CILEK GARNERS SPORTMANSHIP AWARD:

Iowa Senior Laura Cilek recieved the Outstanding Sportsmanship Award for the 2009-10 academic school year. Cilek was selected for the award by the Big Ten Conference and was one of 22 student-athletes chosen for the award.

Cilek, an Iowa City natve and West HS alum, averaged 79 strokes over the 31 rounds she competed in during the 2009-10 season. She shot a low round of 72 multiple times, one of which led to her being named Big Ten Golfer of the Week on March 17. Cilek also excels in the classroom, as she was an academic all-Big Ten honoree.

HAWKEYE NEWCOMERS:

The Iowa women's golf team will welcome two newcomers for the 2010-11 season, Woojay Choi and Karly Grouwinkel. Choi, a The Woodlands, TX native, was named the top player at The Woodlands College Park High School in 2010. Grouwinkel, from Mt. Prospect, IL, holds the Prospect High School 18-hole record, posting a 73 during her senior season.
