### HEAD COACH JIM ZALESKY

Jim Zalesky is in his eighth season as head coach at the University of Iowa. He has a school and career record of 111-24 (.820). Named National Coach of the Year in 1998 and 1999, and Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2000, he has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA (1998-00) and three Big Ten titles (1998, 2000, 2004). Zalesky has coached 10 NCAA Champions, 20 Big Ten Champions and 36 all-Americans at Iowa. He was inducted into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame in June 2004, the University of Iowa Letterman's Club Hall of Fame and the Iowa High School Athletic Association Wrestling Hall of Fame in 2002, and the Iowa Wrestling Hall of Fame in 1994.

A three-time national champion and one of Iowa's 15 four-time all-Americans, Zalesky was an assistant coach and head recruiter at Iowa under Dan Gable for seven seasons (1991-97). He was named Assistant Coach of the Year by the N.W.C.A. in 1992 and 1997. Undefeated as a junior and senior, Zalesky ended his career on an 89-match winning streak.

### WISCONSIN BADGERS

Wisconsin is 7-1-1 with wins over Wisconsin-Oshkosh (46-6), Northern Iowa (20-14), Northern Illinois (27-12), Tennessee-Chattanooga (23-12), Kent State (29-12), Cal State Fullerton (25-9) and Brown (24-9), a loss to Illinois (25-12) and a tie with Nebraska (19-19). Head Coach Barry Davis is 109-86-7 in 12 seasons at Wisconsin. The 1985 Big Ten Athlete of the Year, Davis was a four-time all-American, four-time Big Ten Champion and three-time NCAA Champion at 118 and 126 pounds for Iowa (1981-85). A two-time Olympian, Davis still holds Hawkeye records for most wins in a season (46) and a career (162).

The Badgers return seven NCAA qualifiers, and are led by defending Big Ten Champion and junior Tom Clum (125), junior Ryan Flaherty (197), sophomore Tyler Turner (157), freshman Craig Henning (149). Turner is undefeated (9-0) in dual competition, while Clum is 8-1.

### IOWA-WISCONSIN TIES

- Iowa Head Coach Jim Zalesky and Wisconsin Head Coach Barry Davis wrestled together at Iowa from 1981-84. During those four years, Iowa posted a 70-3-1 dual mark and won four Big Ten and NCAA team titles.
- Wisconsin Head Coach Barry Davis is from Cedar Rapids, IA. Davis' wife is the former Nan Doak, who was the 1985 10,000-meter NCAA Champion for the University of Iowa. She was a five-time all-American in track and three-time all-American in cross country for the Hawkeyes, winning three Big Ten titles. She still holds school records in the outdoor 5,000 meters and the cross country 5,000 meters. She is from Hedrick, IA.
- Iowa Assistant Coach Tim Hartung is from Durand, WI.
- Iowa Assistant Coach Troy Steiner served as an assistant coach under Barry Davis on the Wisconsin staff from 1997-2001. He also owned and operated the ADVANCE School of Wrestling in Madison from 2001-04.
- Wisconsin Assistant Coach Bart Chelesvig was a three-time all-American at 167 and 177 pounds for Iowa (1988-92). He is from Webster City, IA.

### LAST MEETING

Iowa defeated Wisconsin, 24-9, February 13, 2004, in Madison, WI. The Hawkeyes won seven matches, including three by major decision. Hawkeye senior **Cliff Moore** started the meet with his ninth consecutive win, scoring a 15-5 major decision over Tyler Laudon at 141 pounds, improving to 22-2 overall and 12-1 in dual competition. Iowa sophomore **Ty Eustice** followed up with a 10-2 major decision over Tony Turner at 149. Wisconsin's Tyler Turner put the Badgers on the board with his 3-2 win over **Joe Johnston** at 157 in the tiebreak period. Hawkeye redshirt freshman **Cole Pape** recorded his first major decision in dual competition with a 12-4 win over Kelly Flaherty at 165. Iowa senior **Tyler Nixt** scored a 6-1 decision over Ralph DeNisco at 174, improving to 26-1 overall and 12-1 in dual competition. Wisconsin struck again at 184 with Brady Reinke scoring a 6-4 decision over **Paul Bradley** in sudden victory. Iowa scored decisions at the next three weights, starting with senior **Ryan Fulsas**' 13-6 win over Ryan Flaherty at 197. Redshirt freshman **Ryan Fuller** followed up with a 4-1 victory over Jareck Horton at heavyweight. Iowa senior **Luke Eustice** came from behind to defeat Tom Clum, 7-5 in sudden victory at 125. **Eustice** trailed 5-3 in the third period, but recorded a takedown in the last minute of regulation to force the match to sudden victory. He then scored a takedown with three seconds left in sudden victory for the win. Following are the meet results:

### GALANAKIS NAMED BIG TEN WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

Iowa wrestler Mario Galanakis was named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week January 12. Galanakis, a junior from Greenfield, IA, wrestles at 133 pounds. He was honored for upsetting two ranked opponents and recording three wins when Iowa defeated Virginia Tech (38-0), Fresno State (30-7) and Cal-Davis (26-9). Galanakis dominated sixth-ranked David Hoffman of Virginia Tech, 8-4, scoring three takedowns, an escape and a riding time point while holding Hoffman to four escapes. He then defeated Fresno State's Joe Mavins, 7-0, before beating top-20 ranked Derek Moore of Cal-Davis, 5-4.

### CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has been the home for Iowa wrestling since 1983. The Hawkeyes have a record of 143-11 (.928) in the arena, which includes a record 10 victories during the 1986 season. Iowa has recorded 16 undefeated seasons in the arena, with the most recent (8-0) occurring in 2002-03. The dual wrestling attendance record for Carver-Hawkeye Arena is 15,291, which was set when Iowa defeated Iowa State on February 22, 1992. The arena seats 15,500 for a dual wrestling meet. The Hawkeyes are scheduled to host the 2005 Big Ten Championships in Carver-Hawkeye.

### LAST WEEK

The Hawkeye wrestling team lost a 26-12 dual at Oklahoma State in Stillwater, OK. It was the top-ranked Cowboy's fifth-straight dual win over Iowa, as they improved to 8-0 this season. Iowa fell to 5-2 in dual competition. The Hawkeyes recorded wins in three matches, including a pin by junior **Joe Johnston** at 157, but it was not enough to hold off the defending NCAA champions.

Hawkeye freshman **Charlie Falck** put Iowa on the scoreboard with a 5-3 decision over freshman Coleman Scott at 125 pounds. **Falck** scored a takedown and nearfall points as time expired in the match to pick up his fourth dual victory of the season. Oklahoma State built a 10-3 team lead on freshman Nathan Morgan's 12-3 major decision over Hawkeye junior **Mario Galanakis** at 133, senior Ronnie Delk's 3-2 decision over Iowa fresh-

man **Alex Tsirtsis** at 141 and top-ranked Zack Esposito's 2-1 win in the first tiebreak period over Iowa junior **Ty Eustice** at 149. **Johnston's** pin over junior Kevin Ward at 157 pulled the Hawkeyes to within one team point, but Oklahoma State scored wins in four of the final five weight classes to seal the team victory. Cowboy junior Johny Hendricks spoiled Hawkeye redshirt freshman and Stillwater, OK, native **Mark Perry's** homecoming, scoring a 3-1 win at 165. Perry is the nephew of Oklahoma State Head Coach John Smith. Top-ranked Chris Pendleton proved to be too much for Hawkeye freshman **Luke Lofthouse** at 174, scoring a pin in 1:31. Iowa senior **Paul Bradley** scored a 6-4 win at 184 over Clay Kehrer, but that would be the last team points for the Hawkeyes as top-ranked Jake Rosholt scored a 21-6 technical fall in 6:28 over Iowa junior **Adam Fellers** at 197 and top-ranked Steven Mocco recorded a 4-0 decision over Hawkeye freshman **Matt Fields** at heavyweight. One team point was deducted from Oklahoma State because of unsportsmanlike conduct from Mocco. Here are the match-by-match results:

### IOWA WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 779-199-30 (.780) in 93 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 20 national titles, including nine of the last 14, and 31 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 47 NCAA Champions have won a total of 73 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 13 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 99 Big Ten Champions have won a total of 180 conference individual titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time and 24 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 124 all-Americans have earned all-America status 254 times, including 16 four-time, 27 three-time and 28 two-time honorees.

### CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeye wrestling staff of **Jim Zalesky**, **Troy Steiner**, **Tim Hartung**, **Cliff Moore** and **Mike Zadick** earned a total of seven NCAA titles, 12 Big Ten titles and 17 all-America honors. Their combined college career wrestling record is 619-88-1 (.875), including four undefeated seasons.
