-Joblinske tripled and scored the tying run when Zach Daniels reached on an RBI fielder's choice. Nick Roscetti's RBI single gave lowa its seventh walk-off victory in the last season and a half.

BANKS MAGIC

lowa is 21-4 at home since the start of the 2015 season. The Hawkeyes went 17-3 last season for the most home victories since 1996. lowa has five walk-off victories at Duane Banks Field since the start of 2015.

THINGS ARE "ROSEY"

After hitting .391 in Big Ten play as a junior, senior Nick Roscetti has started 2016 where he left off.

• Roscetti is tied for fifth in the Big Ten in doubles (8), tied for eighth in runs scored and RBIs (20), ninth in total bases (47), 11th in hits (33), and 12th in hitting (.363).

Roscetti has a team-best 12 multi-hit games and six multi-RBI contests. He had a career-best 15-game hitting streak from Feb. 26-March 22.
He has six games with two or more RBIs, including a four-RBI performance, tying a career-high, in Iowa's 7-6 walk-off victory over Bradley on March 22. Roscetti had the game-winning RBI single in the bottom of the ninth inning.
Roscetti is hitting .390 (16-of-41) over his last 10 games with 10 RBIs and eight runs scored.

BOOKER'S BREAKOUT

Senior Joel Booker is doing his part to be the catalyst at the top of the Hawkeye lineup. In his first season as Iowa's leadoff hitter, the Columbus, North Carolina, native is having a breakout season.

The outfielder is hitting .337 with 31 hits and 20 runs scored. He has seven doubles, two triples, and two home runs -- surpassing his is extra base hit output from his junior season.
Booker is second on the team with nine multihit games, including four three-hit contests.
He had a career-best 14-game hitting streak

and reached safely in 18 consecutive games earlier this season. He has hit safely in 17-of-22 games and reached safely in all but two contests. • Booker has posted career-bests in hits (4 vs. Chicago State), RBIs (4 vs. Savannah State), and tied a career-high in runs (3 at Missouri State) this season.

DANIELS EARNS B1G HONOR

Freshman Zach Daniels earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors on March 14 after hitting .571 with five RBIs and three runs scored in two lowa victories. He had four RBIs in a 28-0 win over Northwestern College and went 3-for-4 with two runs and an RBI in a win over Savannah State.

Daniels is the first Hawkeye to earn Freshman of the Week honors since Austin Guzzo in 2015.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

• Tyler Peyton is hitting .324 over his last 10 games with eight RBIs and six runs. He had the go-ahead two-run single in lowa's 4-1 comefrom-behind victory to clinch the series win over Maryland. Six of Peyton's 10 RBIs have come in the last three games.

• Sophomore Austin Guzzo scored five runs against Northwestern College to tie a school record. He is one of three players to score five runs in a game and the first since John Mahoney in 1978.

SOPHOMORE C.J. ELDRED...

• has been lowa's most consistent pitcher, going 2-2 with a 2.09 ERA in six appearances (five starts).

• has 27 strikeouts to 10 walks in 38 2/3 innings and is limiting opposing batters to a .213 batting average.

• has a team-best three quality starts. He has allowed one run or fewer in three of his five starts. • pitched his first career complete game, allowing one run on six hits and striking out nine to out duel Maryland All-American Mike Shawaryn. posted back-to-back quality starts against Southern Illinois and Omaha... threw nine innings of two-hit, one run ball against the SIU. He had a no-hitter through 7 2/3 innings, but wasn't involved in the decision. He allowed three runs in six innings in a 3-2 loss to Omaha. picked up his first career win against Dartmouth in his first career start, allowing one run on four hits over five innings, fanning five. • sat out the 2015 season after transferring from Indiana University, where he redshirted in 2014. • is the son of former Hawkeye first round MLB

MCCOY'S BREAKOUT SUMMER

Junior college transfer Mason McCoy, a two-time All-American at Illinois Central College, had a breakout summer in the Northwoods League, breaking league single-season records in hits (112), runs (80), and total bases (168). The Washington, Illinois, native was the Northwoods League MVP, La Crosse Loggers MVP, an NWL All-Star, and a Postseason All-Star.

• UI head coach Rick Heller is one of nine coaches alltime (one of four active) to lead three different NCAA Division I teams to regional play.


