THIS WEEK -- Junior Jennifer **Skolaski** will represent the Hawkeye women's swimming and diving team at the 2004 NCAA Championships Thursday thru Saturday in College Station, TX. All events will be held at the Student Rec Center Natatorium on the Texas A&M University campus. Skolaski is scheduled to compete in the 500 free Thursday, the 100 back Friday and the 200 back Saturday. Event prelims start at 11 a.m. each day, with event finals starting at 7 p.m. each night.

NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP TICKETS -- Tickets are still available for the 2004 NCAA Women's Swimming and Diving Championships. All-session championships passes are \$56, single-day tickets are \$25 and individual session tickets are \$15 for finals and \$12 for prelims. SKOLASKI AT THE 2004 BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS -- Skolaski had three school record setting performances at the 2004 Big Ten Championships in Minneapolis, MN. The junior swam in three individual events and on four relays during the four-day meet. **Skolaski** placed second in the 200 back (1:57.51), breaking the school record of 1:58.37 she set in 2002. She also swam lead legs on the 200 medley and 800 free relays that placed fifth and smashed school records on the first day of competition. The 200 medley relay time of 1:42.94 broke the school record of 1:44.47 set in 2002, and the 800 free relay time of 7:18.90 broke the school record of 7:22.52 set in 2001. **Skolaski** also placed fourth in the 100 back (55.24) and 11th in the 500 free (4:49.72), and swam lead legs on the 400 medley relay (2:48.85) and 400 free relay (3:24.18) that placed ninth.

SKOLASKI IN THE IOWA RECORD BOOKS -- In only three years as a Hawkeye, junior Jennifer Skolaski had made her mark on the Iowa record

books. She holds school records in three individual events (100 back, 200 back and 400 IM) and as part of three relays (200 and 400 medley, and 800 free), and ranks second on Iowa's alltime best performers list in four other individual events (500 free, 1,000 free, 1,650 free and 200 IM). Overall, she is ranked in Iowa's top 10 in school history in nine individual events and as part of four relays.

NCAA Notes -- has qualified to compete in 100 and 200 back and 500 free... this is the third consecutive season she has qualified for the NCAA Championships in all three events.

2003-04 -- team co-captain...leads team in 500 and 1,000 free, 100 and 200 back, and 200 IM... also swam lead legs on 200 and 400 medley, and 400 and 800 free relays that led the team... broke her own school record in 200 back (1:57.51) with runner-up finish at Big Ten Championships... swam lead legs on school-record setting 200 medley and 800 free relays at Big Ten meet... also placed fourth in 100 back (55.24), 11th in 500 free (4:49.72) and swam lead legs on ninth-placing 400 medley and 400 free relays at conference meet... won all three individual events she was entered in at five different meets this season... has 28 top-five individual finishes... swam lead leg on three winning relays (two 200 medley and one 400 medley).

2002-03 -- all-American... placed eighth in 100 back (55.44) at NCAA Championships after recording a collegiate-best and school-record setting 54.34 in prelims... also placed 20th in 200 back (1:59.10) and 30th in 500 free (4:50.30) at NCAA meet... set school record in 400 IM (4:20.14) at Iowa Senior Championships... placed second in 200 back (1:58.58), third in 100 back (55.38), and ninth in 500 free (4:48.20) at Big Ten meet... second team all-Big Ten

selection... led team in 100 and 200 back, 200 and 400 IM, and 500, 1000 and 1,650 free... named Big Ten Swimmer of the Week after winning 100 back (56.83), 500 free (4:56.88) and 1,000 free (10:14.25) against Illinois and Ohio State... placed ninth in 200-meter back (2:17.93), 14th in 100-meter back (1:06.21) and 18th in 400-meter free (4:23.26) at U.S. Open... recorded 33 top-five finishes, including 18 wins... academic all-Big Ten... letterwinner.

2001-02 -- NCAA qualifier, competing in 100 back, 200 back and 500 free... swam lead leg on school record-setting 400 medley relay (3:43.42), and set school records in 100 (56.22) and 200 back (1:58.37)... placed third in 200 back (1:58.37),

fourth in 1,650 free (16:32.30) and sixth in 500 free (4:51.78) at Big Ten Championships... led team in 100 and 200 back, and 500, 1,000 and 1,650 free... named Big Ten Swimmer of Week after winning 200 back (2:03.15), 500 free (5:02.27) and 1,000 free (10:17.26) at Iowa State, and winning 100 back (57.01), 200 back (2:01.88) and 1,000 free (10:06.71) vs. Kansas... all-Big Ten at-large selection... recorded 32 top-five finishes, including 16 first-place finishes... letterwinner.

High School -- swam 200-meter back at 2000 US Olympic trials.... 400-meter IM Junior National champ... won seven individual state titles... three-time all-American, first team all-state and team MVP... USA Swimming athlete representative for state of Wisconsin 1999-00... National Honor Society member... coach was Drew Walden.

Personal -- born November 24, 1982... daughter of Steven and Carol Skolaski... pre-social work major.
