THE FIRST PITCH

FIRST TIME FOES

Morehead State has never faced Alabama State or Iowa in its program history.

GIANT SLAYERS

Morehead State has defeated a nationally-ranked (in the top 40) opponent in three of the last four seasons, including its 13-8 win at No. 27 (NCBWA) Mississippi State Tuesday. In 2015, MSU's OVC Championship season, the Eagles opened the year with three wins at No. 34 San Diego. In 2014, MSU knocked off No. 12 Kentucky and No. 23 Indiana in the same week.

SPEAKING OF STREAKING

Four players - sophomore catcher **Hunter Fain**, sophomore leftfielder **Niko Hulsizer**, sophomore shortstop **Reid Leonard** and senior right fielder **Will Schneider** - have reached base in all five games. Dating back to the end of 2016, Fain has now reached safely in 14 straight games, while Schneider's streak sits at 10 games.

GET ON THE BOARD EARLY = WINS

In this early part of the season, Morehead State has managed to light up the scoreboard for at least one run in the first inning three times in five games, and all three have resulted in wins.

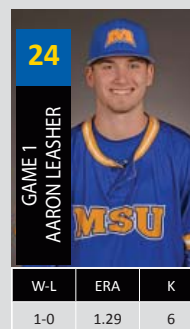
ALMOST A NO-NO

Senior right-hander **Luke Humphreys** and junior righty **David Calderon** nearly completed a no-hitter last Sunday at Jackson State. Humphreys only allowed a bunt single just inside the third-base line in his 5.1 innings of work, while Calderon picked up his first career save with 3.2 of hitless ball. It was the fewest hits allowed by the Eagle pitching staff in the last 10 seasons.

NIKO 'HULK'SIZER

Sophomore leftfielder **Niko Hulsizer** blasted two home runs on opening weekend in Jackson, Miss. and both landed outside the stadium complex on the road in left field. Through four games, Hulsizer ranks in the top 20 in the OVC with a .421 batting average and slugs at a .789 clip. He led the league in batting average (.424) against OVC foes as a freshman.

CALL ON THE CABLE GUY

Senior pitcher **Cable Wright** has been an absolute workhorse in his career, and in fact he already owns the Morehead State career record for appearances with 90. Wright needs 16 appearances this season to set the Ohio Valley Conference record, held by Eastern Kentucky's Robert Teague (1988-91) with 107.

FLYIN RYAN

Senior outfielder **Ryan Kent** has the opportunity to set the Morehead State record for doubles in a career, needing just 15 to accomplish the feat. He is also on the all-time singles list (7th - 150), as well as total plate appearances (6th - 788) and runs scored (7th - 151)

LEASH SHUTS 'EM DOWN

Junior lefty Aaron Leasher tossed two complete-game shutouts in 2016, blanking Belmont with 12 strikeouts on March 26 and shutting down SIUE on the road with a career-best 15 Ks on April 23. Leasher's 107 punchouts were the third highest in a single season in program history.

SOLID IN THE FIELD

Morehead State sports a .985 fielding percentage in the first five games, having made just three errors in 194 chances.

NEWBIES GET THEIR FEET WET

In Morehead State's opening weekend in Jackson, Miss., six new pitchers got their first taste of Division I baseball. Freshmen **Jake Ziegelmeier**, **Dalton Stambaugh**, **Alex Garbrick**, **John Hurayt III** and **Dom Masullo** each tossed at least an inning, while junior college transfer **JC Hatcher** made his first Division I start.

PRESEASON HONORS FOR TWO

Senior outfielder **Will Schneider** (.343 BA, 17 2B, 10 HR) and sophomore shortstop **Reid Leonard** (.344 BA, 12 2B, 32 RBI) were named to the official Preseason All-OVC Team.

FABULOUS FRESHMEN

Now sophomores **Reid Leonard** and **Trevor Snyder** were named Freshmen Americans in 2016. Snyder earned the nod from two outlets - Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association while Leonard was tabbed by CB.

HUNTING BASE STEALERS

Sophomore catcher **Hunter Fain** has thrown out 50 percent of opponents' base stealers (4-of-8) so far after gunning down 14 last year.

MIKE MCGUIRE-- MOREHEAD STATE HEAD COACH

118-119 at Morehead State / 260-207 career head coaching record



Mike McGuire, who served as the pitching coach at Morehead State in 1995 and 1996, is in his fifth season as head coach of the Eagles. He returned to MSU prior to the 2013 season.

McGuire led Morehead State to a historic season in 2015. The Eagles posted school records for overall wins (38) and Ohio Valley Conference victories (20). MSU also captured its first league tournament title since 1993 and advanced to NCAA Regional play for the first time since 1983. McGuire was named OVC Coach of the Year.

Following the 2016 season, three Eagle pitchers (Matt Anderson - Pirates; Tyler Keele - Diamondbacks; Pat McGuff - Twins) were drafted in the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, giving the program five draft picks in the previous two seasons. Two of McGuire's seniors in 2015, Kane Sweeney (Yankees) and Brandon Rawe (Marlins), were chosen in the draft.

In 2014, under McGuire's leadership, Morehead State defeated nationally-ranked Kentucky and Indiana. The Eagles opened the 2015 season with three victories at nationally-ranked San Diego.

The Eagle offense set numerous school single-season and individual records in 2015 and ranked first the nation in five offensive categories.

McGuire, who has been in the coaching profession for more than 20 years, previously made stops at Winthrop, Lander (S.C.) and Louisburg (N.C.). He has mentored 18 All-Americans and more than 50 players who signed professional contracts.

McGuire played collegiately at Akron for two seasons before transferring to South Carolina. He participated in two NCAA Regionals as a member of the Gamecocks. He then played two professional seasons for Zanesville (Ohio) in the Frontier League, leading the Greys to the league title in 1993.

He guided the pitchers and catchers at MSU, and helped lead the Eagles to the OVC Tournament title game in 1996.

He served as assistant head coach at Winthrop from 1997-2002, where he helped lead the Eagles to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances and school-record 48 wins in 2001.

McGuire served as head coach at Lander from 2003-05. In his three seasons, the Bearcats averaged more than 30 wins and ranked among Division II's Top 25 teams. His 2004 squad established a then-school record with 33 wins.

He returned to Winthrop in 2006 as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator. The first season of his second stint saw the Eagles post a 46-18 mark and advance to the finals of the NCAA Chapel Hill Regional. In six seasons, he coached single-season and career record holders in nearly every statistical category. While coaching the offensive aspect of the game, his hitters established single-season team marks for hits, home runs and total bases.

McGuire served as head coach at Louisburg in 2012. He led the Hurricanes to a school-record 52 wins and the program's first-ever No. 1 National Junior College Athletic Association national ranking. Louisburg also constructed a school-record 27-game winning streak.

He received a bachelor's degree in sports administration from South Carolina and master's degree in health, physical education and recreation from Morehead State. He and his wife Angela have three daughters, Courtney, Sydney and Sarah.
