Post game comments by Illinois Coach Mike White:

"It was a painful experience. We have no excuses. You have so gredit lows. They did a great job. They did what they had to do. Iowa made the crucial downs when they had to. Illinois didn't. It's that simple."

Post game comments by Iowa Coacg GHayden Fry:

"I've got the most beautiful pasyers in the world. They're not the best, but they just don't quit. I couldn't care if we didn't win a game the rest of the season. It's just a thrill to coach men like them. These guys are all great citizens."
