IOWA TICKET INFORMATION

Tickets for each of Iowa's three remaining home duals and the 2005 Big Ten Championships are on sale at the University of Iowa Athletic Ticket Office. Single-match tickets are \$8 for adults and \$4 for youth if purchased in advance and \$10 for adults and \$5 for youth if purchased at the door. All-session tickets for the Big Ten Championships are \$35 for adults and \$20 for youth.

ON THE AIR

Radio - Morrie Adams and four-time Hawkeye all-American Mark Ironside will call the action live on AM-800 KXIC. To listen to the broadcast online, go to the wrestling schedule page on www.hawkeyesports.com. Broadcasts using Real One Player software are available using the College Sports Pass, which can be purchased for \$6.95 per month or \$49.95 per year.

Television - Iowa Public Television, in its 29th season of televising college wrestling, will air a live telecast of the dual with Minnesota. Announcers will be Tim Johnson, Jim Gibbons and former Iowa Wrestling Coach Dan Gable.

Video Webcast - Iowa will be offering a live video webcast of the Minnesota dual through www.hawkeyesports.com. Fans who have already purchased a College Sports Pass from College Sports Online to listen to the Iowa radio broadcasts can use their pass to view the meet free of charge. Passes can be purchased for \$6.95 per month or \$49.95 per year.

ZALESKY PRESS CONFERENCE

Hawkeye Head Coach Coach Jim Zalesky will hold a press conference Tuesday at 3 p.m. in the Carver-Hawkeye Arena Press Room to discuss the Big Ten dual season and the upcoming Big Ten Championships, which will be hosted by the University of Iowa March 5-6. Individual wrestlers will be available for interviews and photo opportunities in the wrestling room after the press conference.

HEAD COACH JIM ZALESKY

Jim Zalesky is in his eighth season as head coach at the University of Iowa. He has a school and career record of 114-26 (.814). Named National Coach of the Year in 1998 and 1999, and Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2000, he has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA (1998-00) and three Big Ten titles (1998, 2000, 2004). Zalesky has coached 10 NCAA Champions, 20 Big Ten Champions and 36 all-Americans at Iowa. He was inducted into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame in June 2004, the University of Iowa Letterman's Club Hall of Fame and the Iowa High School Athletic Association Wrestling Hall of Fame in 2002, and the Iowa Wrestling Hall of Fame in 1994.

A three-time national champion and one of Iowa's 15 four-time all-Americans, Zalesky was an assistant coach and head recruiter at Iowa under Dan Gable for seven seasons (1991-97). He was named Assistant Coach of the Year by the N.W.C.A. in 1992 and 1997. Undefeated as a junior and senior, Zalesky ended his career on an 89-match winning streak.

MINNESOTA GOLDEN GOPHERS

Eighth-ranked Minnesota is 8-6, 2-2 in the Big Ten with wins over Arizona State (22-16), Northern Iowa (20-15), Central Michigan (20-18 and 18-15), Michigan (21-16), Lehigh (24-13), Northwestern (28-10) and Purdue (29-12) and losses to Oklahoma State (28-10), Nebraska (21-12), Iowa State (21-12), Illinois (20-15), Michigan State (28-14) and Michigan (24-19). Head Coach J Robinson is 277-99-3 in 19 seasons at Minnesota. He served as interim head coach at Iowa in 1984, when Dan Gable coached the U.S. Olympic team, after stints as an assistant coach (1976-83) and graduate assistant (1972-76) with the Hawkeyes. Minnesota is led by all-Americans Bobbe Lowe (125) and Cole Konrad (Hwt.), and redshirt freshman Mack Reiter (133) who is a Gilbertville, IA, native.

MICHIGAN WOLVERINES

Fifth-ranked Michigan is 11-3-1 overall and 3-0-1 in the Big Ten with wins over Cleveland State (40-9), Central Michigan (24-15), Nebraska (25-12), Army (35-9), Stanford (32-10), Penn State (31-9 and 29-14), Arizona State (24-16), Hofstra (19-18), Wisconsin (23-16) and Minnesota (24-19), losses to Lehigh (22-15), Minnesota (21-16) and Oklahoma (24-13) and a tie with Illinois (17-17). The Wolverines will host Ohio State Friday night in Cliff Keen Arena. Head Coach Joe McFarland is 84-21-3 in six seasons at Michigan and 108-41-3 in nine seasons as a collegiate head coach. The Wolverines are led by all-Americans Ryan Churella (165), Ryan Bertin (157) and Greg Wagner (Hwt.) and redshirt freshman Josh Churella (141) and Eric Tanenbaum (149).

THE SERIES

Minnesota -- Iowa leads the series, 61-22-1, and holds a 29-11 advantage in Iowa City. Minnesota won the last meeting (18-15 in Minneapolis in 2004). Iowa's last win in the series was 22-18 in Iowa City in 2003.

Michigan -- The series is tied at 23-23-1. Iowa holds a 10-8-1 advantage in Iowa City, but Michigan won the last meeting (20-16 in Ann Arbor in 2004). Iowa's last win in the series was a 29-11 decision at the 2003 NWCA National Duals in Columbus, OH.

LAST MEETING

Minnesota 18, Iowa 15 -- February 15, 2004

The Hawkeyes fell to Minnesota, 18-15, February 15, 2004, in Minneapolis, MN. Iowa started its 1,000th dual meet in school history strong, with senior **Luke Eustice** winning a 10-2 major decision over Bobbe Lowe at 125. Minnesota got on the scoreboard with a win in sudden victory at 133, but senior **Cliff Moore** rebounded with a 12-6 win over Tommy Owen at 141. Hawkeye sophomore **Ty Eustice** scored an 8-4 win over Thomas McAlpine at 149, but his unsportsmanlike behavior after the match led to a one-point deduction from the Iowa team score. **Joe Johnston** continued the Hawkeye roll with a 7-4 decision over Matt Nagel at 157. Minnesota used the intermission after 157 to regroup, winning four of the last five bouts. Iowa senior **Tyler Nixt** was the only bright spot in the second half of the dual, winning a 3-1 decision over Jon Duncombe at 174. Iowa led 15-6 after Nixt's match, but two Minnesota decisions had the Golden Gophers trailing 15-12 going into the final match. Minnesota's Cole Konrad needed to win by at least a major decision to prevent a tie. He scored a late takedown to take a 3-0 lead over Iowa's **Ryan Fuller**. He turned the Hawkeye for the fall in 6:45 to seal the win. Following are the individual meet results:

Iowa lost a close 20-16 decision to Michigan January 23, 2004, in Crisler Arena in Ann Arbor, MI. Hawkeye senior **Luke Eustice** opened the dual with a dominating 13-3 major decision over Mark Moos at 125, collecting his 75th career victory. At 133, Foley Dowd put Michigan on the scoreboard with a 22-6 technical fall over **Trent Goodale**. Hawkeye senior **Cliff Moore** scored a takedown in sudden victory to win 5-3 over Clark Forward at 141 to make

IOWA WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 782-201-30 (.787) in 93 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 20 national titles, including nine of the last 14, and 31 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 47 NCAA Champions have won a total of 73 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 13 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 99 Big Ten Champions have won a total of 180 conference individual titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time and 24 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 124 all-Americans have earned all-America status 254 times, including 16 four-time, 27 three-time and 28 two-time honorees.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has been the home for Iowa wrestling since 1983. The Hawkeyes have a record of 144-11 (.929) in the arena, which includes a record 10 victories during the 1986 season. Iowa has recorded 16 undefeated seasons in the arena, with the most recent (8-0) occurring in 2002-03. The dual wrestling attendance record for Carver-Hawkeye Arena is 15,291, which was set when Iowa defeated Iowa State on February 22, 1992. The arena seats 15,500 for a dual wrestling meet. The Hawkeyes are scheduled to host the 2005 Big Ten Championships in Carver-Hawkeye.

STEINER & DUROE TO COACH WORLD TEAMS

Iowa Assistant Coach Troy Steiner and Administrative Assistant Mike Duroe were recently named coaches for the 2005 U.S. Freestyle World Championships teams by USA Wrestling. Steiner will coach the women's team with Bill Scherr, while Duroe will coach the men's team with Joe Seay. Both teams will participate in the World Championships at Budapest, Hungary, Sept. 27-Oct. 2.
