HAWKEYES DIG DEFENSE

The Hawkeyes rank second in the Big Ten in digs per set (15.71), trailing only conference-leading Michigan (15.79). Iowa senior libero **Christina Meister** leads the Big Ten with 4.48 digs per set. Michigan libero Sloane Donhoff ranks second with 4.40 digs per set.

BLOCK PARTY

Junior **Becky Walters** is one of just five Big Ten players to total eight blocks in a conference match this season. Walters recorded three solos and five blocks assists in Iowa's Big Ten opener at Wisconsin (Sept. 23).

MICHIGAN

The eighth-ranked Wolverines are led by 11th-year head coach Mark Rosen and sophomore libero Sloane Donhoff. Donhoff was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week (Sept. 28) and ranks second in the Big Ten with 4.40 digs per game. Michigan has won the last three meetings and leads the all-time series, 28-23. Iowa last defeated the Wolverines in 2007. The Hawkeye rallied from two sets down to defeat Michigan, 3-2, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena (28-30, 29-31, 30-26, 30-28, 15-10).

MICHIGAN STATE

The Spartans are led by fifth-year head coach Cathy George and S Natalie Emro. The sophomore earned a spot on the all-Big Ten freshman team in 2008 and recorded a Big Ten season-high 62 assists versus Syracuse, Sept. 4. Michigan State leads the all-time series, 33-23. The two teams split the season series in 2008, with each team defending their home court.

HAWKEYES GO DOWN SWINGING

It didn't end with a 'W' but the Hawkeyes continued their streak-breaking habits at Penn State (Oct. 2). Trailing the nation's top-ranked team 2-0, lowa battled to a 26-24 win in set three, ending the Nittany Lions' streak of 141-straight regular season set victories.

BIG TEN OPENS - STREAK CLOSES

The Iowa Hawkeyes defeated the Wisconsin Badgers, 3-1, in the Big Ten opener Sept. 23 in Madison, WI. Iowa's win was its first in its last 14 visits to Wisconsin. Iowa last defeated the Badgers on their home floor, 3-2, in 1994. Iowa opened the Big Ten season with a win for the second time in as many seasons under Head Coach Sharon Dingman.

ATTACK, FINISH, WIN

The Hawkeyes are 9-0 when attacking at a higher percentage than their opponent this season. Conversely, Iowa's opponent has hit a higher percentage in all seven of the Hawkeyes losses.

HISTORICAL HAWKEYES

The Hawkeyes opened the 2009 campaign with seven straight road wins to become the first team in program history to start 7-0 away from home. Prior to Iowa's 3-0 record-setting win over Binghamton, the Hawkeyes were one of three Iowa teams to start the season 6-0 away from home (1978, 1988).

Head Coach Sharon Dingman



Sharon Dingman was hired as the eighth coach in Iowa volleyball history March 21, 2008.

The second-year head Hawkeye owns a career record of 358-237 (18 years) after leading lowa to its most successful campaign in eight seasons in 2008. The Hawkeyes' 14 overall victories and six conference wins were the most by an lowa Volleyball team

since 2000.

Dingman also reached a personal milestone in her inagural Hawkeye season, recording career victory No. 350 November 14 in a five-set victory over Northwestern.

Iowa re-established a home-court advantage in Dingman's first season, posting its first winning season at North Carver since 1998 and setting a program attendance record.

Dingman came to Iowa after serving as head coach at Illinois State from 2000-07, where she compiled a 147-98 record. In 2007, Dingman led the Redbirds to their first at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament since 1997. Illinois State reached the championship match of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and finished with a 21-12 overall record.

Illinois State produced winning seasons in seven of the eight seasons under Dingman and never finished lower than fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. Dingman produced 21 all-Missouri Valley Conference selections, including Player of the Year, Libero of the Year and two Freshman of the Year honorees.

Redbird teams under Dingman were also strong in the classroom. Eleven players were named to the league's scholar-athlete squad in her eight seasons. In 2004, four volleyball student-athletes earned perfect 4.00 grade-point-averages and the team recorded a 3.32 GPA.

Dingman started her head coaching career in 1991 at Auburn, where she led the Tigers to a 22-13 record in her only season at the helm. Her 1991 squad become the first Auburn volleyball tem to receive votes in the national poll and Auburn's fourth place finish in the SEC that season marked the highest finish ever for Auburn at the time.

She then moved to Butler in 1992, where she served as head coach for eight seasons. Dingman led the Bulldogs to four 20 win seasons and three postseason tournaments, including an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 1997 after capturing the Midwestern Collegiate Conference title. She was named MCC Coach of the Year in 1997 after compiling a 28-7 record.

Prior to becoming a head coach, Dingman spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at three Division I programs. After one season at Northern Michigan (1984), she assisted at Texas Tech for three seasons (1985-87). Dingman then spent three seasons at Kentucky (1988-90) and helped the Wildcats to an SEC Championship in 1988 along with three-straight regional finals appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

HAWKEYE SCHEDULE

Iowa opened Big Ten play with four-straight road contests. It was the first time since 1992 the Hawkeyes have opened the conference season with four road matches. Eleven of Iowa's 32 contests are against 2008 NCAA Tournament qualifiers. They include Iowa State, Minnesota (2), Penn State (2), Michigan (2), Purdue (2) and Illinois (2).

HAWKEYE CAPTAINS

Senior outside hitter **Megan Schipper** and junior setter **Mara Hilgenberg** are Iowa's team captains for the 2009 season. Schipper leads the Hawkeyes in kills (189) and service aces (22) and ranks second in digs (167). Hilgenberg leads the Hawkeyes with 560 assists and is a third generation Hawkeye captain. Her great-uncle Wally and her uncle Jim were football team captains in 1963 and 1977, respectively.

IOWA IN THE ATTENDANCE GAME

lowa ranks 31st in national attendance after averaging 1,275 fans at the 2009 Hawkeye Challenge. Iowa opened the season (Sept. 11) vs. Iowa State in front of 2,111 fans, the second-largest crowd in program history (2,191, Wisconsin, 10/13/07).

SECOND GENERATION

Mara Hilgenberg's father Jay and **Emma Krieger Kittle**'s father Bruce played football together at Iowa from 1977-1980. Jay was a four-time letterwinner and went on to win Super Bowl XX with the 1985 Chicago Bears. Bruce used a redshirt in 1980 and came back as a team captain for Hayden Fry's 1981 Big Ten Championship team.

AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

The Big Ten is widely recognized as one of the nation's premier conferences. Penn State returns as the conference champion, winner of the last two NCAA Championships and ranked atop the 2009 AVCA Coaches Poll. Other Big Ten schools ranked in the top 25 include Minnesota (5), Michigan (8), Illinois (12) and Michigan State (18).

IOWA ON THE BTN

The 2009 Hawkeyes will make two appearances on the Big Ten Network this season. Iowa opened the Big Ten season on the Big Ten Network with a 3-1 win at Wisconsin, Sept. 23. The rematch between the Hawkeyes and Badgers, Wednesday, Nov. 11, will be broadcast live from Carver-Hawkeye Arena at 7 p.m. CT.
