HAWKEYES TO FACE ILLINOIS IN FINAL BIG TEN SERIES --

The Hawkeyes and Fighting Illini will play a four-game series to round out the Big Ten schedule and the 2004 season. Games will begin at 6 p.m. on Friday, 2 p.m. on Saturday and 1 p.m. on Sunday. Friday and Sunday's games will be nine innings and Saturday's doubleheader will be seven innings. Admission is \$3.

IOWA WINS MID-WEEK GAME OVER ILLINOIS STATE --

The Hawkeyes used an 8-2 victory over Illinois State on Wednesday night at Redbird Field to sweep the two-game series this season.

Four Iowa pitchers, Casey O'Rourke, Michael Washburn, Scott Brune and Tim Gudex limited the Redbird offense to two runs in nine innings. Washburn was credited with the victory, the first of his career, after allowing three hits in 2 2/3 innings.

Freshman Jeff Engel led the Hawkeyes at the plate going 3-for-4 with two runs and two RBIs in the game. In the seventh inning, Engel hit a Texas leaguer over the third baseman's head. Being aggressive on the base paths, Engel stretched the hit into a double, the first of his Iowa career.

The Hawkeyes put the game away with five runs in the final three frames. In the ninth, Luis Andrulonis doubled to lead off the inning and pinch hitter Gabe Haugland followed with a single. After a pop out, Andy Lytle walked to load the bases and the first run of the inning crossed the plate on a catcher's interference. Nate Yoho made the score 8-2 with a sacrifice fly to centerfield to knock in Haugland.

DAHM GETS 300TH CAREER WIN -- Iowa Head Coach Jack Dahm picked up his 300th career victory in the 8-3 win over Purdue on Saturday at Duane Banks Field. Dahm broke the 300 barrier with the 8-2 victory over Illinois State on Wednesday night. In 11 seasons as a head coach, Dahm has now compiled a 301-309 overall record between Creighton and Iowa.

THE DIFFERENCE MAKERS -- The Hawkeyes are 3-11 in one-run games this season. In addition, the Hawkeyes are 1-4 in extra inning affairs.

THE ONE MAN ROTATION -- Senior Nathan Johnson is leading the Big Ten with a 1.64 ERA in seven starts. The righthander has a 4-1 record and has an incredible 47/9 K/BB ratio in conference play.

Johnson hasn't been relieved for in a game since April 9 against Michigan, a span of five complete games. Of a possible 63 innings in league starts, he has been on the hill for 60 1/3 innings.

On the year, Johnson has a 6-3 record with a 3.01 ERA. He has 69 strikeouts in 89 2/3 innings of work, the most innings in the conference.

THE FRESHMEN WAVE -- On Wednesday night against Illinois State, six freshmen saw significant action in the 8-2 win. Jason White (SS), Cole Grandfield (1B), Jeff Engel (LF), Casey O'Rourke (SP), Michael Washburn (RP) and redshirt freshman Scott Brune (RP) all played key roles in the victory.

All three freshmen position players collected a hit at the plate. Engel led the way with a career best day going



Jack Dahm enters his first season as Iowa's head baseball coach and has a 283-276 career record. Prior to coming to Iowa, Dahm spent 10 years as the Head Coach at Creighton University, where he is the school's all-time winningest coach. Dahm also played for four years for the Bluejays under current Chicago Cubs General Manager Jim Hendry.

Assistant Coach **Nick Zumsande** is in his first season as Iowa's pitching coach after collecting 14 years of coaching experience throughout the Midwest. Prior to joining the Hawkeyes, Zumsande served as the pitching coach for Indiana State. Before joining the Sycamores, Zumsande coached for one year at Iowa State University where he helped lead the team to their first Big 12 Tournament appearance in school history.

Assistant Coach **Ryan Brownlee** is in his first season as Iowa's hitting/fielding instructor and recruiting coordinator. Prior to coming to Iowa, Brownlee was the hitting/fielding coach at James Madison University, where he led the Dukes to school records in fielding percentage. Before going to JMU, Brownlee served as an assistant at his alma mater, Evansville.

Volunteer Assistant Coach **Spencer Allen** is in his first season with the Hawkeyes. Allen will coach first base during game days and is responsible for outfield instruction. Allen earned his B.A. in 2001 from Iowa State, where he was a three-year starter at second base.

On the mound, O'Rourke pitched four innings of seven-hit ball with no walks and one strikeout. Washburn picked up his first career win after going 2 2/3 innings, while Brune manned the hill for 1 2/3 innings allowing only one hit.

WELKER TIES IOWA RECORD -- Junior catcher Kris Welker tied an Iowa record on Wednesday night when he was hit by a pitch for the 16th time this season. Welker is leading the Big Ten in the category and this weekend will look to pass former Hawkeye Ian Mattiace (16 HBP, 2002) in the record books.

REID TIES RECORD -- Jim Reid tied an Iowa record for the second time in as many weeks with a four-hit effort against Purdue on Sunday. Reid went 4-for-5 in the game with four singles to tie the mark. Last weekend, Luis Andruonis tied the record for the first time this season with four singles in the series finale at Minnesota.

Reid is leading the team with a .315 average (min. 50 at-bats) and is currently on a six-game hitting streak. The senior designated hitter is tied for second on the team with three triples, third with nine doubles and has 15 RBIs.

LYTLE'S AVERAGE CONTINUES TO CLIMB --

Entering the month of May, Andy Lytle was batting .270. Thus far this month, the junior has caught fire as he is leading the team with a .347 (17-49) mark to be considered Iowa's "Mr. May".

For the season, Lytle is batting .297 with four doubles and 12 RBIs.

DOUBLE ME UP -- Junior Nate Yoho is leading the team with 56 hits this season including 14 doubles and two home runs. He is currently in the midst of a seven-game hitting streak and has a .298 average with a team-leading 35 RBIs. Yoho has a team-best 18 multiple hit games and 11 multi-RBI games.

Yoho is the only Hawkeye to start every game this season, starting all 51 games in right field.

THE FIGHTING ILLINI -- Illinois leads the all-time series over the Hawkeyes 110-70-2. Last season, the two teams split the four-game series in Champaign.

The Fighting Illini enter the weekend with a 20-31 overall record and are ninth in the Big Ten with a 9-19 mark. Last weekend, Illinois split the four-game series with conference leading Minnesota.

At the plate, three batters are hitting over .300 this season. Catcher Chris Robinson is leading the team with a .359 average with nine home runs and is tied for the team-high with 34 RBIs. West Des Moines native Drew Davidson is leading the team with 10 long balls and has 34 RBIs.

The Fighting Illini pitching staff has a 5.35 team ERA. The rotation this weekend will be as follows:
