THIS WEEK -- The Hawkeye men will be competing in the two-day UNI Invitational in Cedar Falls, IA, Friday and Saturday in the UNI-Dome. The men's heptathlon will start at 3:10 p.m. Friday afternoon and will also be the first event Saturday at 10 a.m. Running events are scheduled to begin at 1:30 p.m.

LAST WEEK -- The Iowa men's team came home with two first-place finishes in the Jack Johnson Classic (formerly the Gold Country Classic) at Minnesota. Sophomore **Shane Maier** won his second shot put title in as many weeks with a collegiate best toss of 58-11.25. Classmate **Jake Berns** also ran to a personal best time of 4:10.10 on his way to winning the mile.

Along with several other top ten finishes, many athletes set new collegiate bests in the meet.

-- *Freshmen:* **David Chaplin**, 60 meters (6.95); **John Hickey**, weight throw (40-7.75); **Richard Johnson**, pole vault (14-6.25); **Daniel Peoples**, 800 meters (1:57.13); **David Pierre**, 60 meters (7.15); **Jay Renaud**, 800 meters (2:02.27); **Mark Schaapveld**, weight throw (48-4.5) and shot put (50-4.5); **Blake Schlotzauer**, mile (4:22.30); **Alex Webster**, mile (4:16.90); **Brice Wilson**, 200 meters (24.34); **Bobby Windauer**, 800 meters (2:0-8.64) and long jump, 19-11.75.

NCAA QUALIFIER -- **Shane Maier** improved his provisional qualifying mark for the NCAA Indoor Championships in the shot put with a throw of 58-11.25. The Storm Lake, IA, native threw a qualifying mark of 58-6 last week at the Hawkeye Open.

CRACKING THE TOP TEN -- Three track and field athletes have made it into the Top Ten Indoor Performers list so far this season. Junior **Lee Elbert** is seventh on the 60 meter dash list with his time of 6.91 in the Hawkeye Open. Sophomore **Ryan Jordan** is eighth on the weight throwing list with a toss of 57-0.75. **Shane Maier** moved up to the number-six slot after the Jack Johnson Classic with a shot put mark of 58-11.25.

IOWA MEN'S COACHING STAFF -- Head Coach **Larry Wiecek** is in his 10th season at the helm of the Iowa men's track team. During his career at Iowa, Wiecek has coached 23 all-Americans and 35 Big Ten Champions. Iowa's highest conference meet finishes during his tenure are second at the 1999 outdoor meet and fourth at the 1997 indoor meet. As a runner, **Wiecek** was a six-time Big Ten champion for Iowa, winning four track and two cross country titles. He was also a four-time all-American. In 1998, **Wiecek** was inducted into the National Iowa Varsity Club Hall of Fame.

Scott Cappos is in his ninth year as an assistant coach at Iowa. While he is involved with all parts of the men's track and field program, his main focus is developing the field event athletes.

Pat McGhee is in his 15th season as an assistant coach at Iowa. McGhee serves primarily as hurdling, jumps and sprints coach, but is involved in all facets of the squad.
