**THIS WEEK** -- The Iowa men's swimming team will compete at the Big Ten Championships Thursday thru Saturday in West Lafayette, IN. All events will be held at the Boilermaker Aquatic Center and Doris Z. Holloway Pool on the Purdue University campus. All-session tickets are \$30 for adults and \$20 for students. Single-session prelim tickets are \$5 for adults and \$3 for students. Single-session finals tickets are \$7 for adults and \$5 for students.

**2003 BIG TEN REVIEW** -- The Hawkeyes finished ninth at the 2003 Big Ten Championships, scoring 195 points. Michigan won the team title. **Timo Klami** led the Hawkeyes, winning the three-meter diving and placing fifth in platform diving. He earned first team all-Big Ten honors for his performances.

# HEAD COACH JOHN DAVEY



## John Davey

Head Coach

Former Hawkeye all-American John Davey is in his sixth year as head swim coach at Iowa. From 1995–98, he served as assistant coach at Iowa under head coach Glenn Patton. Prior to returning to his alma mater, Davey was the swim coach for the Anderson Barracudas/M.E. Lyons YMCA swim club in Cincinnati, Ohio (1994-95). Davey also served as an assistant and interim head coach at the University of Wisconsin (1992-94) and as assistant coach at Ohio State University (1991-92).

During his swimming career at Iowa, Davey was and still is the only Big Ten athlete, in any sport, to be named Athlete of the Year all four years of eligibility. While at Iowa, Davey won ten Big Ten titles and was a ten-time all-American. He was a finalist in both the 1992 Olympic Games in Barcelona, Spain, and the 1988 Olympic Games in Seoul, South Korea. In addition, Davey has been a finalist in two World Championships, three European Championships, and has won a silver and three bronze medals at the Commonwealth Games.

The 2003-04 Hawkeyes posted an 8-4 overall dual record - its first winning season under Davey. Those season wins almost double his career coaching victories, as Iowa had won 10 duals in the previous five seasons. The Hawkeye also earned their first top 25 ranking by the College Swimming Coaches Association of America under Davey, checking in a No. 22 in November with wins over Purdue, Notre Dame, Brigham Young and Louisville.

Under Davey's direction, the Hawkeyes have crowned four Big Ten champions and six all-Americans. The 1999-2000 season marked the first time Iowa crowned a Big Ten champion since 1995, and the first time the Hawkeyes had multiple champions since 1994. Ales Abersek became the second swimmer in Iowa history to be named Big Ten Swimmer of the Championship after winning the 100 and 200 butterfly. Timo Klami became the seventh diver in school history to win a Big Ten title, placing first in the three-meter event at the 2003 meet. Klami was also Iowa's first diver since Randy Ableman in 1982 to win a conference title.

As the coach for the Anderson team, Davey led his tankers to the YMCA national championships in the spring and summer of 1995. Davey's team captured seven individual national YMCA titles and swimmer Dod Wales set two YMCA national records.

While at Wisconsin, Davey coached five all-Americans including Ola Stromberg, who holds the Field House pool record in the 1650-yard freestyle, Robert Pinter, an Olympic finalist in 1992 and Valter Kalaus, an Olympic finalist in 1988.

A native of Middleton, England, Davey has held British and English senior records in three different events, which he broke on numerous occasions during his swimming career. He presently holds the Iowa records for both the 200 and 400 Individual Medley. In 1999, Davey was elected to the National Iowa Varsity Club Athletic Hall of Fame.

Davey earned his bachelors degree in exercise science from Iowa in 1989. His wife, Kate, was an all-American swimmer at The Ohio State University and a gold and bronze medal winner for the U.S. in the 1991 World University Games. They have a two-year-old daughter, Gillian, and two cats, Styx and Stone.
