- Tony Ramos (30-0) and Derek St. John (29-0) are a combined 59-0 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- Iowa is 3-1 this year against ranked opponents.
- Oklahoma State (34) and Iowa (23) have a combined 57 NCAA wrestling titles.
- Senior Derek St. John has won a team-best 26 straight matches dating back to last season.

#### ON THE MAT

The University of Iowa wrestling team hosts No. 5 Oklahoma State on Friday at 7:07 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Mat inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Admission is \$15 for adults, \$8 for youth, and free for UI students and children five years old and younger.

#### THE SERIES -- OKLAHOMA STATE

Oklahoma State leads the all-time series 27-18-2. The Cowboys won the first meeting, 24-8, in 1954, and own a two-match winning streak in the series. Oklahoma State won 17-16 in 2012, its last visit to Carver-Hawkeye Arena, and won 18-12 last season in Stillwater, Okla.

The schools have split 20 duals wrestled in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes last win at home over the Cowboys was a 19-16 victory on Jan. 16, 2010.

#### LONG TERM SUCCESS

Iowa (23) and Oklahoma State (34) have combined for 57 NCAA team championships, and are two of just five programs with more than 900 dual victories (Oklahoma State 1,043; Iowa State 1,031, Oregon State, 985; Iowa, 934; Minnesota, 910).

The two schools have also combined for 216 NCAA individual titles. Oklahoma State leads all schools with 136 titles, while Iowa is in second with 80 individual championships.

#### RANKED WRESTLERS

Twenty wrestlers, one at every weight class from each school, are ranked inside the top 20 at their respective weights. Eleven of the nationally ranked wrestlers are rated No. 5 or better.

Both schools have one top-rated wrestler. Iowa's Derek St. John is 19-0 and ranked No. 1 at 157 pounds, and Oklahoma State's Jon Morrison is 14-0 and ranked No. 1 at 133 pounds.

#### DEPTH AT 125

Thomas Gilman and Cory Clark have split time in the Iowa lineup and shared time in the national rankings. Clark opened the season ranked No. 4 and started Iowa's first four duals. Gilman, who cracked the lineup Dec. 5 at Edinboro, has started four of the last five duals, and is ranked No. 3 nationally.

Clark is 12-0 with eight falls and one major decision (He lost 10-8 to Jarrod Garnett in the Midlands semifinals, but Garnett is not a collegiate wrestler).

Gilman is 12-2 with six bonus-point wins and three wins over ranked opponents, including a 3-1 victory over defending NCAA Champion Jesse Delgado (Illinois) in the Midlands finals. He is 3-2 vs. ranked opponents. He lost 4-0 to No. 4 Clark in the finals of the Luther Open, and 4-1 to No. 3 Nico Megaludis (Penn State).

#### ANOTHER SHOT AT THE TOP COWBOY

Oklahoma State brings in the nation's top-rated 133-wrestler for the second time in as many visits to Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Cowboy senior Jon Morrison is 14-0 and scheduled to face No. 4 Tony Ramos (15-2). The last time Oklahoma State visited Carver-Hawkeye Arena in 2011, No. 4 Ramos upset top-ranked Jordan Oliver, 4-3, in the first tiebreak period.

Ramos is 2-0 all-time against Morrison. He won 3-2 in a dual last year, and 6-1 in the quarterfinals of the 2013 NCAA Championships. This is the first time Morrison enters the match as the higher rated wrestler.

Ramos is 30-0 all-time inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena and has an overall dual record of 60-2.

#### BEST-OF-FIVE FOR DZIEWA

Junior Josh Dziewa will face his fifth ranked opponent this year in No. 14. Anthony Callica. Dziewa has split his previous four meetings against ranked opponents, twice beating No. 5 Rick Durso (F&M) at the Midlands Championships, and twice falling to the nation's No. 2 wrestler (Mitchell Port, Edinboro; Zain Retherford, Penn State).

#### GROTHUS BREAKS INTO RANKINGS

Brody is ranked No. 15 at 149 pounds in the most recent Intermat rankings.

Grothus went 6-2 en route to a third-place finish at the Midlands Championships. He avenged an earlier season loss to No. 8 Dave Habat, pinning Habat in 1:38. He also topped No. 2 Jason Tsirtsis of Northwestern, 3-2.

Grothus is 17-5 overall with four falls. He earned his first career Big Ten dual win Jan. 3 at Purdue, and improved to 2-0 in the Big Ten with a 3-2 win against Michigan State on Jan. 4.

#### No. 2 AND THEN SOME

Senior Derek St. John begins a streak of top 10 opponents when No. 2 Alex Dieringer visits Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Friday. St. John is 2-0 all-time vs. Dieringer, including an 8-4 decision in the 2013 dual and a 3-2 overtime

win in the semifinals of the 2013 NCAA Championships.

Following the Oklahoma State dual, St. John will face No. 6. Taylor Walsh (Indiana), No. 3 James Green (Nebraska), and No. 9 Dylan Ness (Minnesota).

St. John is 3-0 this year against ranked opponents, and has eight straight wins against ranked opponents. He has won a team-best 26 straight matches dating back to last season. His last defeat was a 5-4 loss to Nebraska's James Green in the semifinals of the Big Ten Championships. He won two matches in the consolation bracket to place third, and then won five-straight at the national tournament to win the 157-pound NCAA title. He has opened the 2013-14 season with 19 straight wins. The 26-match win streak is the longest of St. John's career.

### UNDEFEATED HAWKEYES

Nick Moore scored 11 dual points last weekend to raise his season total to 33, the fourth highest on the team. Moore earned a tech. fall against Pat Robinson of Purdue and pinned Michigan State's Bobby Nash on consecutive nights, Jan. 3-4.

Moore faces Oklahoma State's No. 2 Tyler Caldwell on Friday. Caldwell beat Moore, 3-2, in Stillwater last year. It is the only previous meeting between the wrestlers. Caldwell was rated No. 3 at the time, and Moore was ranked No. 20.

Moore is 2-2 this year against ranked opponents. He defeated No. 6 Mike Moreno (Iowa State) and No. 13 Pierce Harger (Northwestern), and lost to top-ranked David Taylor (Penn State) and No. 5 Steve Monk (NDSU).

### SWEET 16 FOR EVANS

Junior Mike Evans has scored bonus points in 16-of-17 wins this year. Evans has a recorded seven falls, and leads the team with four major decisions and five technical falls.

Evans racked up three pins and two majors en route to his first Midlands title Dec. 30. He is 17-1 this season and has a career record of 66-16, including a 20-1 all-time mark inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Evans is 0-1 all-time against Chris Perry. Perry used 1:19 of riding time to top Evans, 4-3, last year in Stillwater.

### RANKED AT 184

No. 3 Ethen Lofthouse is expected to face No. 19 Nolan Boyd on Friday night. It is the first meeting between the two wrestlers.

Lofthouse is 2-2 against ranked opponents

this season. His only two losses this season are to No. 1 Ed Ruth (Penn State) and No. 3 Jimmy Sheptock (Maryland). He defeated No. 14 Ophir Bernstein (Brown), 8-2, in the semifinals of the Midlands Championships, and topped John Rizqallah (Michigan State), 4-2, on Jan. 4.

He has won 10 of his last 14 meetings against ranked opponents.

### BURAK-ROSHOLT TAKE II

Sophomore Nathan Burak will face No. 12 Blake Rosholt on Friday. It is the second career meeting between the wrestlers. Rosholt, then ranked No. 5, scored a takedown with 20 seconds remaining to defeat Burak, 3-2, last year in Stillwater.

Burak made his first attached appearance of the season Friday at Purdue, losing 5-4 to No. 17 Braden Atwood.

Burak earned his first attached win of the season Jan. 4 against Michigan State's Nick McDiarmid. He is 6-2 overall and 2-2 against ranked opponents.

### TELFORD WITH ANOTHER SHOT AT RANKED FOE

Bobby Telford owns a 13-1 record this year, including a 4-1 mark against ranked opponents. He has wins over No. 12 Jimmy Lawson (Penn State), No. 13 Adam Fager (Utah Valley), No. 6 J.T. Felix (Boise State), and No. 9 Mike McClure (Michigan State). His lone loss came in Midlands finals to No. 4 Adam Coon (Michigan).

Telford is expected to face No. 15 Austin Marsden on Friday night. It is the first meeting between the wrestlers.

### HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 934-223-31 (.799) in 104 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 52 NCAA Champions have won a total of 80 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 105 Big Ten champions have won a total of 190 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 28 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 148 All-Americans have earned All-America status 301 times, including 17 four-time, 32 three-time and 38 two-time honorees.

### ALL-AMERICAN STREAK

The Hawkeyes have crowned at least one All-American every year since 1972, a span of 42 seasons. Iowa has totaled 255 All-America

honors during that stretch. The Hawkeyes return five All-Americans to this year's squad. Tony Ramos (2nd-133), Derek St. John (1st-157), Mike Evans (6th-174) and Ethen Lofthouse (5th-184) join 2012 All-American Bobby Telford (5th-285) in the 2013-14 lineup.

#### 40 YEARS OF DOMINANCE

Since 1974, only seven schools have captured the NCAA Championship. During that 40-year span, the Hawkeyes have won 23 team titles, including nine straight from 1978-86. The other schools include Oklahoma State (7), Minnesota (3), Penn State (3), Iowa State (2), Arizona State (1) and Oklahoma (1).

#### IOWA-OSU DRAWS A CROWD

A sell-out crowd of 15,400 packed Carver-Hawkeye Arena when No. 1 Iowa hosted No. 2 Oklahoma State in 2011. The Cowboys won the dual, 17-16, with the winning point coming from criteria. Oklahoma State has been involved in five of the top 25 largest duals in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history, and Iowa-Oklahoma State has drawn three of the top 20 largest dual crowds in NCAA history.

#### CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

The Hawkeyes have won 17 of the last 18 duals inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena, and own a 210-20 (.915) all-time record inside the arena. The Hawkeyes have won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

#### LAST MEETING -- JAN. 13, 2013 in Stillwater, Okla.

Iowa fell to second-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-12, at Gallagher-Iba Arena. The Cowboys won six of 10 matches to hand the fourth-ranked Hawkeyes their first dual loss of the season (12-1).

Iowa won four of the first five bouts to build a 12-3 lead before Oklahoma State rallied for five straight wins. The Cowboys needed a third-period takedown in four consecutive matches to earn one-point victories beginning at 165 through 197.

Matt McDonough (125), Tony Ramos (133) and Mark Ballweg (141) got the Hawkeyes rolling early with three straight decisions to build a 9-0 advantage. Oklahoma State cut Iowa's lead to 9-3 when top-ranked Jordan Oliver (149) scored a 9-4 win over Michael Kelly, but Derek St. John (157) regained Iowa's nine-point advantage with an 8-4 win over No. 9 Alex Dieringer.

The Cowboys began chipping into the Iowa lead when No. 3 Tyler Caldwell scored a 3-2 decision over Nick Moore at 165. Oklahoma State's top-ranked Chris Perry used 1:19 of riding time to top No. 6 Mike Evans, 4-3, at 174, and No. 12 Chris Chionuma scored a takedown with 1:13 left in the third to tie the dual, 12-12, and earn a 3-2 win over No. 9 Ethen Lofthouse.

Nathan Burak nearly scored an upset of No. 5 Blake Rosholt at 197 pounds, but the Hawkeye freshman was unable to finish his shots and Rosholt countered a crackdown with a chest lock and a takedown with 20 seconds on the clock. Burak escaped with three seconds left but Rosholt held on for the 3-2 win to grab its first lead of the dual, 15-12.

Iowa had a chance for the win or force a tiebreaker scenario at 285 pounds, but the Cowboys clinched the dual, 18-12, when third-ranked Alan Gelogaev topped No. 6 Bobby Telford, 7-3.

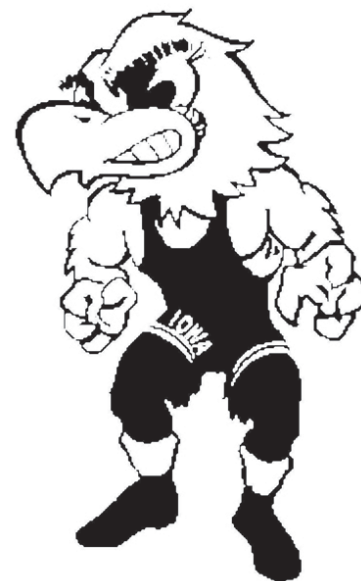

**Tom Brands**  
Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 139-14-1 (.906) overall and 53-5 (.914) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 156-33-1 (.819) career mark.

In seven seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning eight NCAA champions, 10 Big Ten champions and 38 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 53 academic all-Big Ten honorees, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 62 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last seven years, sending the entire 10-man

lineup in 2009-10. Iowa has also won five of the last six Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, Iowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when it hosted Iowa State Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The previous record of 15,646 was set Feb. 1, 2002, when Minnesota hosted Iowa at the Target Center in Minneapolis. The Hawkeyes won the Iowa State dual, 20-15. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' six seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.

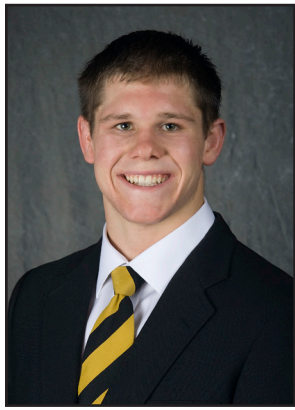

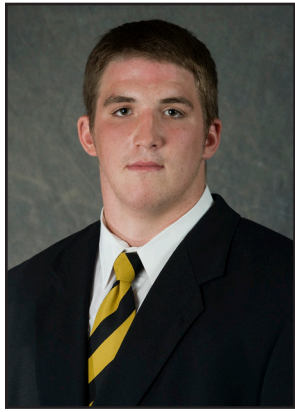
