

THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa men's golf team travels to The Club at Old Hawthorne in Columbia, Mo., on May 15-17 for the NCAA Columbia Regional. The Hawkeyes are the No. 6 seed in the regional. The top five teams, along with the top individual not on a qualifying team, will advance to the NCAA Finals, held at Prairie Dunes Country Club in Hutchinson, Kan., on May 23-28.

THE FIELD

In order of their respective seeding (Golfstat.com national ranking in parentheses), the Columbia Regional consists of Oklahoma State (2), Virginia (11), LSU (14), Arkansas (24), Arizona State (26), Iowa (35), San Diego State (38), Missouri (46), Iowa State (52), Middle Tennessee State (59), Ohio State (63), Denver (129), Loyola (Md.) (149), and Bryant (233).

THE COURSE

The Club at Old Hawthorne, founded in 2007, plays host to an NCAA Regional for the first time in its short history. The 7,141-yard, par-72 course has a course rating of 74.8 and a slope rating of 134.

THE LINEUP

Senior Steven Ihm, juniors Brian Bullington and Ian Vandersee, and freshmen Raymond Knoll and Carson Schaake make up Iowa's varsity lineup. This is Iowa's fourth straight tournament with the same lineup.

PREVIOUS APPEARANCES

In 2013, Iowa placed 11th at the NCAA Southeast Regional in Tallahassee, Fla. The Hawkeyes were led by Steven Ihm, who tied for 38th individually.

Iowa placed fifth in the 2012 NCAA Southeast Regional, advancing to the NCAA Championships. Ian Vandersee tied for eighth individually, carding a 54-hole score of 212 (-1). The Hawkeyes would tie for 22nd in the Finals in Los Angeles.

In 2011, Iowa tied for fourth in its NCAA Regional, advancing to the NCAA Championships. Chris Brant tied for seventh, posting a 210 (-3) to lead the Hawkeyes. Iowa would go on to finish in a tie for 10th in the Finals in Stillwater, Oklahoma.

The Hawkeyes tied for sixth in 2010, missing the cut for the NCAA Championships by one stroke. Brad Hopfinger led the charge for Iowa, tying for 11th individually.

In 2009, Iowa qualified for its first NCAA Championship berth since 1995 behind a solid performance from Hopfinger. The then-sophomore tied for 10th place, leading the Hawkeyes to a fifth place finish in the event.

LAST EVENT

The Hawkeyes captured third place for the second-consecutive year at the Big Ten Championships on May 2-4 in French Lick, Ind., carding a final round score of 284 (-4), the lowest 18-hole score of the tournament, to move from sixth to third on the final day.

Senior Steven Ihm finished fifth individually, despite standing in a tie for 38th after the first round. Ihm carded a career-best seven-over 295 (78,71,76,70) in 72-holes on his way to all-tournament honors. Junior Ian Vandersee finished in a tie for seventh after posting an 11-over 299 (78, 74, 76, 71). The 72-hole score was the best of Vandersee's career.

Freshman Raymond Knoll tied for 12th, posting a 12-over 300 (78, 74, 75, 73) in his first career 72-hole tournament. Freshman Carson Schaake fired a 15-over 303 (75, 77, 80, 71) over the three days of the tournament to tie for 20th. Schaake's final round of 71 (-1) tied the best 18-hole score of his career. Junior Brian Bullington posted a 19-over 307 (76, 79, 80, 72) to tie for 39th. Bullington birdied five holes in his final round.



HONORABLE HAWKEYES

Three Hawkeyes -- Senior Steven Ihm and juniors Ian Vandersee and Brian Bullington -- earned All-Big Ten honors this season. Ihm was named first team All-Big Ten for the second consecutive year, while Vandersee and Bullington earned second-team All Big-Ten honors for the first time in their careers. Bullington was also Iowa's Sportsmanship Award nominee. Ihm also earned Big Ten Golfer of the Week honors twice this season, following his individual victories at the Hawkeye-GRE Invitational and Boilermaker Invitational. Ihm's play propelled the Hawkeyes to tournament victories in both events. Bullington received the same honor following his third place finish at the Arizona State Thunderbird Invitational. Bullington's play led the Hawkeyes to a runner-up finish at the event.

Head coach Mark Hankins has now coached individuals to 11 All-Big Ten honors in his seven years at Iowa. The Hawkeyes had only 16 All-Big Ten honorees before Hankins arrived in 2008. Steven Ihm is the first Hawkeye to earn three All-Big Ten honors.

NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED

The Hawkeyes were named the Golfweek Team of the Week after their team victory at the Boilermaker Invitational. Iowa finished with a total score of 865 (+1) to top conference foe Illinois by one stroke. Iowa rallied from a 10-stroke deficit to top the Fighting Illini for its second consecutive Boilermaker Invitational title.

Golfweek also tabbed Steven Ihm as their Player of the Week, following his repeat championship at the Boilermaker Invitational.

6-STRAIGHT NCAA APPEARANCES

Since taking command of the University of Iowa men's golf program in 2007, head coach Mark Hankins has established the Hawkeyes as a competitive force in collegiate golf. Iowa has advanced to NCAA Regionals each of the past six seasons, and will look to advance to the NCAA Finals for the fourth time in six years. The Hawkeyes are 1-of-3 Big Ten teams (Illinois, Northwestern) to be selected to NCAA Regional competition in each of the last six years.

DEFENDING THE HARDWARE

Iowa captured two tournament championships in 2013, and has successfully defended both titles this spring. The Hawkeyes captured their third consecutive crown at the Big Four Championships on March 1 and mounted a comeback victory at the Boilermaker Invitational. Iowa also picked up a victory at its home tournament, the Hawkeye-GRE Invitational.

A PROGRAM ON THE RISE

lowa has won eleven tournaments since 2008, had thirteen individual medalists since 2009 and has had three All-Americans since 2008. Last season, senior Steven Ihm and junior Joseph Winslow became the 11th and 12th lowa players to be named to the all-region team since 2009.

HEAD COACH MARK HANKINS

Head coach Mark Hankins is in his seventh season as head coach. He has guided the Hawkeyes to six straight NCAA Regional appearances, and to the NCAA Finals three times in the past five years. Iowa was ranked 155th when Hankins took over the program in 2008, yet the Hawkeyes have been consistently ranked within the top-60 for the past five years. Hankins is a native of Mt. Pleasant, Iowa.

- The Hawkeyes have qualified for NCAA Regional competition in six consecutive seasons; Iowa is one of three Big Ten teams (Illinois, Northwestern) to be selected for NCAA Regional competition in each of the last six years. Iowa will be looking for its fourth NCAA Championship berth in the past six years.
- Iowa will be looking for its 15th appearance in the NCAA Championships. Before the current run of three appearances in the last five years, Iowa's last NCAA Tournament berth was in 1995.
- Under head coach Mark Hankins, Iowa has made three NCAA Championship appearances (2009, '11, '12) and six NCAA Regional appearances (2009, '10, '11, '12, '13, '14).
- Iowa has tallied 11 tournament victories since 2008. Iowa had nine total wins from 1995-2007 before Hankins arrived. Iowa has had 11 individual medalists, three All-Americans, 11 All-Big Ten selections and nine Big Ten Golfers of the Week under Hankins. Eight of the 11 lowest 18-hole scores in program history have been scored since Hankins' arrival.





Mark Hankins Seventh Year at Iowa

In his seventh season as head men's golf coach at the University of Iowa, Mark Hankins has established the Hawkeye program at the national level. Under Hankins' guidance, Iowa has advanced to NCAA competition each of the last six seasons, including a tie for 10th place at the NCAA Championships in 2011, the highest finish in the history of Hawkeye men's golf.

Hankins, a native of Mt. Pleasant, Iowa, took over the Hawkeye program in 2007 after seven years as the head coach at Michigan State.

In seven seasons at the helm of the program, lowa has won 10 tournament titles and advanced to the NCAA Championships three times under Hankins. Hankins has also coached three All-Americans, 11 All-Big Ten selections, one Big Ten Player of the Year, five Academic All-Americans and 17 Academic All-Big Ten honorees.

The Hawkeyes finished the 2013 season with an 11th place finish at the NCAA Southeast Regional in Tallahassee, Fla. Iowa had numerous successes during the season, including tying for first place at the Boilermaker Invite with a score of 878 (+14). Iowa shot a 1,186 (+34) during the Big Ten Championships at the Pete Dye Course in French Link, Ind., earning a third place finish. Both Steven Ihm and Joseph Winslow earned PING All-Region and All-Big Ten honors.

The 2012 season yielded a No. 27 spot in the final rankings, the highest of any Big Ten team. In addition, Iowa won the Hawkeye-Great River Entertainment Invitational with an 840 (-24), the third-lowest mark in program history. Iowa used a one over par final round (284) at the NCAA regional to qualify for the NCAA Championships, in which they finished 22nd. Iowa had an honorable mention All-American (Joseph Winslow), four PING All-Region honorees and three All-Big Ten award winners in 2012.

The Hawkeyes finished the 2011 season with the highest national ranking in school history (ninth). Of the five team tournament titles won in the 2010-11 season, lowa won four consecutive titles in the fall. The Hawkeyes tied for 10th at the NCAA Championships, marking their highest finish since 1960. Hankins coached two All-Americans, three All-Big Ten performers and three Academic All-Americans in 2011. Leading the charge was third-team All-American Vince India, recipient of Big Ten Player of the Year honors and winner of the prestiguous Les Bolstad Trophy.

The 2010 Hawkeyes finished the season ranked 36th in the nation and earned their best Big Ten finish (second) since 1992. Additionally, the Hawkeyes picked up their second tournament title in as many seasons with a win at the 2010 TaylorMade-adidas Hawkeye Invitational. Iowa finished tied for sixth in the NCAA Central Regional.


The Hawkeyes' climb in the national rankings began in 2009 under Hankins. Iowa jumped from 155th to 54th during the season as it picked up its first tournament title since 2004 by winning the 2008 Landfall Tradition in Wilmington, N.C. Hankins coached the Black and Gold to a fifth place finish at the 2009 Southeast Regionals and a 17th place finish at the NCAA Championships in Toledo, OH; marking the first time the Hawkeyes qualified for the championships since 1995.

While at Michigan State, Hankins led the Spartans to 10 tournament titles, including two Big Ten Championships (2005 and 2007). In addition, he was voted Big Ten Coach of the Year twice by his peers (2005 and 2007). Hankins also guided Michigan State to five NCAA appearances in his seven years, including a 23rd place finish in the 2007 NCAA Division I National Championship.

Hankins' resume at Michigan State also includes 64 top-10 finishes, national rankings during three different seasons, including the fall 2004 season when his Spartan team was ranked seventh out of 290 Division I men's golf programs, 27 first team Academic All-Big Ten selections, two Academic All-Americans, two All-Americans, one Big Ten Freshman of the Year, and the first Big Ten Conference medalist in Michigan State men's golf history.

Hankins' coaching resume also includes a two-year stint as head coach at the University of Texas at Arlington. There, Hankins led the Mavericks to a top-25 ranking in 1998 and 1999 and led them to eight Division I collegiate tournament titles in two seasons, the most in Division I golf during that time. In addition, the Mavericks qualified for two-straight NCAA regional berths, one NCAA national qualifier, and captured the Southland Conference Championship in 1999.

Hankins worked a total of three years as an assistant coach for men and women, and associate head coach of the men's golf program at his alma mater, Iowa State University. From 1995-1997 he

worked as associate head coach for the Cyclones. During this time, Iowa State advanced to two NCAA regional berths and won three tournament titles.

In his final season at Iowa State, the Cyclones broke every existing team record, including individual scoring average, tournament wins and NCAA Regional finish. His coaching experience also includes serving as head golf coach for the United States team that participated in the 2007 World University Games in Bangkok, Thailand.

In addition to coaching, Hankins has served as a professional at numerous country clubs and camps, including Ames Golf and Country Club, Cyclone Country Golf Camp, Cyclone Golf Academy, Des Moines Golf and Country Club and Iowa PGA Golf Academy. He is currently second vice president of the Golf Coaches Association of America. During his playing career, Hankins earned All-Big Eight Conference honors his senior season at Iowa State (1993). His personal best round of 66 set a Cyclone individual scoring record.

A three-time Academic All-Big Eight honoree (1988, 1991 and 1993), Hankins was also named an Academic All-American as a senior. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology in 1993 and an MBA in 1997 from lowa State.

In addition to collegiate competition, Hankins has played on the Nike Tour, Golden State Tour, Tommy Armour Tour and participated in PGA Tour Qualifying. Hankins said his expectations for the student-athletes who will compete for the UI under his direction will be to attain success both on the golf course and in the classroom.

"It's my responsibility to provide the platform for every member of our men's golf program to succeed athletically and academically. I want them to have a first-class experience and to graduate with a sense of pride about themselves and our university," he said.

"I am extremely excited by the support and enthusiasm the administration, alumni, and friends of the golf program have shown throughout my years at lowa. Gary (Barta) has clearly made a commitment to winning championships in every sport, including men's golf, at the University of Iowa."

Dan Holterhaus Assistant Coach Second Season

Former Iowa men's golfer Dan Holterhaus enters his third year as an assistant coach at Iowa in 2014.

Holterhaus' second season with the Hawkeyes yielded prosperity, as Iowa finished the 2013 season with an 11th place finish at the NCAA Southeast Regional in Tallahassee,

Fla., in its fifth-consecutive NCAA appearance. Iowa had numerous other successes during the season, including tying for first place at the Boilermaker Invite with a score of 878 (+14). Iowa shot a 1,186 (+34) during the Big Ten Championships at the Pete Dye Course in French Link, Ind., earning a third place finish. Both Steven Ihm and Joseph Winslow earned PING All-Region and All-Big Ten honors.

The Hawkeyes enjoyed a successful campaign in Holterhaus' first season with the program as well, advancing to the 2012 NCAA Championships. Iowa finished 22nd, and would finish the season as the highest ranked team in the Big Ten.

Iowa had a number of highlights in 2012, including winning the Hawkeye-Great River Invitational with an 840 (-24), which was the third-lowest score in program history. The Hawkeyes had one All-American, four PING All-Region honorees, three All-Big Ten selections and three Academic All-Big Ten recipients in 2012.

Holterhaus was a member of the Hawkeye men's golf team from 2003-08. He was a two-time team captain and three-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree.
