**THIS WEEK** -- The Iowa women's golf team travels to Bloomington, IN, this weekend to compete in the Big Ten Championships. Eleven teams will play 36-holes Friday, and 18-holes Saturday and Sunday on the par-71 Indiana University Golf Course. The tournament is scheduled to begin at 8:00 a.m Friday and Sunday and 9:00 a.m Saturday.

**THE COMPETITION** -- The competition includes the 11 Big Ten schools: Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Illinois, Michigan State, Minnesota, Northwestern, Ohio State, Penn State, Purdue and Wisconsin.

**LINEUP** -- Competing for Iowa will be **Jill Marcum, Karla Murra, Tyrette Metzendorf, Amy Riepma** and **Maggie Gelber**. The sixth player has not yet been decided. Out of the six players, the four lowest scores will count.

**LAST COMPETITION** -- The Hawkeyes finished third (out of 16 teams) at the Illini Spring Classic with a 948 (+84). **Jill Marcum** led the Hawkeyes with a 14 over par, 230, to finish tied for seventh. **Karla Murra** came in 19th, shooting 237 (+21). She carded a personal spring low round of 77.

**BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY** -- Iowa won the tournament in 1991, with a score of 1,238 after playing 72 holes. At the 2005 Big Ten Championships, held at the University of Michigan, Iowa placed sixth, carding a 959 (+95). The tournament was shortened by rain. **Murra** came in 16th, carding 237, and **Riepma** finished in 28th (242).

**SETTING RECORDS** -- Iowa set a new school record last fall with a 77.1 team scoring average. Freshman **Tyrette Metzendorf** is in first place on Iowa's all-time individual top performances for 36-holes (145) reached at the Legends of Golf Shootout in the fall. **Metzendorf** is also in second place on Iowa's individual performances for 54-holes, carding a 220 at the Hawkeye Intercollegiate.

**HAWKEYE COACH** -- Coach **Bobbe Carney** is in her fourth year as Iowa's head women's golf coach. Last season, the Hawkeyes posted their best season under her guidance, finishing sixth in the Big Ten.

**QUOTING COACH CARNEY** -- "This team is capable of being very competitive in the conference championship. We will need to post strong scores each day because of the strength of the conference. A finish in the top half of the conference is very doable."

**NEXT COMPETITION** -- The NCAA regionals are in Columbus, OH, at Ohio State University May 11-13.
