Program Quick Hits

- Iowa is one of 10 teams in the country, and the only Big Ten team, to have appeared in the last eight NCAA Tournaments. There are 349 Division I teams.
- The Hawkeyes made their first Sweet Sixteen appearance since 1996, and their sixth overall, last season.
- Iowa is 1-of-21 teams to advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in each of the last two seasons.
- Iowa ended the season with a No. 11 national ranking in the *USA Today* Top 25 Coaches' Poll -- the highest for the program since 1995-96 (No. 7 in AP, No. 9 in *USA Today*). The Hawkeyes appeared in the rankings in all 20 weeks of the season.
- The Hawkeyes finished undefeated at home for the first time since 1995-96 last season, setting a program record with 18 wins. Iowa was one of 13 teams nationally to finish undefeated at home during the regular season and one of four to finish undefeated at home when playing at least 16 home games (Baylor, Tennessee, and Wichita State).
- The Hawkeyes ended the 2014-15 year ranked sixth nationally in scoring offense (79.5), setting a new school record for the second consecutive season. In 2013-14, Iowa finished the season with an average of 78.2 points per game.
- Iowa returns two starters in junior Ally Disterhoff and sophomore Whitney Jennings. The 2015-16 roster is comprised of four freshman, four sophomores, three juniors, and three seniors.
- The 2015-16 squad gained valuable experience this August. The Hawkeyes spent 11 days together on the Italian Tour, which included three games, and benefitted from 10 practice days leading up to the trip.
- Iowa's 2015 recruiting class of Tania Davis (Michigan Miss Basketball), Hannah Stewart (North Dakota Miss Basketball), Megan Gustafson (all-time leading scorer in Wisconsin high school basketball history), and Tagyn Larson (four-time all-state, all-city, and all-conference player) came in with a No. 17 national ranking by ESPN HoopGurlz.
- Junior Ally Disterhoff was named a preseason All-Big Ten player by the coaches in October. As a sophomore, she earned second team All-Big Ten honors from both the coaches and the media. As a freshman, she was named honorable mention All-Big Ten by the coaches and media and to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team.
- Sixteenth-year UI head coach Lisa Bluder has led Iowa to three consecutive 20-win seasons and eight overall. She was the recipient of the WBCA's Carol Eckman Award in 2015.

THE MATCHUP

The University of Iowa women's basketball team hosts Purdue on Thursday, Feb. 18 at 7 p.m. (CT) inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

PROMOTIONS

- Thursday is Alumni Association Night. Discounted tickets are available for UI Alumni Association members (\$8 for adults, free for youth) if ordered in advance.
- Fans who bring a new, unopened pet toy or food to donate to the Iowa City Animal Shelter will receive \$2 off admission to any home game this season as a part of Hawkeye Pet Night.

GAME COVERAGE

- Fans can watch Thursday's game live online through BTN Plus available at btn2go.com.
- Audio of the contest is available on select Hawkeye Radio Network affiliate stations and on Hawkeye All-Access available at hawkeyesports.com. Brent Balbinot and Kathryn Reynolds will call the action.
- Balbinot is in his 12th year as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Reynolds is in her first providing analysis.
- Reynolds, a member of the infamous Core Four and team captain for the Hawkeyes in 2014-15, is pursuing a law degree at the University of Iowa.
- Links to video, audio, and Gametracker (live stats) are available on the women's basketball schedule page at hawkeyesports.com.

SERIES RUNDOWN

- Purdue leads Iowa, 36-31, in the all-time series, but the Hawkeyes hold an 18-10 edge in games played inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- The Hawkeyes have won three consecutive games against the Boilermakers in Iowa City. This is the first home game of the series since 2012-13.
- In the Lisa Bluder era, Iowa trails Purdue, 17-11.

A LOOK AT THE BOILERMAKERS

- The Boilermakers, who enter the game 16-9 overall and 7-7 in Big Ten play, have lost four consecutive games against Maryland, at Wisconsin, at Maryland, and against Michigan.
- As a team, Purdue averages 68.4 points and 36.4 rebounds per contest. Three average double figures in scoring, including April Wilson (14.6), Ashley Morrissette (12.5), and Bridget Perry (11.5).
- In conference games alone, Purdue averages 69.6 points and 36.4 rebounds per game. Four average double figures, including Wilson (14.5), Morrissette (12.9), Perry (11.8), and Andreona Keys (10.2).

SEASON REWIND

- The Hawkeyes fell to the Boilermakers, 90-73, on Jan. 24, 2016.
- Iowa shot 52.0 percent, but the Boilermakers shot 58.6 percent and outrebounded the Hawkeyes 34 to 20 for the win.
- Disterhoff led the Hawkeyes offensively with 21 points, followed by Tania Davis and Christina Buttenham who

each netted 14. Davis dished out a team-high seven assists and Chase Coley pulled down a team-high eight rebounds.

• Purdue had four score in double figures for the win, including April Wilson (24), Dominique McBryde (18), Ashely Morrissette (15), and Andreona Keys (10). Wilson added 12 assists for a double-double.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

• In the last six games, freshman Megan Gustafson has posted five double-doubles, the first of her career.

• The stretch began with three consecutive double-doubles against Michigan (12 rebounds, 10 points) on Jan. 28, at Northwestern (15 points, 13 rebounds) on Jan. 31, and at Indiana (12 points, 10 rebounds).

• After recording eight rebounds and seven points against Michigan State on Feb. 7, Gustafson returned to her double-double ways with 13 points and 11 rebounds against Ohio State on Feb. 11.

• The Port Wing, Wisconsin, native secured her fifth double-double at Minnesota on Feb. 15, tallying 14 points and a career-high 19 boards. The last player to record more than 17 rebounds in a game was Samantha Logic (vs. Drake on Dec. 21, 2013). The Iowa record for rebounds in a game is 26 (Jerica Watson vs. Creighton on Dec. 15, 2001).

• Gustafson has led Iowa in rebounds in six-straight contests, after not registering a single rebound against Purdue on Jan. 24.

BIG DIFFERENCE

• Since altering the lineup to include freshman Megan Gustafson and sophomore Chase Coley, the Hawkeyes have seen an increase in production offensively.

• In the last seven games, Iowa has had five players average double figures in scoring rather than three in the previous 19 games. Leading the pack is junior Ally Disterhoft (18.9), followed by Coley (14.4), sophomore Whitney Jennings (11.4), Gustafson (11.1), and freshman Tania Davis (11.0).

• The team has also increased its points per game average from 73.0 to 76.7.

• Gustafson, who has led Iowa in rebounds in six consecutive games, has seen her rebounds per game average spike from 4.8 to 10.4 in the last seven games, while Coley has made the jump from 5.0 to 7.6.

• The 6-3 duo accounts for 50 percent of the team's rebounding effort and 33 percent of Iowa's offensive production.

MOVING UP THE CHARTS

• Junior Ally Disterhoft is 14th all-time in three-point field goals made (101), 15th all-time in scoring (1,420 career points), and 18th all-time in rebounding (575 career rebounds) in Iowa women's basketball history.

• Disterhoft, who has played in every game of her Hawkeye career with 77 consecutive starts, has scored double figures in every game this year and in 71 of her 77 career starts.

• Megan Gustafson has compiled 42 blocks through 26 games played this season, which is fourth on the all-time freshman list at Iowa. The program record of 79 stuffs was set by Morgan Johnson in 2009-10. Gustafson averages a team-leading 1.6 blocks per contest and has compiled three or more stuffs in seven games this season.

DISTERHOFT EARNED ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT ACCOLADES

• Junior Ally Disterhoft earned Capital One Academic All-District first team recognition for the second consecutive season for her efforts on the court and in the classroom on Feb. 11.

• She advances to the Capital One Academic All-America Team ballot, where first, second, and third team All-America honorees will be elected in late February.

• Disterhoft, the lone sophomore in the country to earn Capital One Academic All-America third team accolades in 2015, is a business major studying accounting and finance.

• The Iowa City, Iowa, native is a four-time Dean's List honoree, academic All-Big Ten selection, Big Ten Distinguished Scholar, and two-time Presidential Committee on Athletics Scholar Athlete.

• She was also recognized as Iowa's female Student-Athlete of the Month in November -- an award voted on by UI student-athletes.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir), the all-time winningest coach in program history, is in her 16th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 32nd season as a college head coach.

Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 14 postseason appearances (12 NCAA and two WNIT) in 15 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in each of the last eight seasons. Iowa is the only team in the Big Ten, and one of 10 in NCAA Division I women's basketball, to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the last eight years. There are 349 Division I teams.

Bluder, the 2015 Carol Eckman Award winner, has posted a 319-185 (.633) record at Iowa and her career record stands at 675-327 (.674). Bluder surpassed Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as the all-time winningest coach in program history on Feb. 10, 2014, as the Hawkeyes defeated Northwestern, 90-84.

Bluder, 1-of-10 active major college coaches with 600 or more wins, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010) and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year (2001 and 2008). She has guided Iowa to a winning record in 14 of her 15 years at Iowa, including 11 upper-division finishes in the challenging Big Ten Conference. Bluder, who ranks fourth among Big Ten coaches all-time in league victories (152), has led Iowa to nine 20-win seasons in her 15 years, including seven of the last eight years.

Bluder has coached numerous players to different awards in her 15 years in Iowa City. She has mentored 19 players to 46 All-Big Ten honors, including 12 first team picks, 16 second, 11 third and eight honorable mention selections. She has also had two Big Ten Freshman of the Year award winners, two Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year recipients, six members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team and three players named to the Big Ten All-Defensive team, with Kachine Alexander earning the honor twice.

Five players during Bluder's tenure have earned a total of seven Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) all-region team accolades and six players have earned a total of 11 honorable mention All-America honors. Bluder coached her first consensus All-American in Samantha Logic, who earned the honor after being named a WBCA Division I Coaches All-American, USBWA All-American, ESPN Second Team All-American, and Third Team Associated Press All-American.

With Bluder on the Iowa sidelines, student-athletes have been named Academic All-Big Ten 75 times, including a program-best eight honorees in 2011 and 2012. The 75 honorees equal the third-highest total in the Big Ten during the last 15 years.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five postseason appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

COLEY FARNS B1G RECOGNITION

- Sophomore Chase Coley was named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll for the first time in her career on Feb. 1 after wins over Michigan and Northwestern.
- Coley led the Hawkeyes offensively in each contest, posting 21 points against the Wolverines and 19 points against the Wildcats. She added 10 rebounds to her line against Michigan to earn her third career double-double.
- On the week, Coley shot .789 (15-of-19) from the field and .833 (10-of-12) from the charity stripe.
- The Minneapolis, Minnesota, native also tallied five assists and three blocks in the two-game stretch.

CALL ON ME

- Junior Ally Disterhoft, a preseason All-Big Ten selection by league coaches, has been a consistent force for the Hawkeyes all season.
- Disterhoft, who averages 36.1 minutes per contest, is fourth in the conference and 11th nationally with 938 minutes played this season.
- The 6-0 forward paces Iowa in points per game (17.0), and is third in rebounds per game (5.6), assists per game (2.8), and steals per game (1.0).
- She has scored double figures in every game of the season and in 71 of her 77 career starts.
- The Iowa City, Iowa, native has led Iowa in scoring in 12 of 26 games this season, scoring 20 points or more in eight contests.
- Disterhoft owns a .529 field goal percentage, a .359 three-point field goal percentage, and a .727 free throw percentage.
- She ranks 14th all-time in three-point field goals made (101), 15th all-time in scoring (1,420 career points), and 18th all-time in rebounding (575 career rebounds) in Iowa women's basketball history. Disterhoft is the 34th player in program history to surpass the 1,000 career point threshold.

FEELING AT HOME

- Sophomore Whitney Jennings compiled the best offensive game of her career at Indiana on Feb. 4, netting a career-high 22 points in her home state. The Hawkeyes dropped a 79-74 decision to Indiana despite her efforts.
- The Logansport, Indiana, native knocked down 9-of-17 field goals (.529) and sunk 3-of-7 three-point field goals (.429) in front of family and friends.
- She also matched her career-high for the second straight game with two blocks, and added two rebounds, two assists, and one steal to her line in 38 minutes played.
- Jennings was named Miss Indiana Basketball as a senior in 2013-14, and has played in every game of her Hawkeye career (59) with 54 career starts at point guard.

HAWKEYES SOAR PAST WILDCATS

- Iowa earned a road win at Northwestern, 79-64, on Jan. 31. The Wildcats were ranked as high as No. 12 this season.
- Five Hawkeyes scored in double figures, including sophomore Chase Coley (19), junior Ally Disterhoft (18), freshman Megan Gustafson (15), sophomore Whitney Jennings (11) and freshman Tania Davis (11). It is the third game of the season in which five Hawkeyes reached double figures in scoring.
- Gustafson recorded her second consecutive double-double with 15 points and a career high 13 rebounds. It is the second double-double of her career.
- Junior Alexa Kastanek came off the bench to lead the Hawkeyes in assists with six, pull down four rebounds, and net three points in 21 minutes.

BACK ON TRACK VS. MICHIGAN

- The Hawkeyes topped Michigan, 85-69, on their home court on Jan. 28 to end a three-game losing streak.
- Iowa's 85 points is a team high in Big Ten play. The last time the Hawkeyes scored over 80 points was on Dec. 22 against Drake (89 points).
- Freshman Megan Gustafson recorded her first career double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds, while sophomore Chase Coley posted the third of her career with 21 points and 10 rebounds.
- Freshman Tania Davis set a career high in points with 18, and added five assists and her first career block to her line.
- Junior Ally Disterhoft also reached double figures with 16 points. She has scored in double figures every game this season and in 67 of 73 career starts.
- The squad posted 21 assists to 12 turnovers.
- The Hawkeyes matched a season best with seven blocks in the contest.
- The Iowa bench outscored Michigan reserves, 33-6.

HAWKEYES HOLD OFF BADGERS

- The Hawkeyes held off a fourth quarter surge to record a road win at Wisconsin, 57-54, on Jan. 13.
- Ally Disterhoft led the team in scoring with 18 points, hitting 8-of-9 field goals. Whitney Jennings joined her in double figures with 11 points.
- Christina Buttenham came off the bench to match her career-high and pace the Hawkeyes in rebounds with six, four offensive and two defensive.
- Iowa outrebounded the Badgers, 36-28.
- Depth made a difference for the Hawkeyes, as their bench outscored the Badger reserves, 12-2.



HOT SHOOTING HAWKS TOP RUTGERS

• Iowa shot a season-high 54.5 percent to earn its second consecutive conference win over Rutgers on Jan. 4.

• Four Hawkeyes scored in double figures, including Alexa Kastanek (20), Ally Disterhoff (15), Chase Coley (10) and Whitney Jennings (10). Iowa outrebounded the Scarlet Knights, 34-31, in the contest.

• Kastanek sunk five three-pointers, one from tying her career-high, to lead the Hawkeyes offensively.

• Megan Gustafson came off the bench for three blocks, six points, and a team-high six rebounds in her 20 minutes. She has blocked three or more shots in seven of 25 games of her freshman season.

DISTERHOFT MAKES HISTORY

Junior Ally Disterhoff became the 34th player in Iowa women's basketball history to reach the 1,000 career points mark. The Iowa City, Iowa, native scored 20 points in season-opening action against North Dakota and surpassed the 1,000-point threshold with 11 points against UT Martin on Nov. 15.

B1G OPENER, BIG SUCCESS

• Iowa opened its Big Ten Conference slate on the road with a win at Nebraska, 74-68, on Dec. 31. It is the lone matchup against the Huskers this season.

• The Hawkeyes have won four consecutive games against the Huskers, dating back the 2014-15 season when Iowa topped Nebraska three times.

• Iowa dominated the boards in the contest, outrebounding Nebraska, 51-29.

• Iowa shot 45.6% from field goal range, 35% from three-point land, and 78.9% from the charity stripe in the win.

• Three Hawkeyes scored in double figures, led by junior Ally Disterhoff who netted 17 points. She added 11 rebounds for her first double-double of the year.

• Sophomore Chase Coley and Lincoln, Nebraska, native junior Alexa Kastanek scored 16 and 13 points, respectively.

A QUALITY NONCONFERENCE START

• Iowa compiled a 10-2 record in nonconference action, facing challenging opponents at home and on the road to prepare for Big Ten play.

• The Hawkeyes won seven of 12 nonconference games by 10 or more points.

A season-high six scored in double figures for the Hawkeyes against Drake on Dec. 22, including Ally Disterhoff (20), Megan Gustafson (16), Whitney Jennings (15), Alexa Kastanek (15), Chase Coley (11), and Tania Davis (10).

DISTERHOFT EARNED B1G HONOR ROLL RECOGNITION... AGAIN

• Junior Ally Disterhoff was named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll on Dec. 28, after helping Iowa defeat intrastate rival Drake, 89-76.

• The 6-0 forward scored a team-high 20 points, tied for the team lead with seven rebounds, and dished out four assists against the Bulldogs. She has scored 20 points or more in six games through 24 contests this season.

• The Iowa City, Iowa native, hit 6-of-9 field goals, including a 3-of-6 performance from beyond the arc in the game.

• She has scored in double figures in all 24 games this season and in 69 of 75 career starts.

• Disterhoff was also named to the Big Ten Honor Roll on Dec. 7, after guiding the Hawkeyes to a pair of wins at Virginia and against Robert Morris.

• Junior Ally Disterhoff was named to the 2016 WBCA Allstate Good Works Team on Dec. 2.

• Student-athletes are recognized for making outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement, and for their leadership on and off the court.

• Disterhoff was nominated for raising helmet awareness for moped riders in the Iowa City area and has a close connection to Live Like Line (#LLL) cause.

2016 Recruiting Class

Bre Cera (Mukwonago, Wisconsin), Makenzie Meyer (Mason City, Iowa), Amanda Ollinger (Cedar Rapids, Iowa), and Alexis Sevillian (Goodrich, Michigan) have inked National Letters of Intent to play basketball at the University of Iowa, UI head coach Lisa Bluder announced on Nov. 11. The class of four is ranked 18th nationally by Blue Star Basketball.

"We are excited about our 2016 recruiting class," Bluder said. "We have signed four tremendous athletes that also succeed academically and are all-around great young women. They will be wonderful additions to our Hawkeye family."

Cera, a 5-10 guard from Mukwonago High School in Mukwonago, Wisconsin, is a Blue Star Basketball Top 300 recruit, ranking as the 83rd-best prospect nationally.

The two-time first team all-state honoree has helped Mukwonago to a trio of top three conference finishes in her high school career, including a conference championship in the 2012-13 season. Cera guided her team to a state runner-up finish that year as a freshman, a semifinal appearance at state as a sophomore, and a regional berth as a junior. The two-time team captain has been named first team all-conference, first team all-area, and first team all-county in consecutive seasons.

Cera became Mukwonago's all-time leading scorer in February of her junior season. She averaged 17 points, five rebounds, three assists, and two steals per game that year. As a sophomore, Cera surpassed the 1,000 career points mark, was named Milwaukee Journal-Sentinel prep athlete of the week, and averaged 14 points, four rebounds, three assists, and two steals per game. She also owns the school record for points in a game with 37.

"Bre is a terrific defensive player, a hard worker, and unbelievable competitor," Bluder said. "She makes her presence known on both ends of the court. Bre is a great athlete who has the versatility to play a variety of positions on the floor."

Meyer, a 5-10 guard from Mason City High School in Mason City, Iowa, is an ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruit, ranking as the 83rd-best prospect nationally and the 23rd-best point guard.

The two-year captain, only the fifth player in Mason City history to join the 1,000 career point club, helped her team to state quarterfinals in 2015 and semifinals in 2013 at the 5A level, and a trio of conference co-championships. As a junior, Meyer averaged 20.5 points, 6.8 rebounds, 3.2 assists, and 2.3 steals per game. She was named first team all-conference, first team all-district, first team all-state, and to the Sports Spotlight Iowa High School Girls Basketball All State Team.

Meyer, the school record holder for points scored in a game with 36, garnered first team all-district, first team all-state, and Mason City Globe Gazette Player of the Year honors as a sophomore. The National Honors Society member also excels academically, earning Principle List and academic all-conference recognition.

"Makenzie has the opportunity to play the point or the off guard for us," Bluder said. "She controls the tempo, but also has a scorer's mentality. Makenzie was our first commitment from this class and got the ball rolling for us. She is a great player who has consistently competed at the highest level, not only within the state of Iowa, but nationally. We are excited to have another native Iowan in Makenzie."

Ollinger, a 6-1 forward from Linn-Mar High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, is an ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruit, ranking as the 90th-best player overall and 18th-best forward.

The two-time second team all-state and three-time all-metro and all-conference honoree most recently helped Linn-Mar to a runner-up conference finish, averaging 12.3 points, 4.8 rebounds, and 1.1 blocks per game as a junior. She also earned the team's top free throw percentage award, and is only the second player in program history to net six three-pointers in a game (joining Linn-Mar and Hawkeye women's basketball alum Jaime Printy).

As a sophomore, Ollinger averaged 18.6 points, 7.2 rebounds, and 2.3 blocks per game. She is also a standout volleyball player, who led the state in kills, kills per set, and kills in a season at the 5A level. The two-time team captain is a two-time all-state volleyball honoree.

"She is an all-around athlete that can play either forward position for us," Bluder said. "Amanda is an excellent rebounder, but can also nail the open three. She runs the floor so well for a player her size and will beat people guarding her down the court or off the bounce. It's great to have another Iowa player on our roster, especially one from so close to Iowa City."

Sevillian, a 5-6 guard from Goodrich High School in Goodrich, Michigan, is a Blue Star Basketball Top 300 recruit, ranking as the 91st-best prospect nationally. She has a familiar face on the Hawkeye roster in freshman Tania Davis, also a Goodrich graduate.

The two-time all-state, all-area, and all-conference honoree has guided Goodrich to three consecutive conference championships, two district and regional championships, and a state championship in 2013. As a junior, Sevillian started every game, registered 422 points, 94 rebounds, 62 steals, and 60 assists, and led her team to state semifinals and a 23-2 final record. She tallied 304 points in her sophomore season, helping Goodrich to a 22-3 mark.

Sevillian, a preseason all-state and Miss Michigan Basketball candidate, is a National Honor Society member. She also excels in track and field and was named an All-American in the shot put after placing third nationally in the event.

"Alexis is a great defensive player, who can also shoot the three. She has a tremendous work ethic and competes all the time. Her older sister, Keke, currently plays basketball at Penn State, so she knows Big Ten basketball."

DISTERHOFT FARNS PRESEASON HONOR

Junior forward Ally Disterhoft was named a preseason All-Big Ten honoree by league coaches. The two-year starter and team-elected co-captain, was a second team All-Big Ten selection in 2015, and an honorable mention All-Big Ten honoree, Big Ten All-Freshman Team member, and Big Ten All-Tournament Team selection in 2014.

The Iowa City, Iowa, native entered the season 34th all-time in scoring at Iowa with 977 career points. Disterhoft -- the only sophomore to be named a CoSIDA Capital One Academic All-American in 2014-15 -- led the Hawkeyes in points (503) and points per game (14.8) last season.

HAWKEYES IN BIG TEN PLAY

Iowa head coach Lisa Bluder is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010). She has guided Iowa to 11 upper-division finishes in the Big Ten in 15 seasons. Iowa won a share of the Big Ten regular season championship in 2008 and finished in a three-way tie for second in 2009. The Hawkeyes clinched a share of the title in 2008 with a win at Wisconsin in the regular season finale (March 2, 2008). In conference games alone, Bluder owns a 157-105 (.600) record at Iowa. Since the 2008 season, Iowa has finished first once, second three times, third twice, fourth once, and seventh once. Iowa finished second in the inaugural 14-team league in 2015.

2 TOURNAMENTS, 2 TEAM TROPHIES

- The Hawkeyes have taken home the hardware in every tournament so far this season, beginning with the Hawkeye Challenge, Nov. 13-15, and continuing at the Lone Star Showcase, Nov. 26-28.
- Iowa topped North Dakota and UT Martin at its annual tournament in Iowa City opening weekend to secure its first team championship with a 2-0 record.
- Ally Disterhoft (MVP), Kali Peschel, and Megan Gustafson earned Hawkeye Challenge All-Tournament team accolades.
- The Hawkeyes edged out the competition in their bracket at the Lone Star Showcase over Thanksgiving break. The squad recorded wins over Wright State and Houston, but fell to No. 23 George Washington in double overtime.
- Iowa and George Washington both posted 2-1 records, but the Hawkeyes earned the team title by the margin of victory tie breaker.

ACADEMIC PROWESS

- Iowa was the only program to have two Capital One Academic All-Americans, Ally Disterhoft and Samantha Logic, in 2014-15. There were 15 total honorees.
- Disterhoft was the only sophomore in the country to earn Capital One Academic All-American honors.
- Seven Hawkeyes, Disterhoft, Bethany Doolittle, Alexa Kastanek, Samantha Logic, Kali Peschel, Kathryn Reynolds, and Hailey Schneden, earned Academic All-Big Ten recognition following the 2014-15 season.
- To be eligible for Academic All-Big Ten, student-athletes must be letterwinners and be in at least their second academic year at the institution. They must also carry a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better.

#REDWHITENBLUDER

Sixteenth-year UI head coach Lisa Bluder took her talents to the international stage as head coach of the U.S. Pan American Women's Basketball Team in 2015. She guided the Red, White, and Blue to four consecutive wins in four days to reach the gold medal contest, where Team USA ultimately fell to the Pan American Games host in Canada in day five of competition. It marked the 14th medal all-time (seven gold, five silver, two bronze) for the U.S. and the second for Bluder, who earned a gold medal with the team as an assistant coach at the World University Games in 2001.


