HAWKEYES HEAD TO INDIANA, PURDUE

The Hawkeyes continue Big Ten play this weekend with trips to Indiana and Purdue. The Hawkeyes travel to Bloomington, IN, to face the Hoosiers Friday at 4:30 p.m. before heading to West Lafayette, IN, for a Saturday contest with the Boilermakers at 6 p.m.

Head Coach Sharon Dingman on preparing for Big Ten road trips: "We approach every match the same. We do our best to prepare the same - be that how we approach practices, eating times, etc. We are asking our players to be consistent in all they do and as a staff it is our job to do that same thing and to provide the opportunities for them to establish a routine. Playing on the road in the Big Ten is such a challenge and we count on our leaders to make sure the younger players understand the importance of preparation."

SCHIPPER CLIMBS THE CHARTS

Senior **Megan Schipper** became the 16th player in program history to record 1,000 career kills in Iowa's 3-1 win at Wisconsin (9/23). The Hawkeye captain currently ranks 15th on Iowa's all-time list with 1,053 career kills. She picked up her 200th kill of the 2009 season in Iowa's 3-0 win over 18thranked Michigan State (10/11). Schipper has collected at least 300 kills in each of the previous two seasons, including 2007, when she led the Hawkeyes with 309 kills as a sophomore. The Aplington native tallied a career-high 345 kills in 2008, the second-highest total on the team (Catherine Smale, 380). This season, Schipper leads Iowa with 3.28 kills per set.

MEISTER DIGS DEFENSE

Senior libero **Christina Meister** leads the Big Ten with 4.42 digs per set. Since 1990, only three Hawkeyes have averaged more than four digs per set through an entire season: Pam Kavadas, 5.22 ('04); Emily Hiza, 4.74 ('06) and 4.52 ('07); Janet Moylan, 4.63 ('90).

KRIEGER KITTLE CLOSES IN ON CENTURY MARK

Freshman Emma Krieger Kittle is seven kills away from reaching the 100kill plateau. The Iowa City native recorded a career-high 12 kills vs. 11thranked Iowa State (9/11) and has collected 41 of her 93 kills in Iowa's five games vs. ranked opponents.

HIT IT AND WIN IT

The Hawkeyes are 10-0 when attacking at a higher percentage than their opponent this season. Conversely, Iowa's opponent has hit a higher percentage in all eight of the Hawkeyes losses.

INDIANA

The Hoosiers are led by third-year head coach Sherry Dunbar and players Ashley Benson and Jordan Haverly. The front row duo represents the only pair of teammates to rank among the Big Ten leaders in kills per set. Haverly, a freshman OH, leads Indiana with 3.47 kills per set, seventh-best in the Big Ten. Benson, a junior MB, averages 3.46 kills per set, eighth-best in the conference. The Hoosiers lead the all-time series, 32-25. The two teams split the season series a year ago, with each team defending its own home court. The Hawkeyes last defeated Indiana on the road, 3-0, in 2006.

PURDUE

The Boilermakers are led by seventh-year head coach Dave Shondell and OH Carrie Gurnell. The senior leads Purdue and ranks sixth in the Big Ten with 3.48 kills per set. Purdue leads the all-time series, 42-18. The Boilermakers swept the Hawkeyes last season and have won the past 10 meetings. Iowa last defeated the Boilermakers, 3-2, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena in 2003. The Hawkeyes have not won at Purdue since sweeping the Boilermakers, 3-0, in 2000.



Head Coach Sharon Dingman



Sharon Dingman was hired as the eighth coach in Iowa volleyball history March 21, 2008.

The second-year head Hawkeye owns a career record of 359-238 (18 years) after leading lowa to its most successful campaign in eight seasons in 2008. The Hawkeyes' 14 overall victories and six conference wins were the most by an lowa Volleyball team

since 2000.

Dingman also reached a personal milestone in her inagural Hawkeye season, recording career victory No. 350 November 14 in a five-set victory over Northwestern.

Iowa re-established a home-court advantage in Dingman's first season, posting its first winning season at North Carver since 1998 and setting a program attendance record.

Dingman came to Iowa after serving as head coach at Illinois State from 2000-07, where she compiled a 147-98 record. In 2007, Dingman led the Redbirds to their first at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament since 1997. Illinois State reached the championship match of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and finished with a 21-12 overall record.

Illinois State produced winning seasons in seven of the eight seasons under Dingman and never finished lower than fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. Dingman produced 21 all-Missouri Valley Conference selections, including Player of the Year, Libero of the Year and two Freshman of the Year honorees.

Redbird teams under Dingman were also strong in the classroom. Eleven players were named to the league's scholar-athlete squad in her eight seasons. In 2004, four volleyball student-athletes earned perfect 4.00 grade-point-averages and the team recorded a 3.32 GPA.

Dingman started her head coaching career in 1991 at Auburn, where she led the Tigers to a 22-13 record in her only season at the helm. Her 1991 squad become the first Auburn volleyball tem to receive votes in the national poll and Auburn's fourth place finish in the SEC that season marked the highest finish ever for Auburn at the time.

She then moved to Butler in 1992, where she served as head coach for eight seasons. Dingman led the Bulldogs to four 20 win seasons and three postseason tournaments, including an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 1997 after capturing the Midwestern Collegiate Conference title. She was named MCC Coach of the Year in 1997 after compiling a 28-7 record.

Prior to becoming a head coach, Dingman spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at three Division I programs. After one season at Northern Michigan (1984), she assisted at Texas Tech for three seasons (1985-87). Dingman then spent three seasons at Kentucky (1988-90) and helped the Wildcats to an SEC Championship in 1988 along with three-straight regional finals appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

DINGMAN RETURNS TO PURDUE

Head Coach Sharon Dingman was a member of backto-back Big Ten Championship teams at Purdue (1979-80) before transferring to Northern Michigan, where she served as team captain and earn MVP honors while finishing her collegiate playing career.

HISTORICAL HAWKEYES

The Hawkeyes opened the 2009 campaign with seven straight road wins to become the first team in program history to start 7-0 away from home. Prior to Iowa's 3-0 record-setting win over Binghamton, the Hawkeyes were one of three Iowa teams to start the season 6-0 away from home (1978, 1988).

HAWKEYES GO DOWN SWINGING

It didn't end with a 'W' but the Hawkeyes continued their streak-breaking habits at Penn State (Oct. 2). Trailing the nation's top-ranked team 2-0, Iowa battled to a 26-24 win in set three, ending the Nittany Lions' streak of 141-straight regular season set victories.

IOWA IN THE ATTENDANCE GAME

Iowa ranks 28th in national attendance, averaging 1,267 fans per game. Iowa opened the season (Sept. 11) vs. Iowa State in front of 2,111 fans, the second-largest crowd in program history (2,191 vs. Wisconsin, 10/13/07).

HAWKEYE CAPTAINS

Senior outside hitter **Megan Schipper** and junior setter **Mara Hilgenberg** are Iowa's team captains for the 2009 season. Schipper leads the Hawkeyes in kills (210) and service aces (23) and ranks second in digs (188). Hilgenberg leads the Hawkeyes with 634 assists and is a third generation Hawkeye captain. Her great-uncle Wally and her uncle Jim were football team captains in 1963 and 1977, respectively.

SECOND GENERATION

Mara Hilgenberg's father Jay and **Emma Krieger Kittle**'s father Bruce played football together at Iowa from 1977-1980. Jay was a four-time letterwinner and went on to win Super Bowl XX with the 1985 Chicago Bears. Bruce used a redshirt in 1980 and came back as a team captain for Hayden Fry's 1981 Big Ten Championship team.

AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

The Big Ten is widely recognized as one of the nation's premier conferences. Penn State returns as the conference champion, winner of the last two NCAA Championships and ranked atop the 2009 AVCA Coaches Poll. Other Big Ten schools ranked in the top 25 include Minnesota (6), Illinois (10) and Michigan (11).
