# **ON TRACK**

Hawkeye senior Megan Blank is on track to break lowa's single season batting average record for the second time in her career. She currently owns a batting average of .442, five points ahead of the record she set in 2013 when she ended the season with a .437 clip. In her career, Blank boasts a .408 batting average and has started all 200 games at shortstop since arriving at lowa. Lea Twigg, who played from 1996-97, holds the career batting average record with a mark of .409.

# **STRIKEOUTS X 3**

Redshirt sophomore pitcher Shayla Starkenburg has more than tripled her strikeout total of 51 from a season ago, totaling 155 so far in 2015. She has also significantly raised her strikeouts per appearance average from 2.55 (51 strikeouts in 21 appearances) in 2014 to 4.08 (155 in 38 appearances) this year. Starkenburg currently leads the Big Ten in innings pitched (183.2), is second in appearances (38) and games started (28), third in looking strikeouts (46), and fifth in strikeouts (155).

# TAKING ON THE BEST

Nine of Iowa's 2015 opponents are ranked in the most recent release of the USA Today/NFCA Division I Top-25 Poll (April 14). They include: Oregon (1), Florida (2), Michigan (4), Oklahoma (5), Louisiana Lafayette (9), Minnesota (13), UCF (15), Missouri (20), and North Dakota State (RV). The Hawkeyes have played 10 games against opponents ranked in the top six this season.

# **BIG TEN STAT RUNDOWN**

• Senior Megan Blank is tied for first in the Big Ten in hits (61), is second in batting average (.442), third in doubles (13) and total bases (99), seventh in on-base percentage (.509), and 11th in slugging percentage (.717).

• Redshirt sophomore Sammi Gyerman is fourth in the conference in total plate appearnaces, and tied for ninth in hits (52).

• Redshirt sophomore pitcher Shayla Starkenburg leads the Big Ten in innings pitched (183.2), is second in appearances (38) and games started (28), third in looking strikeouts (46), and fifth in strikeouts (155).

# HEAD COACH MARLA LOOPER



Marla Looper concluded her fourth season as the head coach for the University of Iowa softball program in 2014. Looper owns an 114-136-1 overall and 47-57 Big Ten Conference record since the 2011 season.

Looper collected her 100th career victory in the 2014 season finale, when Erin Erickson delivered a walkoff, two-run home run to lift the Hawkeyes past Ohio State, 3–2. On the season, lowa posted 16 wins -- nine in conference action and three over ranked opponents (16-30-1).

Megan Blank earned her third-straight first team All-Big Ten honor and was a second team NFCA All-Midwest Region selection after leading the Hawkeyes in batting average, slugging percentage, hits, doubles, triples, RBIs and walks. Kayla Massey earned her second career Big Ten Pitcher of the Week nod on March 31 after recording two complete game wins over Wisconsin. Three earned Academic All-Big Ten accolades including Haley Hansel, Whitney Repole and Michelle Zoeller.

Looper led the Hawkeyes to 30 wins in 2013 (30-24) in her third year, marking the most wins for the program since finishing 42-16 in 2009. Iowa posted six wins over ranked opponents.

Three Hawkeyes earned All-Big Ten honors -- Megan Blank was named to the first team, Johnnie Dowling earned second team honors, and Kayla Massey was named to the Big Ten All-Defensive team at pitcher. Blank earned her second-straight first team accolade, becoming the sixth Hawkeye in program history to earn first team honors in each of her first two seasons.

Blank was also named a 2013 NFCA First Team All-Midwest Region selection, earning her second all-region honor in as many seasons. Blank became the sixth Hawkeye in program history to garner all-region honors in each of her first two seasons. In the classroom, a school-record 10 Hawkeyes were named to the 2013 spring Academic All-Big Ten team.

During her second season with the Hawkeyes, Looper led the team to a runner-up finish in the Big Ten -- the program's highest finish since winning the league title in 2003. Iowa dropped two of its first three conference series before winning five straight to close out the season. It was the first time the team had won five straight series since the 2004 season.

lowa entered the final weekend with a conference title within reach, but it couldn't close the gap with Michigan despite taking 2-of-3 games at Minnesota. The Hawkeyes finished with a 27-26 overall and 16-8 conference record in 2012.

Five players garnered All-Big Ten recognition, including three first team selections. Senior Liz Watkins, sophomore Kayla Massey and freshman Megan Blank earned first team accolades, sophomore Michelle Zoeller was a second team honoree and junior Johnnie Dowling was a third team selection.

Blank also garnered NFCA second team all-region honors during her freshman campaign. She is the ninth Hawkeye to earn first team All-Big Ten and all-region honors during her freshman season.

The Hawkeyes finished second in the Big Ten in pitching (2.31 ERA) and third in fielding (.967). The squad turned 26 double plays during the course of the season to rank sixth nationally in double plays per game (.49).

Looper guided the Hawkeyes to a 27-24 overall and a 9-11 Big Ten record in her first season in Iowa City. The first year head coach led the UI to a pair of six game winning streaks in her opening campaign and a tournament title at the Stetson Classic.

lowa opened Big Ten Conference play strong, jumping out to an 8-3 record. Among the victories was a 4-2 triumph at No. 1 Michigan. The win, which pushed the overall mark to 26-16, was lowa's first over a No. 1 ranked opponent since the 2005 season and the first over a ranked foe since 2008.

Looper's Hawkeyes were on the verge of completing a series sweep in Ann Arbor before the Wolverines rallied from a 2-0 deficit in the bottom of the seventh inning to claim the victory and halt lowa's momentum.

A pair of Hawkeyes earned Åll-Big Ten recognition at the conclusion of the season. Liz Watkins was tabbed as a second team selection, while Katie Keim earned third team accolades.

Looper took over the reigns of the Iowa program after serving as an assistant coach at the University of Texas for 11 seasons (1999-2010). Looper helped lead the Longhorns to three College World Series appearances (2003, 2005 and 2006) and nine NCAA Tournament berths. She also helped guide Texas to back-to-back Big 12 regular season and tournament championships in 2002 and 2003 along with regular season championships in 2006 and 2010.

# **SERIES NOTES**

• lowa leads Purdue, 39-9, in the all-time series.

The last time the teams met, the Hawkeyes swept the Boilermakers in West Lafayette, Indiana. Iowa won game one 4-3 after nine innings, game two 2-0 after eight innings, and game three 8-2.
Purdue last defeated lowa on April 3, 2011, by a score of 3-0.

# **SCOUTING PURDUE**

• Purdue enters the series with a 26-16 record overall and a 5-7 mark in Big Ten Conference play.

• Five Boilermaker starters are hitting above .300, including Ashley Burkhardt (.407), Katie Harrison (.333), Alyssa Koorsen (.328), Kristen Hoppman (.315), Kaylah Hamption (.304).

• Pitcher Lilly Fecho leads Purdue in the circle with 16 wins, a 1.64 ERA, 31 appearances, 27 starts, 18 complete games, 175.0 innings pitched, and 221 strikeouts.

# **CY-HAWK SERIES BATTLE**

The Hawkeyes and Cyclones battled it out to determine the winner of the annual lowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series on April 15. The game included a pair of ties, before lowa State hit a go-ahead solo home run for a 5-4 lead. It held up, handing lowa the 5-4 loss and the 15-11 loss in the overall series. Two Hawkeyes recorded multiple hit games, including Megan Blank (3-for-4) and Cheyenne Pratt (2-for-3), in front of the largest crowd of the season at Pearl Field (827).

# **B1G SERIES VICTORY**

The Hawkeyes clinched their first Big Ten series win, 2-1, over Wisconsin on April 10-12. Iowa took the first game of the series in run-rule fashion. The Hawkeyes used a 10-run first inning to jump ahead and eventually secure a 16-4 victory in five innings. After falling 5-4 in game two, the Hawkeyes outlasted the Badgers, 3-2, in 10 innings in game three. Senior Megan Blank hit the go-ahead home run in the top of the 10th to clinch the series victory.

# **BLANK DELIVERS**

Megan Blank's 25th career home run was one to remember. The senior recorded the go-ahead blast in the top of the 10th inning at Wisconsin on April 12 to secure the conference series victory. Blank currently leads the team with seven home runs this season, and is fourth all-time in career home runs.

# **STARKENBURG COMES UP B1G**

Shayla Starkenburg threw a career-high 10 innings and fanned a career-high 11 batters in lowa's 10-inning win over the Badgers on April 12. The redshirt sophomore gave up three earned runs on 13 hits and two walks. The Ankeny, lowa, native leads the Hawkeyes in wins (12), ERA (4.95), appearances (38), starts (28), complete games (22), shutouts (3), and strikeouts (155) this season.

# FREE BASES

Sarah Kurtz tallied six walks in three games against Wisconsin on April 10-12. The freshman recorded a .727 on base percentage over the three game series, and reached base successfully at least two times in all three contests.

# HOFFMAN PLATES 5

Holly Hoffman plated five runs in a three games against Wisconsin on April 10-12. The redshirt junior recorded a .462 clip with six hits in 13 at bats. Senior Megan Blank (33), redshirt sophomore Sammi Gyerman (32), and Hoffman (23) lead the Hawkeyes in RBIs this season.

# **GYERMAN MAKES HISTORY**

Sammi Gyerman hit for the cycle to lead the Hawkeyes past the Illini, 15-7 after five innings, on April 3. The redshirt sophomore recorded double and a triple in lowa's nine-run first inning before hitting a home run in the third and a single in the fourth. The San Pedro, California, native, became the first Hawkeye in school history to hit for the cycle and just the third player in the Big Ten to accomplish the feat. Gyerman posted career bests in hits (4), RBIs (6) and runs scored (3) in the contest.

# **OFFENSE ON THE RISE**

The Hawkeyes have enjoyed a jump offensively from 2014 to 2015 under new hitting coach Adam Arbour. Iowa has improved in batting average (.250 to .275), slugging percentage (.376 to .407), on-base percentage (.321 to .357), doubles (59 to 67), home runs (23 to 26), RBIs (122 to 181), walks (97 to 131), runs scored (141 to 202) and runs per game (3.0 to 4.4).

# **CONFERENCE AVERAGE**

Five Hawkeyes are hitting .300+ in conference play. Senior Megan Blank leads the team with a .452 clip, while redshirt sophomore Sammi Gyerman (.438) and freshman Angela Schmiederer (.400) join her in the 400s. Redshirt junior Holly Hoffman (.372) and freshman Allie Wood (.308) have each recorded .300+ clips in 14 conference contests this season.

## **INCREASE IN SPEED**

lowa swiped a season-high four bases against Western Illinois on April 2. Redshirt sophomore Sammi Gyerman stole a pair, while senior Megan Blank and sophomore Claire Fritsch each stole one. Prior to the Thursday contest, the Hawkeyes had just eight stolen bases on the season.

# **UPSET IN ANN ARBOR**

The Hawkeyes handed the No. 4 Wolverines their fifth loss of the season with a come-from-behind victory in Ann Arbor, Michigan, on March 29. Down four runs in the top of the sixth, Iowa scored three runs off of a pair of home runs by redshirt junior Holly Hoffman and freshman Allie Wood. The Hawkeyes continued their rally in the seventh when sophomore Kaitlyn Mullarkey capitalized on an RBI opportunity with a double down the right line to give lowa a 5-4 lead. The Hawkeyes added an insurance run on a RBI ground out from Wood to take a 6-4 lead into the bottom of the seventh. After a Wolverine reached on a single to start the seventh, lowa used a 4-6-3 double play to silence the scoring chance and ultimately secure the upset victory.

# **STARKENBURG TROUBLES NO. 4 WOLVERINES**

Redshirt sophomore pitcher Shayla Starkenburg limited the Wolverines to just four hits in the first game of a doubleheader on March 28. Only three other teams have held Michigan to four hits or less this season. They include: then-ranked No. 1 Florida (2 hits), Kent State (3 hits) and Illinois State (4 hits). The Ankeny, Iowa, native registered a complete-game upset win on March 29. After a rocky first inning Starkenburg settled in and allowed just one run in her final six innings of work and did not allow a Wolverine hit in four of her final six innings.

#### **TOUGH OUT**

Senior Megan Blank has just eight strikeouts in 138 at bats this season. Blank currently leads the team in batting average (.442), slugging percentage (.717), and on base percentage (.509).

lowa leads the Big Ten Conference in double plays with 24 on the season. The Hawkeyes have recorded two double plays in a game six times: No. 6 Louisiana-Lafayette (Feb. 20), No. 6 Oklahoma (March 15), Tulsa (March 18), Nebraska (March 25), No. 4 Michigan (March 29), and Illinois (April 4).

## **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

The Hawkeyes are fourth in the Big Ten in doubles. Iowa has recorded 67 doubles on the season. Senior Megan Blank, the career doubles school record holder, leads the team with 13, while redshirt sophomore Sammi Gyerman has 10.

## **B1G HITS**

lowa is ranked ninth in the Big Ten in hits. Iowa has accumulated 331 hits in 46 contests this season. Senior Megan Blank leads the team and is tied for the most in the conference with 61 hits, while redshirt sophomore Sammi Gyerman has 52 hits on the season.

## **STARKENBURG STRIKEOUTS**

Redshirt sophomore Shayla Starkenburg is tied for fifth in the Big Ten in batters struck out (155) and third in batters struck out looking (46). Starkenburg fanned a career high 11 batters in Iowa's 3-2 10-inning victory over Wisconsin on April 12. She has struck out nine batters twice this season (Florida A&M on March 1; East Carolina on March 14. Starkenburg recorded her first career no-hitter against Southern Utah on Feb. 7. The Ankeny, Iowa, native has 155 strikeouts in 183.2 innings pitched this season.

# BACK-TO-BACK... AGAIN

Redshirt sophomore Sammi Gyerman and senior Megan Blank registered back-to-back home runs to help lowa secure a 7-6 victory over Tulsa on March 18. The feat marked the second time the duo has gone back-to-back this season (Cal State Fullerton, 3/7/15).

## **BLANK MAKES HISTORY**

Senior Megan Blank recorded her 53rd career double against Nebraska on March 25 to break Iowa's 18-year-old career doubles record. Blank is now in sole possession of the lowa softball career doubles record with 56. The previous record of 52 was set by Kari Knopf in 1997.



## DOWN GOES NO. 17

The Hawkeyes defeated No. 17 UCF on Feb. 27 to notch their first win over a ranked opponent this season. Junior Erin Erickson used a squeeze bunt to score the eventual game-winning run in the fifth to guide the Hawkeyes to a 3-2 victory. Redshirt sophomore Shayla Starkenburg was credited with the complete game win. She allowed one earned run on six hits and struck out three.

# **ERICKSON NAMED TO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM**

Junior Erin Erickson was named to the Ragin' Cajun Invitational All-Tournament team following the five-game invitational on Feb. 20-22. Erickson posted a .308 batting average and a .615 slugging percentage on the weekend with a double, home run, and two RBIs.

# STARKENBURG SILENCES THUNDERBIRDS

Redshirt sophomore Shayla Starkenburg registered her first career no-hitter against Southern Utah on Feb. 7. Starkenburg fanned a career-high eight batters and only walked three in seven innings of work. She became just the seventh pitcher in Iowa history to toss a no-hitter, and the first pitcher to do so since Amanda Zust on March 21, 2010. Starkenburg's no-hitter is the 17th in Iowa softball history.

# **BLANK NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN**

Senior shortstop Megan Blank was named a Preseason First Team All-Big Ten infielder by College Sports Madness on Feb. 4. Blank, a three-time regular season First Team All-Big Ten honoree, led the Hawkeyes in batting average (.361), slugging percentage (.602), on-base percentage (.452), hits (48), doubles (11), triples (3) and RBIs (25) in 2014.

#### **NFCA HONORS BLANK FOR 3RD-STRAIGHT YEAR**

Shortstop Megan Blank collected her third-straight NFCA honor as she was a second team All-Midwest Region pick in 2014. The senior was named to the NFCA All-Midwest Region second team as a freshman and first team as a sophomore. She is the 16th player in Iowa history to earn three regional awards in her career.

#### 3 IN A ROW

Senior Megan Blank received her third-straight First Team All-Big Ten accolade and was also named to the conference's All-Defensive Team, following the 2014 season. The shortstop is the eighth lowa player to earn first team distinction three times.

Blank led the Hawkeyes in batting average (.361), slugging percentage (.602), on-base percentage (.452), hits (48), doubles (11), triples (3) and RBIs (25) last season. In Big Ten action, Blank hit at a .415 clip, slugged .677 and compiled an on-base percentage of .506. Seven of her 11 doubles, two of her three triples, two of her five home runs and 15 of her 25 RBIs came against conference foes.

Heading into her senior season, Blank ranks in several career categories at lowa. She is second with a .398 batting average, sixth with 43 doubles, eighth with 18 home runs, ninth with 113 RBIs and 10th with 10 triples with one season remaining with the Hawkeyes. Blank led the team with 13 multiple-hit games and six multiple-RBI games, had the longest reached base streak (14) and owned the longest hitting streak (9). She ended the season with a seven-game reached base streak.

# PRACTICE FACILITIES

The Hawkeyes have benefited from two new facilities in 2015 -- the indoor lowa Turf Facility, located at the Hawkeye Tennis and Recreation Complex, and the Jacobson Hitting Facility, located in football's former weight room. The HTRC lowa Turf Facility has enabled the program to have consistency in team practices, while the Jacobson hitting cages have allowed student-athletes to take extra reps at any time.

#### **HAWKEYE TRADITION**

lowa has made four Women's College World Series appearances (1995, 1996, 1997, 2001) and played in 16 NCAA Tournaments in school history. The 16 appearances are the second most in Big Ten history, and the four WCWS appearances equal the second most in conference history. The Hawkeyes have won four Big Ten Conference regular season championships (1989, 1997, 2000, 2003) and two Big Ten Tournament titles (2001, 2003). Iowa holds a 1262-781-5 (.618) record in 37 seasons.

## <u>UP NEXT</u>

lowa is set for five road games next week, beginning with a midweek doubleheader on April 22 at Missouri. The Hawkeyes remain on the road for their third consecutive Big Ten series on the road at Minnesota from April 24-26.




