BACK POINTS

- This is the 100th meeting between the two schools. Iowa leads the all-time series 70-28-1.
- Iowa is 10-0 for the fourth time under Tom Brands. The Hawkeyes started 10-0 in 2008-09, 2009-10, and 2012-13.
- The schools have met 12 times since 2006-07, Tom Brands' first season as Iowa's head coach. The Hawkeyes own an 8-4 advantage during that stretch.
- Bobby Telford has never faced a Minnesota wrestler not named Tony Nelson.
- Iowa has 10 wrestler ranked, including seven ranked fifth or better.
- Minnesota has eight wrestlers ranked, including two No. 1's, and four in the top five.
- Iowa's last win at Williams Arena was 16-15 in 2013. Iowa won on the third tiebreak criteria -- match points.

ON THE MAT

The top-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team travels to Minneapolis to face No. 2 Minnesota on Friday at 6 p.m. (CT) inside Williams Arena. Tickets start at \$5.

Iowa (10-0, 5-0) and Minnesota (10-0, 6-0) sit atop the Big Ten as the only remaining undefeated teams. Minnesota owns a one-half dual lead in the win column.

100th MEETING

Friday's dual will be the 100th meeting between Minnesota and Iowa. The schools first met in 1921, a 39-3 Iowa victory in Iowa City.

The Hawkeyes lead the all-time series 70-28-1. Iowa is 30-10-1 all-time in Minneapolis.

The schools have met 12 times since 2006-07, Tom Brands' first season as Iowa's head coach. The Hawkeyes own an 8-4 advantage during that stretch.

ON THE TUBE

The dual is televised by BTN. Tim Johnson and Jim Gibbons will call the dual, and Shane Sparks will report matside live from Williams Arena.

HAWKEYES IN THE RANKINGS

Iowa has nine wrestlers ranked in the top 10 of the latest Intermat rankings (Jan. 20), more than any other school.

Seven of Iowa's wrestlers are ranked in the top 5, including Thomas Gilman (5), Cory Clark (5), Josh Dziewa (5), Brandon Sorensen (2), Mike Evans (2), Nathan Burak (3) and Bobby Telford (2).

Two more Hawkeyes are projected in the top eight, including Nick Moore (7) and Sammy Brooks (8). Michael Kelly is ranked No. 15 at 157.

WIRE TO WIRE

Iowa debuted at the top spot on Nov. 11 when the USA Today/NWCA preseason poll was released 12 weeks ago. Iowa had five first place votes before the season started, the same number as Minnesota. The Hawkeyes have maintained the top spot all season and enter Friday's dual as the unanimous No. 1, claiming all 10 first-place votes.

SORENSEN IS 1 OF A KIND

Redshirt freshman Brandon Sorensen is the only Division I wrestler in the country with wins over two reigning NCAA finalists.

Sorensen defeated NCAA 149-pound runner-up Josh Kindig, 6-1, on Jan. 11, and 12 days later he handed defending NCAA champion Jason Tsirtsis his first loss of the season, 3-2, in double overtime.

His 24 wins lead the team, and his only losses have been to teammate Brody Grothus (3-2) at the Luther Open, and current No. 1 David Habat (3-2) at the Midlands Championships.

LAST OF THE UNBEATENS

Mike Evans (18-0) and Nathan Burak (13-0) enter the dual with undefeated records. Both streaks are career bests. In the history of Iowa wrestling, 15 wrestlers have finished the season with a perfect record (minimum 20 matches). Four of those wrestlers were able to perform the feat twice. They include Mark Ironside, Lincoln McIlravy, T.J. Williams and Jim Zalesky. Iowa coaches Tom Brands and Terry Brands are among the 15 wrestlers. Tom went 45-0 in 1990-91 and Terry went 35-0 in 1991-92.

UNDEFEATED ALL-AMERICANS

Two of Iowa's four returning All-Americans -- Mike Evans (174) and Nathan Burak (197) -- are a combined 31-0 this season.

Evans is 18-0 with 11 wins by bonus points. Burak is 12-0 with two pins, one major decision, and one technical fall. He has claimed two tournament titles wrestling unattached at the Luther Open and Midlands Championships. He wrestled attached for the first time Jan. 4 at Ohio State and earned a 2-1 win over No. 7 Kyle Snyder.

Cory Clark and Bobby Telford, Iowa's other returning All-Americans -- are a combined 34-3. Clark is 16-2 overall with eight falls, one technical fall, and one major decision. Telford is 18-1 with nine pins, one major decision, and one win via medical forfeit.

All four returning All-Americans won Midlands individual titles on Dec. 30.

The Hawkeyes have crowned at least one All-American every year since 1972, a span of 43 seasons. Iowa has totaled 261 All-America honors during that stretch. The Hawkeyes

crowned six All-Americans in 2014, including four-time All-American Derek St. John (157) and first-timers Clark (125) and Burak (197). Tony Ramos earned his third career All-America honor, winning the 133-pound bracket, and Evans (174) and Telford (285) were both named All-Americans for the second time in their careers.

EVANS LEADS ACTIVE HAWKEYES

Senior Mike Evans has opened the season with 18 consecutive wins. The streak is a career-long and seven better than his previous streak of 11 set in 2013-14.

Evans has 95 career wins, more than any other active Hawkeye, and his 62 career dual starts are most on the team. He is 52-10 all-time in duals.

Evans has faced Minnesota's Logan Storley four times (1-3), including three times in a dual setting (1-2). Evans lost 4-3 at the 2013 dual, and defeated Storley 2-1 at the 2014 dual, their last meeting. Storley bested Evans 3-1 at the 2013 NWCA National Duals, and 3-2 at the 2013 NCAA Championships.

CHASING MILESTONES

Seniors Mike Evans and Bobby Telford are within striking distance of career win No. 100. Evans leads all active Hawkeyes with 95 career wins, Telford has 93. Forty wrestlers in the program history have accumulated 100 career wins, including coaches Tom Brands (158), Terry Brands (137), and Ryan Morningstar (110).

Tom Brands is four wins shy of his 160th dual victory at Iowa, which would tie Dave McCuskey for No. 2 in program history.

BIG WEEKLY HONORS

Redshirt freshman Brandon Sorensen was named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week for the second time this season on Jan. 27.

Sorensen, a native of Cedar Falls, Iowa, defeated defending NCAA champion and previously undefeated Jason Tsirtsis of Northwestern, 3-2, in double overtime on Jan. 23. Sorensen, then ranked No. 3, rode top-ranked Tsirtsis for all 30 seconds in the second tiebreaker to win, 3-2.

He leads Iowa with 24 wins, including six major decisions and five falls, and his only losses of the year have been 3-2 setbacks to teammate Brody Grothus and current No. 1

Dave Habat of Edinboro.

Sorensen climbed to No. 2 in the national rankings. He is the only Division I wrestler in the country with wins over two reigning NCAA finalists. Two weeks before his 3-2 overtime win over Tsirtsis, he defeated NCAA runner-up Josh Kindig, 6-1, on Oklahoma State's home mat.

The weekly honor is the second of his career and the third for Iowa this season. Sorensen shared the conference honor Jan. 13 after defeating Kindig. Bobby Telford earned league recognition Dec. 31.

BRANDS GETS WIN NO. 150

The Hawkeyes' 11th straight win over Iowa State on Nov. 29 was Tom Brands' 150th career win at Iowa. He is 156-15-1 (.909) in eight-plus seasons as Iowa's head coach. Only Dave McCuskey (160) and Dan Gable (355) have more dual wins at Iowa.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 951-224-31 (.799) in 105 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 53 NCAA Champions have won a total of 81 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 110 Big Ten champions have combined for 191 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 29 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 150 All-Americans have earned All-America status 307 times, including 18 four-time, 32 three-time and 39 two-time honorees.

40 YEARS SINCE NO. 1

Iowa celebrated the 40th anniversary of its first national championship on Jan. 23. Gary Kurdelmeier led Iowa to its first NCAA Championship in 1975, and in the 40 years since, the Hawkeyes have accumulated 23 team titles, more than any other school -- Oklahoma State (7), Penn State (4), Minnesota (3), Iowa State (2), and Arizona State (1).

NCAA EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeyes have seven wrestlers with NCAA Championships experience. Seniors Mike Evans (174) and Bobby Telford (285) are three-time NCAA qualifiers. Telford earned All-America honors in 2012 and 2014, while Evans earned

All-America honors in 2013 and 2014. Junior Nathan Burak (197) and sophomore Cory Clark (125) also advanced to the All-America stand in 2014. Burak was making his second NCAA tournament appearance, while Clark was making his first. Senior Nick Moore (165) has competed in two NCAA Championships (2013, 2014), and last year senior Josh Dzievia (141) and junior Brody Grothus (149) made their first career appearances.

HAWKEYES ON TV

BTN will televise the final round of the Big Ten Championships on March 8, 2015, at 2 p.m. The 2015 conference tournament is hosted by Ohio State.

LAST MEETING -- #2 IOWA 15, #4 Minnesota 19 -- Jan. 25, 2014

IOWA CITY, Iowa -- The University of Iowa fell to No. 4 Minnesota, 19-15, on Jan. 25 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The teams split 10 matches, but Minnesota scored bonus points at 125 and 197 to hand No. 2 Iowa its first conference loss of the season and snap the Hawkeyes streak of 26 straight conference wins at home.

Iowa scored three wins over top five opponents. Eleventh-ranked Josh Dzievia escaped in the second period to earn a 1-0 win over No. 5 Chris Dardanes, and Mike Evans and Bobby Telford both worked overtime to earn wins at 174 and 285.

Evans, ranked No. 6 at 174, escaped in the first tiebreak period to defeat No. 5 Logan Storley, 2-1. Telford, ranked No. 3 at 285, finished a single leg with six seconds left in sudden victory to defeat No. 2 Tony Nelson, 3-1.

The Hawkeyes also got wins at 133 and 165. Third-ranked Tony Ramos used a pair of takedowns and 1:30 riding time to defeat No. 9 David Thorn, 6-2, at 133. Nick Moore rode Danny Zilverberg the entire second period and added two escapes in the third to hold on for a 3-2 win at 165.

The Gophers opened with bonus points at 125 and never trailed in the dual. Sam Brancale ended No. 3 Thomas Gilman's nine-match win streak with a first period fall. No. 3 Nick Dardanes broke a 6-6 tie with a 5-3 decision over No. 13 Brody Grothus at 149, and No. 14 Dylan Ness reversed No. 2 Derek St. John in the final 30 seconds to win 7-4 at 157.

Decisions from Moore and Evans knotted the score, 12-12, but No. 9 Kevin Steinhaus defeated Sammy Brooks, 8-6, at 184, and top-ranked Scott Schiller clinched the dual with a 16-5 major decision at 197.

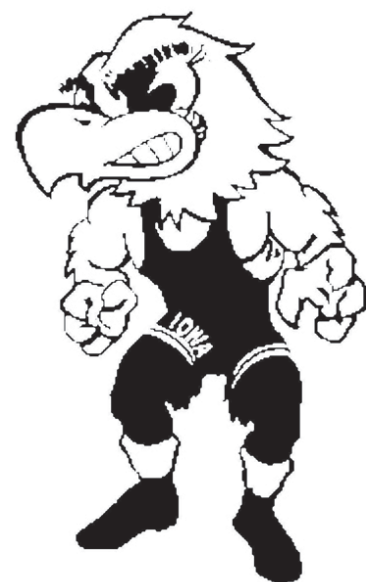

Tom Brands
Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands completed his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 156-15-1 (.907) overall and 63-6 (.909) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 173-35-1 (.826) career mark.

In eight seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning nine NCAA champions, 11 Big Ten champions and 44 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 61 academic all-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 72 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last eight years, sending the entire 10-man line-

up in 2009, 2010, and 2014. Iowa has also won or shared six of the last seven Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, Iowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the then-national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when Iowa defeated Iowa State, 20-15, on Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' eight seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.

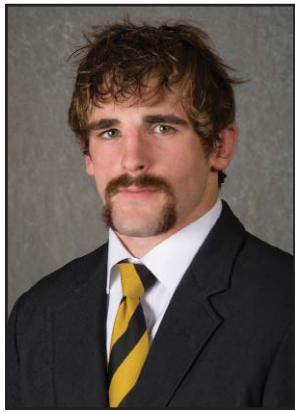
